वटु वात्ता or बात्ता, m. N. of a man (also -deva), Rājat.

वटुक वात्तका, m. a pill, bolus, Bhadrab. (cf. वात्तका).

वटु वाथ (also written बाथ), cl. 1. P. वाथति, to be big or fat, Dhātup. ix, 46; to be powerful or able, ib.

वटु वाथारा, mfn. stupid, dull, a fool, blockhead, Hcar.; (only L.) wicked, vile (cf. वाथारा); m. a physician; a water-pot; = वक्रा; = अम्बशथा; = शब्दा-करा.

वडव वादवा, m. (also written वादवा, वादवा, वादवा) a male horse resembling a mare (and therefore attracting the stallion), Vait.; (ā), f., see next. - धनु, f. a mare, KātyŚr.

वादवा, f. (also written वादवा, वादवा, वादवा) a female horse, mare, TS. &c. &c.; the nymph Aśvinī (who, in the form of a mare as wife of Vivasvat or the Sun, became the mother of the two Aśvins; cf. अश्विनी), Pur.; Daś.; a partic. constellation represented by a horse's head, W.; a female slave, L.; a harlot, prostitute, L.; = द्विजा-स्त्री, L.; N. of a woman (having the patr. Prāthēyī), GrS.; of a wife of Vasu-deva (called Paricārikā), Hariv.; of a river, MBh.; of a place of pilgrimage, Vishn. - गुनि (°बाग्नि or °वाग्नि), m. 'mare's fire,' submarine fire or the fire of the lower regions (fabled to emerge from a cavity called the 'mare's mouth' under the sea at the South pole; cf. aurva), MBh.; Kathās.; - माला, n. a partic. foamy substance on the sea, L. - नाला (°बान), m. = वादाबाग्नि, Gol.; Kāv. (also personified, Virac.); a partic. powder (prepared from pepper and other pungent substances to promote digestion), Bhpr. - भार्ग्वी, m. वण वाण (also written बाण), cl. 1. P. वाणति (pf. वाणा &c.; Caus. aor. आवणात or आवणात), to sound, Dhātup. xiii, 3.

वाणता, mfn., v. l. for वेश्णता, KātyŚr., Sch.; = व्युता, ib.

वाणिज वाणिज, m. (also written बाणिज) a merchant, trader, RV. &c. &c.; the zodiacal sign Libra, VarBṛS.; N. of a partic. Karaṇa (q. v.), ib.; trade, traffic, commerce, Gaut.; Mn.

वाणिक, in comp. for वाणिज. - कातका, m. a company of merchants, caravan, Daś. - karman, n. (Pāṇcat.), - kriyā, f. (VarBṛS.) the business or occupation of a m°, trade. - tva, n. the position of a m°, Mudr. - patha, m. वण्ट वाण्ट (also written बाण्ट), cl. 1. 10. P. वाण्टति or वाण्टयति (accord. to some also वाण्टापयति), to partition, apportion, share, divide, Dhātup. ix, 43; xxxii, 48 (only वाण्टयते, Caṇ., and वाण्टयमाना, Hcar., v. l.)

वाण्टा, mfn. tailless, having no tail, Gaut. (cf. बाण्टा); unmarried, L.; m. an unmarried man, L.; a portion, share, L.; the handle of a sickle, L.

वाण्टका, m. a portion, share, L.; dividing, MW.; an apportioner, distributor, ib.

वाण्टाना, n. apportioning, distributing, partition, dividing into shares, L.

वाण्टानिया, mfn. to be apportioned or divided, W.

वाण्टिता, mfn. divided into shares, partitioned, MW.

वाण्टाल वाण्टाला or वाण्टाला or वाण्टाला, m. (only L.) a spade, shovel, hoe; a boat; a kind of contest or partic. mode of fighting.

वण्ट वाण्ट, cl. 1. Ā. वाण्टते (pf. वाण्टते &c.), to go or move alone, go unaccompanied, Dhātup. viii, 9.

वाण्टा, mfn. crippled, maimed, L.; unmarried, L.; m. an unmarried man, L.; a servant, L.; a dwarf, L.; a javelin, L.

