

The phlegmatic humour, mucus, Man. 4, 132; Pañch. iii. d. 60.

श्लेष्मल *śleshmala*, i.e. *śleshman* + *a* (with *l* for *n*), adj. Phlegmatic.

श्लेष्मात *śleshmâta* (akin to the last), m. A small tree, *Cordia latifolia*.

श्लेष्मातक *śleshmâta* + *ka* (m.), A tree, *Cordia myxa*, Man. 6, 14; cf. Râm. 1, 13, 28 (°कमय *ka* + *maya*, adj. Made of *śleshmâtaka*).

† श्लोक *ŚLOK* (rather a denomin. derived from the next), i. 1, Âtm. 1. To compose verses. 2. To be composed. 3. To acquire. 4. To abandon.

श्लोक *śloka*, i.e. *śru* + *ka*, m. 1. Fame. 2. A verse, Pañch. 106, 8; a saying, Chr. 22, 24.—Comp. *Puṇya-*, I. adj. well-famed, Bhâg. P. 1, 12, 18. II. m. 1. a name of Nala, Nal. 7, 18. 2. epithet of Yudhishthira and Vishṇu. III. f. *kâ*, a name of Damayantî and Sitâ.

श्लोण् *ŚLON*, see *śron*.

श्वक्रीडिन् *śvakrīḍin*, i.e. *śvan*-*krīḍâ* + *in*, m. A breeder of sporting dogs, Man. 3, 164.

श्वघ्निन् *śvaghnin* (? nom. sing. *ghni*), m. A gamester, Chr. 295, 10 = Rigv. i. 92, 10.

† श्वङ् *ŚVANĀK*, or स्वङ् *SVANĀK*, i. 1, Âtm. To go, to move.

श्वङ् *ŚVANĀG*, see *śraṅg*.

श्वच् *ŚVACH*, see *śvañch*.

श्वज् *ŚVAJ*, see the next.

श्वञ्च *ŚVANĀCH* (ved.), † श्वच् *ŚVACH*, † शञ्च *ŚANĀCH*, † श्वज्

श्वट् *ŚVATH*, and श्वट् *ŚVANṬH*, see 4. *śath*.

श्वन् *śvan* (probably from *śvi*), I. m. A dog, Hit. i. d. 112, M.M. II. f. *śunî*, A bitch.—Comp. *Deva-śunî*, f. the bitch of the gods, *Saramâ*, MBh. 1, 671. *Vana-śvan*, m. 1. a jackal. 2. a tiger. 3. a civet or polecat.—Cf. *κύν*, *άλ-κύν*; Lat. *canis*, *catulus* (based on *śvant*, the original form of *śvan*); Goth. *hunds* (based on *śvant*); A.S. *hund*.

श्वनर *śvanara*, i.e. *śvan*-*nara*, m. A base fellow.

श्वपच् *śvapach*, i.e. *śvan*-*pach*, m. and f. A dog-feeder, Man. 3, 92.

श्वपच *śvapacha*, i.e. *śvan*-*pach* + *a*, m., and f. *châ*, 1. A dog-feeder. 2. A man or woman of a low caste, Râjat. 5, 390; 404.

श्वपाक *śvapâka*, i.e. *śvan*-*pach* + *a*, I. m. 1. A man of a low and outcaste tribe, Râjat. 5, 217; 382. 2. The son of a *Kshattrî* by an *Ugrâ* woman, Man. 10, 19. II. f. *kî*, A woman of a low or outcaste tribe, Râjat. 5, 390.

† श्वभ्र् *ŚVABHR*, i. 10, Par. 1. To go. 2. To live in distress. 3. To make a hole, to pierce (cf. the next).

श्वभ्र *śvabhra*, n. A hole, Vikr. d. 18.

श्वयथु *śvayathu*, i.e. *śvi* + *athu*, m. Swelling, intumescence.

श्वयीची *śvayîchî*, i.e. probably *śvi* + *a*-*añch*, f. (?). A disease (tumefaction).
