आभा, शुति, प्रभा, भास्, रोचिस् *f.* lightning, अचिरांशुविलासच्चलः Kir. ii. 19. (Note—The acc. inst., dat., abl. and gen. singulars of this word, रित् अचिरम्, अचिरेण, अचिराय, अचिरात्, and अचिरस्य, are used as indeclinables in the sense of 'soon, shortly after'.)
