सायण son of Māyaṇa, wrote under Bukka I of Vidyā-nagara (1850—79) and his successor Harihara. He died in 1387. His numerous works are attributed by turn to himself, to his brother Mādhava, or Vi-dyāraṇya. See Burnell's Preface to the Vañçabrahmaṇa. He was a pupil of Vishṇu Sarvajña (Hall p. 161), and of Čañkarānanda (Hall p. 98), and guru of Rāmakṛiṣṇa (Pañcadāciṭikā). There can be very little doubt, and a thorough examination of all parts enables us to prove, that his comments on the Rigveda and Taittiriyasamhitā were only partially done by himself and carried on by his school. The interpretation of the Taittiriyabrahmaṇa, Taittiriyāraṇyaka, Aitareyāraṇyaka, shows a want of discretion which can only be explained on the supposition that their authorship belongs to a different writer.
