- ✓ **d hṝṣ** (*dhr̄ṣnōti*; *dadhárṣa*; *ádhṝṣat*; *dhr̄ṣitā*, *dhr̄ṣṭā*; *-dhṝṣya*; *dharṣayati*). be bold or courageous; dare; venture, 74²; — *caus.* venture on some one or something; offend; overpower; *dharṣitā*, overcome. - dheya**, *n.* the giving. [*v̄1dhā*, mg 4, ‘bestow, give’: 1213c.]
- dhaīrya**, *n.* firmness; earnest or resolute bearing. [*2dhīra*, 1211.]
- ✓ **d hmā**, see *v̄dham*.
- ✓ **d hyā** (*dhyāti*; *dhyāyati* [761d1]; *dhyāu*; *ádhyāsít* [911]; *dhyāsyāti*; *dhyātā*; *dhyātvā*; *-dhyāya*). think upon; meditate. [see *v̄dhī* and 108g.] + **abhi**, set the mind on something; sink one’s self in thought, 57¹.
- dhyāna**, *n.* meditation. [*v̄dhyā*, 1150.]
- dhyāna-para**, *a.* having meditation as highest object, absorbed in contemplation. [1302b.]
- ✓ **d hraj** (*dhr̄ajati*; *ádhr̄ājīt*). draw onward, advance, *intrans.* [see *v̄drāgh*, of which this is poss. a collateral form.]
- ✓ **d hru**, *collateral form of v̄dhvṝ.*
- d hrūti**, *f.* a deceiving; infatuation. [*v̄dhru*.]
- d hruvā**, *a.* — 1. holding or continuing, *i.e.* remaining fixed in place; *as m.* the pole-star, 100⁸; — 2. of abodes certain, safe, 79¹⁸. [*v̄dhṝ* in mg 6: see 1190.]
- d hruvā**, *f.* sacrificial ladle, 102¹³, *see srūc.* [lit. ‘holder,’ *v̄dhṝ* in mg 1: see 1190.]
- ✓ **d hvāns** or **dhvas** (*dhvānsati*, *-te*; *dadhvānsa*, *dadhvasé*; *ádhvasat*; *dhvastā*; *-dhvāsyā*). — 1. fall to dust, perish; *dhvasta*, exhausted, hurt, impaired; — 2. vanish, be off; — 3. *only in ppl.* *dhvasta*, bestrewn, covered over, *esp.* with dust. [cf. Eng. *dus-t*; prob. also AS. *dwēs* and *dysig*, ‘foolish,’ Eng. *dizzy*, Old High Ger. *tusic*, ‘foolish.’]
- d hvānsā**, *m.* the perishing; destruction. [*v̄dhvāns*.]
- ✓ **1 d hvan** (*ádhvanīt*; *dhvāntā*; *dhvānāyati*). — 1. cover one’s self; *dhvāntā*, dark; — 2. become extinguished; — *caus.* — 1, envelope, cover over; — 2. blacken. [perhaps akin w. *v̄dhvans*: see *dhūma*: cf. AS. *dunn*, Eng. *dun*, ‘dark, brownish-black.’]
- ✓ **2 d hvan** (*dhvānatī*; *dadhvāna*; *dhvāntā* [955a]). sound, resound. [cf. Old Eng. *dune*, Eng. *din*.]
- d hvaní**, *m.* sound. [*v̄2dhvan*.]
- ✓ **d hvṝ** (*dhvārati*). bend or make crooked; cause to fall; harm by deceit. [see *dhūrta* and *dhruti*: cf. AS. *dwellan*, ‘lead astray; cause to delay’; Eng. *dwell*, *intrans.*, ‘delay, linger, abide’; Eng. *dwaull*, ‘wander, rave,’ *dwaile*, ‘stupefying potion’; Dutch *dwaal-licht*, ‘ignis fatuus’; Goth. *dvals*, ‘foolish’; Eng. *dull*, *dolt*; Ger. *toll*, ‘mad.’]