वाण्टारा, m. (only L.) the new shoot of the Tāl or palm tree; the sheath that envelopes the young bamboo; a rope for tying a goat &c.; the female breast; a dog's tail; a dog; a cloud.

वण्ट वाण्ट (connected with वाण्ट), cl. 1. Ā. वाण्टते, to partition, share, divide, Dhātup. viii, 18; to surround, cover, ib. (v. l. वेश्णते for विभ्जाने); cl. 10. P. वाण्टयति, to partition, share, divide, xxxii, 48 (v. l.)

वण्टार वाण्टारा, m. (cf. बाण्टा) a niggard, miser, W.; a eunuch or attendant on the women's apartments, ib.

वत् 1. वात, an affix (technically termed वाति; see Pāṇ. v, 1, 115 &c.) added to words to imply likeness or resemblance, and generally translatable by 'as,' 'like' (e. g. ब्राह्मणा-वात, like a Brāhman; पित्रि-वात = पितृवा, पितराम् इवा, पितुरिवा and पितरिवा). - करा, m. the affix वात, Saṃk.

वतंस वा-तासा, m. (ifc. f. ā) = वा-तासा, a garland, ring-shaped ornament, crest (also °साका), Kāv.; Chandom.

वतण्ड वातण्डा, m. N. of a man, g. लोहितदी on Pāṇ. iv, 1, 18; pl. his descendants, Pravar. (cf.

ताण्डा-वातण्डा); (ī), f. a female descendant of वातण्डा, Pāṇ. iv, 1, 109.

वतरणी वातराणी, w. r. for वातराणी.

वतायन वातयाना, w. r. for वातयाना.

वतु वातु or वातु, ind. an interjection = hush! silence! Hcar.

वतु वातु, f. a river of heaven, L.; m. (only L.) one who speaks the truth; a road; a disease of the eyes.

वतोका वा-तोक, f. = वा-तोक, a cow mis-carrying from accident, L.

वत्स वात्सा, m. (prob. originally 'yearling,' fr. a lost word वात्सा) a calf, the young of any animal, offspring, child (voc. वात्सा often used as a term of endearment = my dear child, my darling), RV. &c. &c.; a son, boy (see बाला-व°); a year (see त्रि-व°); N. of a descendant of Kaṇva, RV.; PañcarBr.; ŚāṅkhŚr.; of an Āgneya (author of RV. x, 187), Anukr.; of a Kāśyapa, Kathās.; of the step-brother of Maitreya (who passed through fire to prove the falseness of Maitreya's allegation that he was the child of a Śūdrā), Mn. viii, 116 (Sch.); of a son of Pratardana, MBh.; Hariv.; of a son of Sena-jit, Hariv.; of a son of Aksha-mālā, Cat.; of a son of Uru-kshepa, VP.; of a son of Soma-śarman, Kathās.; of the author of a law-book, Cat.; (with कारकध-वयु-सूत्रा-कृत) of another author, ib.; of a serpent-demon, VP.; N. of a country (whose chief town is Kauśāmbī), Kathās.; Nerium Antidysentericum, L.; the Kuṭaja tree, L.; pl. the descendants of Vatsa, ĀśvŚr. (and ī, f.) more than a calf, a weaned calf, a young bull or heifer (also applied to goats and exceptionally to sucking calves and even to full grown animals which have not yet copulated), TS.; VS.; AitBr. &c.; °tarāṇa (°ra-ṛiṇa), n. the debt or loan of a bullock (?), Pāṇ. vi, 1, 89, Vārt. 7, Pat. - tva, n. the state or condition of a calf, BhP. - danta, m. 'calf-toothed,' a kind of arrow (having a point like a calf's tooth), MBh.; R. (also °taka); N. of a mythical person, Virac.; n. an arrow point like a calf's tooth, ŚāṅkhP. - devī, f. N. of a princess of Nepāl, Inscr. - napāt (वात्सा-), m. N. of a descendant of Babhru, ŚBr. - nābha, m. a partic. tree, MBh.; Hariv. (also °bhaka); N. of a mythical being, Hariv.
