अप्रकरण *n.* Incidental or irrelevant matter.

अप्रकाश I *a.* (*f. धा*) Not bright, dark, e. g. अप्रकाशा दिः सर्वः; 2 wanting in brightness, (*lit.* and *fig.*) प्रकाशाप्रकाश लोकालोक इवाचलः R. 1. 68.

अप्रकृत I *a.* (*f. ता*) 1 Not pertaining to the topic under discussion, irrelevant, किमनेनाप्रकृतेन R. G.; 2 occasional or incidental. II *n.* The standard of comparison i. e. उपाखण (in rhetoric).

अप्रगम *a.* (*f. मा*) Going too fast for others to follow, दूरपतिव्यदप्रगमः परैः.

अप्रगत्य *a.* (*f. त्वा*) Not bold, modest, bashful, e. g. भृष्टः पर्थे वसति नियतं दूरताप्रगत्यः.

अप्रगुण *a.* (*f. आ*) Perplexed.

अप्रजास *a.* Without issue, childless, अतीतायमप्रजासि वा अवास्तदवामुयः Yaj. II. 144.

अप्रजाता *f.* A woman who has not borne a child.

अप्रतिघ *a.* (*f. धा*) 1 What cannot be warded off or hindered; 2 not angry.

अप्रतिहृ *a.* (*f. ता*) Without an adversary, unrivalled, e.g. अप्रतिहृदः सत्यवदे स्थितः पितुः.

अप्रतिपक्ष *a.* (*f. धा*) 1 Without an opponent, without a rival; 2 unlike.

अप्रतिपक्षि *f.* 1 Want of understanding; 2 confusion, perplexity, (अप्रतिपक्षि - उता स्यादेष्टानिदृदर्शनश्चितिः), अप्रतिपक्षिविद्वलानि चेत्रियाणि Kad.; 3 absence of ready wit. (उत्तरस्याप्रतिपक्षिरप्रतिभा Gaut. S.)

अप्रतिबन्ध *a.* (*f. त्वा*) 1 Unobstructed, unimpeded; 2 acquired by birth without

any obstruction, as a दाय (in civil law).

अप्रतिबल *a.* (*f. ला*) Of unequalled power.

अप्रतिभ *a.* (*f. भा*) 1 Modest, bashful; 2 not of ready wit, dull.

अप्रतिभट *a.* (*f. डा*) Unrivalled.

अप्रतिम *a.* (*f. मा*) Unequalled, matchless.

अप्रतिरथ *a.* (*f. धा*) An unrivalled warrior, (having no प्रतिरथ or a rival warrior), दौत्यनिमप्रतिरथं तनयं निवेदय चतुः Sak. 1v.

अप्रतिरथ *a.* (*f. धा*) Free from dispute, uncontested, वर्ष-शताधिकमोगः सन्ततोऽपतिरथः स्व-वै गमयति Mit.

अप्रतिरूप *a.* (*f. पा*) 1 Unequalled in form; 2 incomparable.

अप्रतिरीर्थ (*f. र्या*) Of incomparable valour.

अप्रतिशासन *a.* (*f. ना*) Having no rival in sovereignty, subject to one rule, R. VIII. 27.

अप्रतिष्ठान *n.* Want of solidity or firmness, (*lit.* and *fig.*) तर्काप्रतिष्ठानादप्यच्यथानुभेयम् S. Bh. II.

अप्रतिहत *a.* (*f. ता*) 1 Unimpaired, unaffected, सा द्वाष्टेरप्रतिहता Bhartr. II. 40; 2 unobstructed, unimpeded, जृम्पतामप्रीतहतप्रसरमायैस्य कोध-ज्योतिः Ve. I. COMP.—चित्त *a.* of unimpaired intellect. —नै-ज *a.* with unimpaired eyes.

—प्रसर *a.* having an unimpaired course. (See above 2), —शक्ति *a.* of irresistible power or weapon, गुह इवाप्रति-हतशक्तिः Kad.

अप्रतीत *a.* 1 Not understood, not clearly intelligible (as a word); (This is regarded as a defect of a word in rhe-

toric. A word is defined as being अप्रतीत if it is used in a sense which it may have only in a certain class of works. K. Pr. vii.); 2 not pleased or satisfied.

अप्रस्ता *f.* A girl not yet given in marriage.

अप्रस्त्यक्ष (*f. धा*) 1 Not visible, imperceptible; 2 absent.

अप्रस्त्यय I *a.* (*f. आ*) 1 having no confidence, distrust, बलवदपि शिक्षितानामात्मन्य-प्रस्त्यय चेतः Sak. 1; 2 having no knowledge; 3 having no affix (in gram.) II *m.* 1 Distrust, want of confidence, e. g. कपटशतमर्यं क्षेत्रमप्रस्त्ययानाम् (*scil.* शीरुपम्) Silhana, 'a woman's figure is a field...for all kinds of distrust'; 2 the not being understood, the not resulting clearly; 3 a non-affix (in gram.), अर्थवदधातुरप्रस्त्ययः प्रातिपादिकम् Pan.

अप्रस्तिष्ठन् *ind.* From the left to the right.

अप्रधान *a.* (*f. ना*) Not principal, secondary, subordinate, (*op.* to गौण). आवा तावदप्रधानो Hit. (In most instances the word occurs as a neuter, either as an attribute to a noun or absolutely or as a part of a compound in the sense of 'any thing secondary').

अप्रधृत्य *a.* (*f. ध्या*) Invincible, unconquerable, यदात्रीच भीममत्यन्तघूर्ह इते पार्थेनाहवेष्यप्रधृत्यम् Bh.

अप्रशु *a.* 1 Incompetent, unable, (with the loc. e. g. अप्रश्नेऽप्रशः 'unable to draw up'); 2 not powerful.

अप्रमत्त *a.* (*f. ना*) Assiduous, attentive, vigilant.

अप्रमद *a.* (*f. ता*) Joyless, sad, Bt. x. 9.
