

**दृगचल** *dṛig-añcala* &c. See 2. *dṛiś*.

**दृभू** *dṛigbhū*, f. a thunderbolt, L.; the sun, L.; a serpent, L. (cf. *dṛinphū*, *dṛimphū*, *dṛinbhū*, *dṛimbhū*).

**दृक्षीरज** *dṛin-niraja* &c. See 2. *dṛiś*.

**दृडक** *dṛidaka*, m. a fire-place or hole made in the ground for cooking, W.

**दृडु** *dṛidu*, m. or f. (mus.) a kind of dance.

**दृढ** *dṛidha*. See under  $\sqrt{dṛiñh}$  &c.

**दृति** *dṛiti*, m. (fr.  $\sqrt{dṛi}$ ) a skin of leather, a leather bag for holding water and other fluids (fig. = a cloud), skin, hide, a pair of bellows, RV.; AV.; Br.; Mn.; MBh. &c.; a fish, L.; N. of a man with the patr. Aindrōti or  $^{\circ}drōta$ , TāṇḍyaBr. [cf. *dārteya*; Gk. *δέρπα*]. — *kunda-tapascit* (only  $^{\circ}cittām ayana$ , n.), N. of a Sattrā, ŚrS. — *dhāraka*, m. a kind of plant, L. — *vātavata* (only  $^{\circ}vator aya-na$ , n.), N. of a Sattrā, ŚrS. — *hari*, mfn. carrying a leather skin or bags (said of cattle), Pān. iii, 2, 25; m. a dog, L. — *hāra*, mfn. id. (but not said of cattle), Pān. ib.; m. a carrier of skins and bags, a water-carrier &c., W.

**दृध** *dṛidhrā*, mfn. ( $\sqrt{dhri}$ ) seizing or fastening tightly, RV. iv, 1, 15.

**दृन्** *drin*, ind. an interjection (prob. made to explain *dṛinbhū*), L.

**दृन्** *dṛinphū*, m. a kind of snake, Uṇ. i, 93, Sch. (v.l. *dṛimphū*).

**दृन्** *dṛinbhū*, m. (Pān. vi, 4, 84, Vārtt. I, Pat.) a thunderbolt, L.; the sun, L.; (f., W.) a snake; L.; a wheel, L. **Dṛimbhū**, id., Uṇ. i, 93, Sch. (cf. *dṛigbhū* &c.)

**दृप** I. *drip* or *driph*, cl. 6. P. *dṛipati* or *dṛimp<sup>o</sup>*; *driph* or *dṛimp<sup>o</sup>*, to pain, torture, Dhātup. xxviii, 28.

**दृप** 2. *drip*, cl. 4. P. *dṛipyati* (*darpati* only ApDh. i, 13, 4); fut. *drāpsyati* or *darpishyati*, Br.; *darpitā*,  $^{\circ}ptā$ , and *draptā*, Pān. vii, 2, 45; pf. *dadarpa*; aor. *adṛipat*, Br.; *adrāpsit*, Pān. iii, 1, 44. Vārtt. 7; *adarpit* and *adārpit*, Vop.) to be mad or foolish, to rave, Br.; to be extravagant or wild, to be arrogant or proud, to be wildly delighted, MBh.; Kāv. &c.; to light, kindle, inflame (*darpati* or *daripayati*, Dhātup. xxxiv, 14, v.l. for *chrid*): Caus. *daripayati*, to make mad or proud or arrogant, Pañc.; Kathās.

**Dṛipta**, mfn. mad, wild, proud, arrogant (-*tara*, compar.), MBh.; Kāv. &c. (cf.  $\dot{a}-d$ <sup>o</sup> and  $a-dṛipitā$ ). — *bālakī*, m. N. of a man with the patr. Gārgya, ŚBr. **Driptātman**, mfn. ‘haughty-minded’ (Kṛiṣṇa), MBh. xii, 1661.

**Dṛipti**. See *prá-d<sup>o</sup>*.

**Dṛipyat**, mfn. being proud or arrogant, W. (cf. *d-d<sup>o</sup>*).

**Dṛipra**, mfn. strong, Uṇ. ii, 13, Sch. (cf. *dūpra*); proud, arrogant, W.

**दृभू** I. *dṛibh*, cl. 1. 10. P. *darbhati* and *darbhayati*, to fear, be afraid, Dhātup. xxxiv, 15.

**दृभू** 2. *dṛibh*, cl. 6. P. *dṛibhāti* (ŚBr.); I. 10. P. *darbhati* and *darbhayati* (Dhātup. xxxiv, 16), to string or tie together, tie in a bunch.

