

अनुवचन *a.* (*f.* वा) 1 Not excessive, 2 not manifest.

अनुवक्ष *m.* A genealogical table.

अनुवक्र *a.* (*f.* क्रा) Somewhat oblique, (applied to the motion of a planet.)

अनुवचन *n.* Repeating, reciting.

अनुवत्सर *m.* A year.

अनुवर्त्तन *n.* 1 Obliging or gratifying another; 2 compliance, obedience; 3 consequence, result.

अनुवक्ष I *m.* Obedience to the will of another. II *a.* (*f.* क्षा) Obedient.

अनुवाक *m.* A chapter of the Vedas.

अनुवाचन *n.* 1 Causing to recite, teaching; 2 reading to oneself *i. e.* mentally. (It occurs in this sense generally as a stage-direction, नाम-मुद्राभरणानुवाच्य Sak. 1.)

अनुवात *m.* The wind that blows from behind. (अनुवाते to windward.)

अनुवाह *m.* 1 Repeating by way of explanation, explanatory reference to anything already said; 2 that which points to an injunction given before and illustrates it by the way of comment, (*op.* to विधि); 3 report, *e. g.* कृत्स्नार्थानुवादः ' a report of (another's) misdeeds '.

अनुवाद्य *a.* (*f.* द्या) Fit to be the subject or a part of the subject in a sentence (*op.* to विधेय). In a sentence the subject is supposed to be already known and is repeated in order to show its connection with the विधेय or predicate, which affirms or denies something about it : only the predicate conveys some new information

about the उद्देश्य. (अनुवाद्यम-नुक्त्वेव न विधेयमुदीरयेत्).

अनुवारम् *ind.* Time after time, repeatedly.

अनुवास *m.* 1 Perfuming the clothes, 2 an oily enema.

अनुवासन *n.* The same as अनुवास *q. v.*

अनुवृत्ति *f.* Finding, obtaining.

अनुविद्ध *a.* (*f.* द्वा) 1 Inter-mixed, अनुविद्ध इवार्थो हि सर्वः शब्देन भासते V. P. ; 2 hurt, pierced, bored, कीटानुविद्धरत्ना-दिसाधारण्येन काव्यता । दुष्टेष्वपि मतः S. D. 1. ; 3 set (as a jewel), surrounded, inter-twined सरसिजमनुविद्धं शैवलेना-पि रम्यम् Sak. 1.

अनुविधान *n.* 1 Obedience; 2 acting in conformity with.

अनुविनाश *m.* Dying after, perishing after.

अनुवृत्ति *f.* 1 Pleasing another by acting conformably to his will, कान्तानुवृत्तिश्चानुयमप्यस्ति भवतः M. M. ix. ; 2 application or bearing of a preceding rule or its part on a following one; 3 repetition *e. g.* वर्णानामनुवृत्तिरनुप्रासः ' अ० is a repetition of letters. '

अनुवेध *m.* The same as अनुव्याध *q. v.*

अनुवेलम् *ind.* Constantly, continually, इति स्म वृच्छत्यनुवेलमादतः R. iii. 5.

अनुवेश *m. n.* Entering after.

अनुवेशन *n.* The same as अनुवेश *q. v.*

अनुव्यञ्जन *n.* A secondary mark.

अनुव्यवसाय *m.* Perception of a judgment or sentiment, (in Vedānta phil.)

अनुव्याध *m.* 1 Hurting, piercing, न हि कीटानुव्याधादयो रत्नस्य रत्नत्वं व्याहन्तुमीक्षाः S.

D. i. ; 2 obstruction ; 3 contact, Sis. 11. 20.

अनुव्याहरण *n.* 1 A curse, an imprecation ; 2 repeating.

अनुव्याहार *m.* See अनुव्याहरण.

अनुव्रजन *n.* Following, especially a departing guest as a mark of respect.

अनुव्रज्या *f.* The same as अनुव्रजन *q. v.*

अनुव्रत *a.* (*f.* ता) Devout, faithful.

अनुव्रतिक *a.* (*f.* क्रा) 1 Followed by a hundred ; 2 bought for a hundred.

अनुशय *m.* 1 Repentance, regret, Sis. 11. 14 ; 2 deep or intense enmity, यस्मिन्मुक्तानुशया सदैव जागर्ति देशाय... भुजंगी M. M. vi. , शिखुपालोऽनुशयं परं मतः Sis. xvi. 2 ; 3 hatred ; 4 close attachment ; 5 the evil result of an act which clings to it and causes the soul to enter other bodies (in Vedānta phil.) ; 6 rescission, as of sale (in law).

अनुशयाना *f.* One of the heroines described in the rhetorical literature ; a mistress who is overcome with sadness because she apprehends the loss of her lover.

अनुशयिन् *a.* (*f.* नी) 1 Connected as with a consequence, *e. g.* दुःखानुशयी देवः ' hatred brings on sorrow ' ; 2 faithful ; 3 penitent.

अनुशार *m.* A Rākshasa.

अनुशासन *n.* 1 Instruction, precept, advice, भवारोपेण प्रमदाजनोदितं भवत्यविशेष इवानुशासनम् Kir. 1. 28 ; 2 explanation, explanatory treatise, अथ योगानुशासनम् P. Y. 1. 1, नामलिङ्गानुशासनम् Am. 1. 1.

अनुशासिन् *a.* (*f.* नी) 1 Instructor, adviser ; 2 chasti-
