मुक्त p. p. [मुच्चक] 1 Loosened, relaxed, slackened. -2 Set free, liberated, relaxed. -3 Abandoned, left, given up, set aside, taken off. -4 Thrown, cast, discharged, hurled. -5 Fallen down, dropped down from; Ku. 1. 6 -6 Drooping, unnerved; मुकैरपत्रवैराग्यांश् Dk. 7 Given, bestowed -8 Sent forth, emitted. -9 Finally saved or emancipated. -10 Ejected, spit out. -11 Deprived. -12 Absolved or emancipated (from sin or worldly existence); see मुच्च also. -न्तः One who is finally emancipated from the bonds of worldly existence, one who has renounced all worldly attachments and secured final beatitude, an absolved saint; मुक्तिविन गीतेन युवर्णिनं च लीक्षय। मनो न भिद्यते वस्त्र

मुक्ता 1 A pearl; हरोयं हरिणाशी-पां लुडति स्तनपंडते । मुक्तानामप्यवस्थेय के वयं स्मरकक्षः Amaru.100 (where मुक्ता नां means also 'of absolved saints'). (Pearls are said to be produced from various sources, but
