Nikumbha¹, name of several Asuras. § 90 (Ampāvat.): I, 65, 2527 (son of Prahlāda).—§ 92 (do.): I, 65, 2534 (another, son of Danu).—§ 130 (do.): I, 67, 2662 (incarnate as king Devādhipa).—§ 248 (Sundopasundop.): I, 209, 7620 (*Daiyendrab*, father of Sunda and Upasunda).

Nila², king of Māhiṣmatī. § 130 (Ampāvat.): I, 67, 2697 (*bhūmipāh*, among the incarnations from the Krodhavaça gana).—§ 232 (Swayamvarap.): I, 186, 6990 (present at the svayamvara of Draupadi).—§ 282 (Sahadeva): II, 31, 1124 (on his digvijaya Sahadeva fought with *N.*, who was assisted by Agni).—§ 282b (Māhiṣmatī): II, 31 [1131 (*‘rājñoduhitā*)], 1133 (Agni married the daughter of *N.*).—§ 284 (Sahadeva): II, 31, 1160 (*‘syā kule*), 1162 (paid tribute to Sahadeva).—§ 515 (Karnadigvijaya): III, 254, 15250 (*māhīpatim*, vanquished by Karṇa on his digvijaya).—§ 554 (Sainyodyogap.): V, 4 γ , 79.—§ 555 (do.): V, 19, 592 (*Māhiṣmativāsi* N° Nilāyudhaih saha, came with troops to Duryodhana).—§ 572 (Rathātirathasaṅkhyanap.): V, 166, 5751 (*Māhiṣmativāsi* nilavarmā, among the rathas in Duryodhana's army).—§ 580 (Bhishmavadhap.): VI, 56, 2414 (*Nilāyudhaih* saha, in the army of Yudhiṣṭhīra), 2415.—§ 585 (do.): VI, 98 ψ , 4153 (*Anupādhīpatih*, followed Ghaṭotkaca); 94, 4210 (*Anupādhīpatih*), 4213, 4215, 4216, 4217 (fought with Aṣvatthāman, was defeated and swooned).—§ 592 (Saṃcāptakavadhap.): VII, 23 α , 1012 (proceeded against Drona, description of his horses, etc); 25, 1109 (fought with the sons of Dhṛitarāshṭra); 31, 1362, 1364, 1365, 1367, 1370 (slain by Aṣvatthāman).—§ 604 (Karṇap.): VIII, 6, 166 (*Anupāvāsi*, had been slain by Aṣvatthāman).—§ 621 (Rājadh.): XII, 4 ϵ , 113 (present at the svayamvara of the daughter of the Kaliṅga king Cīrāṅgada). Nimesha², Nimeshāh (pl.), Nimeshonmeshakarman = Çiva (1000 names¹).

Nimi¹, an ancient king of the Videhas. § 6 (Anukram.): I, 1a, 227 (in Sañjaya's enumeration).—§ 267 (Yamasabhāv.): II, 8, 320 (in the palace of Yama).—§ 677 (Mokshadh.): XII, 235, 8600 (*Vaidarbhiḥ*, gave his kingdom to the brahmans).—§ 761 (Ānuçāsanik.): XIII, 115 δ , 5667 (among the kings who did not eat meat during the month of Kārtika).—§ 767 (do.): XIII, 137 α , 6255 (gave his kingdom [to the brahmans], cf. Nimi², son of Dattātreya and father of Ārimat. § 749 (Ānuçāsanik.): XIII, 91, 4330 (*Dattātreyaśya putrah*, father of Ārimat), 4332, 4345 (was the first who performed a çrāddha), 92, 4372.

Nimisha¹, a Suparna, son of Garuḍa. § 564 (Mātaliyop.): V, 101 β , 3595 (enumeration).

Nimisha = Vishṇu (1000 names).

Nimitta(m), Nimittasthā = Çiva (1000 names¹).

Nimnagāsuta ("son of the river") = Bhishma: XIII, 7723.

Nipa, pl.
