

जयशर्मन् Quoted by Raghunandana.

जयशेखर सूरि pupil of Mahendraprabha and codisciple of Muniçekhara and Merutuṅga:

Prabandhakoṣa. BP. 17.

जयसिंह king (1094—1143), patron of Jayamaṅgala (Kavičikshā). Peters. 1, 68.

जयसिंह king, son of Viṣṇuśiṅha, son of Kṛiṣṇasiṅha, son of Rāmasiṅha, son of Jayasiṅha, son of Mahāsiṅha, son of Jagatsiṅha, son of Mānasīnha. The first Jayasiṅha was patron of Ratnākara (Jayasiṅha-kalpadruma 1714). Oxf. 285a. L. 1705.

जयसिंह देव patron of Hemacandra (about 1150). Oxf. 180b.

जयसिंह son of Sussaladeva, king of Kācmīra, ruled 1129—1150. Rājatarāṅgiṇī 8, 241. Report p. 50. He was patron of Mañkha.

जयसिंह king of Bāberī, patron of Gopīnātha Maunin (Siddhāntatattvasarvasva). Hall p. 77.

जयसिंह of Jayapura (1730), patron of Jagannātha (Rākhāgaṇita). Oxf. 340b. Cambr. 75.

जयसिंह मिश्र Caṇḍīstotrāntargatamūrtirahasyaṭīkā. Peters. 2, 196.

जयसिंह सूरि pupil of Mahendra: Nyāyatātparyadīpikā or Nyāyasāradīpikā. IO. 213. B. 4, 24.

जयसिंह सवार्द्ध Yantrarāja jy. Bik. 351. Yantrarājaṭīkā. NW. 508. Yantrarājaracanāprakāra or Jayasiṅhakārikā. Peters. 2, 194. Probably not different from the Yantrarāja.

जयसिंहकल्पद्रुम or **ब्रतकल्पद्रुम** dh. composed by Ratnākara in 1714. Oxf. 285a. Paris (D 54). L. 1705. Bik. 396. NW. 156. SB. 146. Called Jayasiṅha-kalpataru in Ahalyākāmadhenu. O: Uddyota by Ratnākara. IO. 565. Ben. 132. 141. Rādh 18. NP. I, 62. II, 144.

जयसिंहदेव by repute, author of: Jayamādhavamānasollāsa.

जयसिंहाभ्युदय Quoted by Ratnakāṇṭha Peters. 2, 17.

जयसोमगणि Khaṇḍapraçastivṛitti. Bik. 708.

जयहर्कल्पतर a synonyme of the Jayasiṅhakalpadruma. Ahalyākāmadhenu.

जयाख्यासंहिता āgama. Oppert II, 4016.

जयादित्य son of Rāṇiga, brother of Keçavārka.

जयादित्य poet. Skm. Sbhv.

जयादित्य author of the four first adhyāyas of the Kācikāvṛitti. Quoted in Mādhaviyadhātuvṛitti, and by clouds of grammarians.

जयानक father of Alaka (Haravijayaṭīkā).
