

**अनव** *m.* 1 Misfortune, ill-luck; 2 adversity; 3 gambling; 4 misconduct.

**अनवंगत** *a.* (*f. ता*) Fallen into misfortune, M. x. 95.

**अनर्गल** (*f. ला*) 1 Unrestrained, तुरंगमुस्तृष्टमनगलं पुनः: R. iii. 39; 2 unlocked.

**अनर्ध** *a.* (*f. धी*) Priceless, invaluable.

**अनर्ध** *a.* (*f. धी*) 1 Priceless; 2 highly revered, K.S. i. 58. **अनर्य** *I m.* 1 Want of meaning, nonsense; 2 a worthless object; 3 misfortune. II *a.* (*f. धी*) 1 Worthless, useless; 2 unfortunate, unlucky; 3 nonsensical, meaningless.

**अनर्यक** *I a.* (*f. का*) 1 Non-significative *i. e.* expletive (as a particle); 2 non-sensical; 3 unprofitable; 4 unlucky. II *n.* Nonsensical or incoherent speech.

**अनर्ह** *a.* (*f. ही*) 1 Unworthy; 2 unsuitable; 3 not deserving.

**अनर्त** *m.* 1 Fire, व्यभिचार न ता पक्तोऽन्तः: Na. iv. 18.; 2 the god of fire; 3 digestive power; 4 bile. COMP.—**शीपन** *a.* stomachic.—**प्रिया** *f.* Sváhá, Agni's wife.—**साइ** *m.* loss of appetite, dyspepsia.

**अनर्तम्** *ind.* 1 Not enough, insufficiently.

**अनर्तस्** (*f. सा*) 1 Not indolent, diligent; 2 unable.

**अनर्त्य** *a.* (*f. ल्पा*) 1 Not a little *i. e.* much, अनर्त्यमयामयवल्लितः: Bh. V. ii. 138; 2 numerous.

**अनवकाश** *a.* (*f. शा*) 1 Uncalled for; 2 inapplicable; 3 having no opportunity or place.

**अनवप्रह** *a.* (*f. हा*) Resistless, मुकुमारकायमनवप्रहः स्मरः: M. M. i.

**अनवचिक्ष** *a.* (*f. शा*) 1 Not separated or cut; 2 unbounded; 3 excessive; 4 undiscriminated, unmodified, (in Nyaya).

**अनवद्य** *a.* (*f. शा*) 1 Irre-proachable, blameless, R. vii. 70; 2 unobjectionable. (Note—There are two negative prefixes in अ. Cf. अवित्य) COMP.—**अंगी** *f.* a woman with a faultless form.—**रूप** *a.* of faultless form *i. e.* beautiful.

**अनवधान** I *n.* 1 Inattention; 2 inadvertence, II *a.* (*f. ना*) Inattentive.

**अनवधि** *a.* Unlimited, infinite. **अनवम** *a.* (*f. मा*) Not low *i.e.* high, illustrious, मुख्यमानवमा सभास् R. xvii. 27.

**अनवरत** *a.* (*f. ता*) Incessant, uninterrupted, Sak. ii.

**अनवरतम्** *ind.* Incessantly, uninterrupted.

**अनवरार्थ** *a.* (*f. धी*) Chief, principal.

**अनवलभ्य** *m.* Independence, absence of support.

**अनवलोभन** *n.* A purificatory rite observed by a woman in the third month after conception.

**अनवसर** *m.* 1 Absence of leisure; 2 unseasonableness, भ्रवमनवसरप्रस्त एवाधिभावः: M. M. ix.

**अनवस्कर** *a.* (*f. रा*) Pure, free from dirt.

**अनवस्था** *f.* 1 An unsettled state; 2 incontinence; 3 an endless series of causes and effects, the regressus in infinitum, (in phil.) एवम्यनवस्था स्याद्या मूलक्षतिकारिणी K. Pr. ii.

**अनवस्थान** I *a.* (*f. ना*) Unstable, fickle. II *m.* Wind. III *n.* 1 Instability; 2 incontinence, misconduct.

**अनवेष** *a.* (*f. आ*) Regardless. **अनवेषस्** *ind.* Without taking regard.

**अनवेषण** *n.* Regardlessness.

**अनवेषा** *f.* See अनवेषण.

**अनश्च** *n.* Fasting, a fast.

**अनश्वर** *a.* (*f. री*) Imperishable, eternal.

**अनस्** *n.* 1 A cart; 2 a living being; 3 birth.

**अनस्तमित** *a.* (*f. ता*) Not set (as the sun or moon), अनस्तमिते दिवसनाथे Ve ii.

**अनहन्** *n.* An unlucky day.

**अनाकाल** *m.* 1 Improper time; 2 famine. COMP.—**भृत** *m.* a man who has become a slave voluntarily for sustenance in famine (in civil law).

**अनाकुल** *a.* (*f. ला*) Undisturbed, composed,

**अनागत** *a.* (*f. ता*) 1 Not arrived, तावद्यस्य भेतत्यं यावद्यम-नागतम् Hit; 2 not obtained; 3 unknown; 4 future. COMP.—

**अवेक्षण** *n.* looking to what is to come or follow.—**आर्तिका** *f.* a young girl not arrived at puberty.—**आवाध** *m.* future bodily pain.—**विधातृ** *m.* One who provides against what is yet to come.

**अनागम** *m.* 1 Non-arrival; 2 non-acquisition.

**अनागस्** *a.* Free from fault or sin, आर्तिकाणाय वः शक्ते न भर्तुमनागसि Sak. i.

**अनाचार** *m.* 1 Bad conduct; 2 violation of religious or civil law.

**अनातप** *a.* Cool, free from heat.

**अनातुर** *a.* (*f. रा*) Not fatigued, ऐजे धर्मनातुरः R. i. 21.

**अनामन्** I *m.* Not self, other than spirit or soul. II *a.* Without spirit or soul. COMP.—

**—ज** *a.* one who does not know self, foolish, Sak. vi.—**—त्व** *a.* one who has no control over his senses.
