

Yaçodeva, son of Rāmacandra, son of Karmasena, son of Rolicandra, son of Çivagaṇa, son of Candrapāla, son of Manyudeva, son of Narabrahmadeva, son of Viḍharāja, son of Vairātaraja, son of Raya, son of Astaçatru, son of Viçoka, son of Karṇa. They were of the Seṅgara, or in Saṃskrit, Çringivara tribe. Bhagavantadeva was the patron of Nilakanṭha, the author of the following work.

भगवन्नभास्कर or सृतिभास्कर often shortened into भास्कर a law-book composed early in the 17th century by Nilakanṭha. The latest writers he quotes are Raghuṇandana and Bhaṭṭoji. The work is divided into 12 Mayūkha: 1. Saṃskāra (composed by his son Çāñkara). 2. Ācāra. 3. Tithi (Kāla, Samaya). 4. Çrāddha. 5. Nīti. 6. Vyavahāra. 7. Dāna. 8. Utsarga. 9. Pratishṭhā. 10.
