Divākara's mother was daughter of Nilakanṭha Bhaṭṭa, son of Çāṅkara Bhaṭṭa, son of Nārāyaṇa Bhaṭṭa, son of Rāmeçvara Bhaṭṭa. He was father of Vaidyanātha. Hall p. 175:
