**अमिध** *I a.* (*f.* ध्या ) **1** Not fit for sacrifice, नामेधं प्रक्षियेदनी M. iv. 53; **2** unholy, impure. अमिध्यादपि काश्चन ( प्रासम् ) M. ii. 239. **II n.** **1** Excrement, समुत्सृजेन्प्राज्ञमार्गं यस्त्वमेधमनापदि M. ix. 282; **2** an unlucky woman, *e.g.* अमिधं वृद्धा मृधेमुपति-

**अमोघ** *I a.* (*f.* या ) **1** Unerring, unfailing, infallible, अमोघाः प्रतिगृह्णन्तावर्ष्यानुपदमाशिवः R. i. 44; **2** reaching the mark, धनुष्यमोघं समधत्त सायकम् R. iii. 53, K. S. iii. 65, कामि-रुधेष्वमोघैः Megh. ii. 10; **3** productive, fruitful, यदमोघमपामन्तरुपंवीजमत्र त्वया K. S. ii. 5. **II m.** **1** The name of a river; **2** an epithet of Vishnu. Comp.—**दण्ड** *m.* a name of S'iva.—**दृष्टि** *a.* of unerring mind.—**बल** *a.* of never-failing strength.—**वाच्** *a.* whose words are not vain.—**विक्रम** *a.* of unerring valour.  
**अंब** *In.* The eye. **II ind.** A particle of affirmation.  
**अंबक** *I n.* An eye, (as in श्यंबक ) **II m.** A father.  
**अंबर** *n.* **1** The sky, æther, तावतर्णयदम्बरे R. xii. 41; **2** a garment, दिव्यमाल्याम्बरधरं दिव्यगन्धानुलेपनञ्च Bg. xi. 11, R. iii. 9; **3** tale; **4** saffron; **5** a kind of perfume. Comp.—**अन्त** *m.* **1** the end of a garment; **2** horizon.—**ओक्त्व** *m.* a god, बलिप्यने मौलिभिरम्बरीकसाम् K. S. v. 79.  
**अम्बरि**(री व) *m. n.* **1** A frying-pan; **2** one of the hells. **II m.** **1** A young animal; **2** the sun; **3** a name of Vishnu; **4** a name of S'iva.  
**अम्बह** *I m. pl.* The name of a country and its inhabitants. **II m.** **1** The offspring of a man of Brāhmana and of a woman of Vais'ya tribe, (प्रासणाद्भयकन्यायामम्बहोनामजा-**

येत M. x. 8); **2** an elephant-driver.  
**अम्बहा** *f.* A sort of jasmin; **2** a woman of the Aumbashtha caste, (in this sense also अम्बह्नी ) प्रासणेन वैश्यायामुत्पन्न. अम्बहा Kull.  
**अम्बा** *f.* ( In the first sense the voc. sing. is अम्ब in classical literature. ) **1** A mother (also used as a term of respect), कृताञ्जलिस्तत्र यदम्बसत्यात् R. xiv. 16, किमम्बाभिः प्रेषितः Sak. ii.; **2** a name of Durgā; **3** the name of a daughter of Kās'irāja.  
**अम्बाला** ( डा ) *f.* A mother.  
**अम्बालिका** *f.* **1** A mother (also used as a term of respect); **2** the name of a wife of Vichitraviryā. (See App. II.)  
**अम्बिका** *f.* **1** A mother (also used as a term of respect; for instance, the brother-in-law of the king, kneeling before Vasantasena and making profession of his love, is made to say in Mrich. 'अतिके अम्बिके मुमु म् विष्णुसिम्. ') ; **2** a name of Pārvatī, आसीभिरेधयामासुः पुरपाकाभिराम्विकाम् K. S. vi. 90; **3** the name of a wife of Vichitraviryā. (See App. II.) Comp.—**ईश्वर**, **पति** *m.* a name of S'iva.  
**अम्बिकेय** *m.* A name, **1** of Ganes'a, **2** of Kārtikeya, **3** of Dhritarashtra. ( अम्बिकेय is the more correct form of this word ).  
**अम्बु** *n.* Water, गांगमम्बु सितमम्बु यामुनं कञ्जलाभम् K. Pr. x., अतितराम्बुच्छटा K. Pr. i. R. i. 51, xi. 11. Comp.—**कृप** *m.* **1** a drop of water; **2** a shower.—**कण्ठक**, **किरात** *m.* the short-nosed allegator. **कीरात**, **कुर्म** *m.* a porpoise.—
