धृतसंकल्प a. firmly resolute upon (loc.).

धृतात्मन् a. firm-minded, constant.

धृति f. holding fast, firmness, solidity, constancy, resolution; satisfaction, contentment. — धृतिं कृ hold fast or be satisfied; °बन्ध् set the mind on (loc.).

धृतिगृहीत a. armed with constancy or resolution

धृतिपुष्प n. the flower of content or happiness; °ष्पं बन्ध् be satisfied or blessed.

धृतिमन् a. steadfast, constant, firm; satisfied, content.

धृतिमुष् a. robbing fortitude, agitating.