**Dṛibdhā**, mfn. strung, tied, L. (cf. *sam-d<sup>o</sup>*). — *bdhi*, f. stringing together, arranging, L.

**दृभोक** *dṛibhīka*, m. N. of a demon slain by Indra, RV.

**दृमिचरणेश्वर** *dṛimicāñḍēśvara*, n. N. of a Liṅga, MatsyaP. (v.l. *krim<sup>o</sup>*).

**दृम्प** *dṛimp* or *dṛimph*. See 1. *drip*.

**दृम्पू** *dṛimphū* or  $^{\circ}bhū$ . See *dṛinphū* &c.

**दृवन्** *dṛiván* ( $\sqrt{dṛi}$ ?), mfn. piercing (arrow), VS. x, 8.

**Dṛik**, in comp. for 2. *dṛiś*. **Dṛik-karṇa**, m. ‘eye-eared,’ a snake, L. — *karman*, n. an operation by which any planet of a certain latitude (*vikshepa*) is referred to the ecliptic, Sūryas. — *kāṇa*, m. see *drikāna*. — *krodha*, m. the wrathfulness of the aspect (of a planet), Sūryas. — *kshatra*, prob. w.r. for *chattra*, q. v. — *kshaya*, m. decay of sight, growing dim-sighted, MW. — *kshepa*, m. the sine of the zenith-distance of the highest or central point of the ecliptic at a given time, Sūryas. — *chattrā*, n. ‘eye-cover,’ eye-lid, Rājat. viii, 133. — *tulya*, mfn. (astron.) being in accordance with an observed spot, Sūryas.; -*tā*, f. ib. — *patha*, m. range of sight;  $^{\circ}tham$   $\sqrt{i}$  or *gam*, to appear, become visible, Kālid.; Rājat. — *pāta*, m. the letting fall a glance, a look, esp. a downward l°, Var.; Rājat. — *prasādā*, f. ‘eye-cleaner,’ a blue stone used for a collyrium (= *kulathā*), L. — *priyā*, f. ‘eye-delight,’ beauty, splendour, L. — *sakti*, f. (cf. *nayanāñc<sup>o</sup>* and *locanāñc<sup>o</sup>*). — *adhyaksha*, m. ‘sight-ruler,’ the sun, L. — *anta*, m. the outer corner of the eye, Prasannar. — *gati*, f. the cosine of the zenith-distance or the sine of the highest or central point of the ecliptic at a given time, Aryabh.; Sūryas.; -*jīvā*, f. (Sūryas.); -*jyā*, f. (Schol. on Aryabh.) id. — *gocara*, m. range of sight, horizon, Rājat. — *gola*, m. a small circle on the axis of the earth within the greater circles of the armillary sphere and accompanying each planetary circle, W.; -*varṇana*, n. N. of wk. — *jala*, n. ‘eye-water,’ tears, L. — *jyā*, f. the sine of the zenith-distance or the cosine of the altitude, Sūryas. — *dṛiśya-prakarana*, n., -*dṛiśya-viveka*, m. N. of wks. — *bhakti*, f. look of love, Dhūrtas. — *bhū*, see *dṛigbhū*. — *rūj*, f. disease of the eye, L. — *rudh*, mfn. obstructing the sight, Sīs. xix, 76. — *lambana*, n. vertical parallax, Sūryas.; Sch. — *visha*, mfn. having poison in the eyes, L.; m. a Nāga or serpent, W. *d<sup>o</sup>*); f. sight, view (dat. *dṛiśé* as inf., cf.  $\sqrt{1. dṛiś}$ ); look, appearance (in *i-d<sup>o</sup>*, *kī-d<sup>o</sup>*, *tā-d<sup>o</sup>*); the eye, R.; Var. &c. (g. *śarad-ādi*); (ā), f. the eye, L. **Dṛiśākāñkshya**, n. ‘desirable to the eye,’ a lotus, L. **Dṛiśāsputa-mālā** (or  $^{\circ}śā-sph$ <sup>o</sup>?), f. N. of wk. **Dṛiśōpama**, n. ‘resembling the eye,’ Nelumbium Speciosum.

**Dṛiśati**, f. look, appearance, RV. vi, 3, 3.

**Dṛiśāna**, m. (cf. 1. *dṛiś*) a Brāhmaṇ or spiritual teacher, L.; N. of a Rishi with the patr. Bhārgava, Kāth.; of a demon, L.; n. light, brightness, L.

**Dṛiśālu**, m. the sun, L.

**Dṛiśi**, f. seeing, the power of seeing, Vedāntas. (dat.  $^{\circ}śāye$  as inf., cf. 1. *dṛiś*); the eye, BhP. (also  $^{\circ}śi$ , L.); a Śāstra, W. — *mat*, mfn. seeing, beholding, BhP.

**Dṛiśika**, mfn. worthy to be seen, splendid, RV.; (ā), f. look, appearance, ib. (cf. *citra-*, *dur-*, *su-*). *kū*, m. beholder, TS.

**Dṛiśēnya**, mfn. = *dṛiśika*, RV. x, 88, 7.

**Dṛiśna**. See *ānati-* (add.).

(arithm.) reduction of a given quantity with fractions affirmative or negative. — *tā*, f. (Daśar.), -*tva*, n. (Var.) visibility, vision, sight. — *pura*, n. **Dṛiśṭā**, mfn. seen, looked at, beheld, perceived, noticed, Mn.; MBh.; Kāv. &c.; visible, apparent, AV.; VS.; considered, regarded, treated, used, Śak. iii, 7; Pañc. i, 402; appeared, manifested, occurring, existing, found, real, Kāv.; Pañc.; Hit.; experienced, learnt, known, understood, MBh.; Kāv. &c.; seen in the mind, devised, imagined, MBh.; R.; allotted, destined, ib.; settled, decided, fixed, acknowledged, valid, Mn.; Yājñ.; MBh. &c.; n. perception, observation, Śāmkhyak.; Tattvas.; (scil. *bhaya*) a real or obvious danger. — *karman*, mfn. whose actions are seen or proved, tried by practice, MBh.; Rājat.; who has
