- वाचकपद a. containing words that have a sense or express something.
- वाचन n. reciting or causing to recite, reading, expressing; f. वा lesson, chapter.
- वाचस्यति m. lord of speech, master of language, E. of sev. gods, esp. of Bṛhaspati, also a man's name.
- वाचा f. speech, word; the goddess of speech: वाचामात्र & °क n. = वाङ्मात्र.*
- वाचाट a. talkative, vain-glorious.
- वाचारम्भण n. a mere phrase (lit. a hold or support of language).

- वाचिक a. consisting of words, verbal, oral.
- वाचिन् a. asserting, expressing (-°).
- वाच्य to be spoken or said (n. impers.); being said or meant; to be spoken to or about; to be spoken against, blamable, censurable; n. blame, censure, fault. Abstr. °ता f., °त्व n.
- वाच्यर्थ m. the meaning immediately expressed.
- वाज m. swiftness, strength, courage; race, struggle, contest & its prize, booty, gain, reward, treasure, good; offering-meat; runner, horse; N. of one of the Rbhus, pl. the Rbhus together.
- वाजजित् a. winning the contest or booty.
- वाजदा & °दावन् a. granting good or strength.
- वाजपति m. lord of strength (f. °पत्नी).
- वाजपेय m. n. a cert. sacrifice.
- वाजपेयस् a. embellished with gifts or strength.
- वाजभर a. carrying the prize.
- वाजय्, वाजयति & वाजयति, °ते run for the prize, race, hasten; combat, contest; spur on, incite.
- वाजयु a. running (for the prize), zealous, eager, strong, bestowing booty or treasure.
- वाजरत्न a. rich in goods or treasures.

- वाजश्रव m. N. of a man.
- वाजश्रवस् m. N. of a teacher.
- वाजश्रवस् m. patron. from prec.
- वाजश्रुत a. famed for swiftness.
- वाजसनि a. gaining or granting good, booty, strength, etc.; victorious.
- वाजसनेयं m. patron. of Yājñavalkya; pl. N. of a Vedic school.
- वाजसनेयिन् m. pl. the school of Vājasaneyas.
- वाजसनेयिब्राह्मण n., °संहिता f. Brāhmana & Śāhītā of the Vājasaneyas.
- वाजसा a. = वाजसनि.
- वाजसात n, °साति f. gain of the prize or of goods, battle, victory.
- वाजसुत् a. running for the prize.
- वाजिन a. swift, courageous, strong, brave, manly m. hero, warrior; horse, stallion. Pl. the horses of the gods, also the sect of Vājasaneyas.
- वाजिन n. race, running, contest, manly strength.
- वाजिनीवन् a. swift or having swift horses. courageous, strong.
- वाजिनीवसु a. having swift horses or giving strength.
- वाजिनैयं m. son of a hero or warrior.
- वाजिनेध m. horse-sacrifice.
