

द्वणिन् *tūnin*, i.e. *tūna + in*, adj. Provided with quivers, Râm. 6, 76, 21.

द्वणीर *tūnī + ra* (see *tūna*), m. and n. A quiver, MBh. 7, 1271; MBh. 6, 2288.

द्वणीरवन्त् *tūnīra + vant*, adj., f. *vatī*, Provided with a quiver, Hariv. 15154.

† **द्वर्** *TÛR*, i. 4, Âtm. 1. To go quick. 2. To hurt, see *tur*.

द्वर् *târ*, f. Swiftness, Bhâg. P. 2, 7, 37.

द्वर्य *tûrya*, I. = *turya*, Râjat. 2, 91. II. m. and n. Any musical instrument, Man. 7, 225.

द्वर्यमय *tûrya + maya*, adj., f. *yî*, MusicalKathâs. 23, 84.

† **द्वल्** *TÛL*, i. 1 and 10, To weigh (cf. *tu*). i. 10, Âtm. = *tûn*.

द्वल *tûla*, m. and n. Cotton, MBh. 1, 6740.—Comp. *Haṁsa-*, down, Daçak. in Chr. 198, 17.

द्वलक *tûla + ka*, n. Cotton, Bhâshâp. 112.

द्वलिका *tûlikâ*, i. e. *tûla + ka*, f. 1. A pencil, Kumâras. 1, 22. 2. A mattress filled with cotton, Kathâs. 26, 78.

द्ववरक *tûvara + ka* (*tûvara* = ved. *tûpara*, Without horns, beardless, an eunuch), adj. Unmanly, MBh. 5, 5470.

† **द्वष्** *TÛSH*, i. 1, Par. To be satisfied; see *tush*.

द्वष्णीक *tûshṇīka*, i.e. *tûshṇīm + ka*, adj. Taciturn, Râm. 2, 117, 3 Gorr. *°ham*, adv. Silently, Râm. 5, 1, 97.

द्वष्णीम् *tûshṇīm*, i.e. *tush + na + i + m*, adv. Silently, MBh. 12, 3839; Man. 8, 147.

द्वष्णीभाव *tûshṇībhâva*, i.e. *tûsh-ṇīm-bhâva*, m. Silence, MBh. 12, 3840.

† **द्वंह** *TRĪMH*, i. 6, *ṭriha*, Par. To hurt; see *ṭrih*.

† **द्वच्** *TRĪKSH*, i. 1, Par. To go.

द्वच *ṭricha*, i.e. *tri-ṭrich + a*, m. and n. Three verses, Chr. 294, l. 5.

द्वण् *TRIN*, or **द्वन्** *TRIN*, ii. 8, Par. To eat, Skandap. Kâçikh. 3, 49.

द्वण *ṭriṇa*, i.e. *ṭri + ṇa* (cf. *taru*), n. (and m.). 1. Grass, any gramineous plant, Man. 1, 48; Hit. i. d. 144; Râm. 2, 21, 26; Man. 4, 166. 2. A grass-blade, Pañch. i. d. 190.—Cf. perhaps O.H.G. dorn, A.S. thorn.

द्वणक *ṭriṇa + ka*, n. A worthless grass-blade, MBh. 1, 3666.

द्वणपीड *ṭriṇa-pīd + a*, n. A mode of close-fighting, MBh. 2, 909.

द्वणमय *ṭriṇa + maya*, adj., f. *yî*, Made of grass, MBh. 1, 5554.

द्वणवन्त् *ṭriṇa + vant*, adj., f. *vatī*, Abounding in grass, MBh. 12, 3694.

द्वणाङ्कु *ṭriṇâṅku*, m. The name of a Rishi, Râm. 4, 41, 62.

द्वतीय *ṭritiya*, i.e. *tri + tîya*, f. *yâ*. 1. ordinal number, Third, Man. 2, 35. 2. adj. A third part, Man. 6, 33. 3. *°yam*, adv. Thirdly, Man. 8, 129.—Cf. Goth. thridja; A.S. thridda; Lat. tertius; *ṭritros*.

द्वतीयक *ṭritiya + ka*, adj. Tertian, Suçr. 2, 405, 14.

द्वतीयिन् *ṭritiyin*, i.e. *ṭritiya + in*, adj., f. *nî*. 1. Being of the third rank. 2. Entitled to a third part.

द्वद् *TRĪD*, ii. 7, Par., Âtm. 1. To cleave (ved.). 2. To kill, to destroy,
