

[extension of $\sqrt{2}$ mr̥, 'crush': cf. á-μαλδ-úvw̥, 'destroy' e.g. a wall: w. mr̥dú, 'soft, weak,' cf. Lat. *mollis*, **molv̥is*, **moldv̥i-s*, 'soft, weak,' and *βραδύς*, **μραδύς*, 'slow' (for mg, cf. Ger. *weich*, 'soft' w. Eng. *weak*, and Lat. *lēn-is*, 'soft,' w. *len-tus*, 'slow'):

with \sqrt{mrd} in hima-mardana, 'melting of the snow,' we might compare μέλδω, 'melt,' Eng. *melt*; but the *s* of the collateral form *smelt* makes this doubtful: see also *mradas*.]

+ vi, destroy.

m̥d, f. earth; loam; clay; mound of earth, 62¹⁸. [prop. 'crumbled earth,' \sqrt{mrd} : similar specializations of mg are frequent: thus AS. *mol-de*, 'crumbling earth, dust,' Eng. *mol-d*, come fr. a \sqrt{mal} , the cognate of $\sqrt{2}$ mr̥, 'crush, crumble'; Ger. *Grand*, 'sand,' is fr. the same root as Eng. *grind*; Ger. *Scholle*, 'clod,' and *zer-schellen*, 'break to pieces,' go back to the same root; *logá* and *loṣṭá*, 'clod,' are derivs of \sqrt{ruj} , 'break.]

mr̥dú, a. soft; weak. [\sqrt{mrd} , q.v.]

mr̥nmáya, a. made of earth; w. gr̥ha, house of clay, the grave. [$m̥d + maya$: see *maya*.]

\sqrt{mrg} (*mr̥gáti*, -te; *mamárça*, *mamr̥cé*; *ámṛkṣat*; *mr̥ṣṭā*; *máṛṣṭum*; -*mṛgya*). -1. touch, mulecere, stroke; grasp, take hold of; -2. take hold of of mentally, consider. [cf. the Hesychian *βρακεῖν*, **μρακ*, 'grasp, understand'; Lat. *mulcere*, 'stroke.']

+ abhi, touch.

$\sqrt{mṛṣ}$ (*mṛṣyate*, -ti; *mamárṣa*, *mamr̥sé*; *ámars̥iṣta*; -*mṛṣya*; caus. *marṣáyati*). -1. forget, 92¹⁶; -2. (like Eng. not mind) disregard, treat as of no consequence, bear patiently.

meka, a setting up, in su-méka. [$\sqrt{1 mi}$, 'establish.']

mékhala, f. girdle, see 59³ n.

meghá, m. cloud. [\sqrt{migh} , see *mih*.]

médas, n. fat. [\sqrt{mid} or *med* (761a), *médati*, 'be fat.']

méda, m. -1. juice of meat, broth; -2. sap and strength, essential part, esp. of the sacrificial victim; -3. sacrificial

victim; animal sacrifice. [cf. \sqrt{mid} under *médas*.]

medhas, wisdom, in su-medhas. [equiv. of *medhá*.]

medhá, f. wisdom.

melaka, m. assembly; w. kr̥, assemble. [\sqrt{mil} , 1181.]

modaka, m. small round comfit, sweetmeat. [prop. 'gladdener,' \sqrt{mud} , 1181: so Eng. *cheer* and *refreshment* are applied esp. to eatables.]

māuñjá, a. made of Munja-grass; -ī, sc. *mekhalā*, girdle of Munja-grass. [$múñja$, 1208f.]

māuñjī-nibandhana, n. ligation of the Munja-girdle.

māuná, n. silence. [$múni$, 1208d.]

mna, uncertain verbal. minded; assumed on account of *sumná*. [$\sqrt{mnā}$.]

$\sqrt{mnā}$ (mánati; ámnásit; mnátā). collateral form of \sqrt{man} , 'be minded,' 108g. [see \sqrt{man} : cf. *μι-μνή-σκω*, 'keep in mind.']

$\sqrt{myakṣ}$ (*myákṣati*; *mimyákṣa* [785]; *ámyak*). be fixed in or on; be present. + sam, keep together, 73⁴.

mradas, n. softness. [\sqrt{mrad} , collateral form of \sqrt{mrd} , q.v.]

$\sqrt{mlā}$ (*mláyati*; *mamláū*; *ámlásit*; *mláná*). wither. [collateral form of $\sqrt{1 mr̥}$, 'die,' and so 'perish, decay, fade.']

mlāna-sraj, a. having a withered garland.

\sqrt{mluc} (*mlócati*; *ummlóca*; *mluktá*). go.

+ apa, go off, retire; *apamlukta*, retired, hidden.

mlechá, m. barbarian. [\sqrt{mlech} .]

\sqrt{mlech} (*mlécchati*). speak unintelligibly or barbarously. [root **mlék*: *mlécchati* is for **mlék-sketi*, like *přechati*, q.v., for **prksketi*: cf. á-μ(β)λακ-εῖν, *μλακ*, 'err, miss'; *βλάξ*, *βλακ-ός*, 'stupid.']

yá [509], relative pron. -1. who, which; sometimes following its correlative: 7⁶, 17¹⁸, 29⁵, 30¹⁵, 33¹⁶, 52⁷, 73⁹, 78¹⁰, 79⁷; *evambhūto vidvān*, *yas* .. *samarthas*,
