चूपा *f.* 1 A leatheren girth for an elephant; 2 sucking.

चूच्य *n.* Any article of food that is to be sucked.

चृत् I *vt.* 6. P (*pres.* चृतति) 1 To hurt, to kill; 2 to tie, to connect together. II *vt. i.* P, 10. U (*pres.* चृतति, चृतयति-ते.) To light, to kindle.

चैकितान *m.* 1 An epithet of S'iva; 2 name of a king.

चेट (उ) *m.* A servant, a slave, e. g. शंगारस्य सहाया विटचेटवि-दृष्टाकायाः स्युः.

चेट (ड) *क* *m.* 1 A servant; 2 a paramour.

चेटिङ्गिका *{f.* A female slave चेटी (जी) *{f.* or servant.

चेतन I *a.* (*f.* नी) Animate, alive, living, feeling. II *m.* 1 A sentient being; 2 a man; 3 soul, mind; 4 the supreme soul. COMP.—अ-चेतन *a.* animate and inanimate, Megh. I. 5.

चेतना *f.* 1 Life, vitality, Bg. xiiii. 6; 2 consciousness, sense, पञ्चात्यायमिनीयामात्मसादभिव चेतना R. xvii. 1, xii. 74; 3 wisdom, reflection.

चेतस् *n.* 1 Consciousness, sense; 2 the thinking soul; 3 the mind, धाराति पश्चादस्तुतं चेतः Sak. I. COMP. चेतो-ज्ञनन्. चेतोभव, चेतोभू *m.* 1 love, passion; 2 the god of love. चेतोभत् *a.* living, sentient. चेतोविकार *m.* disturbance of the mind, emotion. चेतु *ind.* If, although, provided that, उपचारपदं न चोहि-

दं त्वमनंगः कथमक्षता राति: K.S. iv. 9. इति चेतु 'if it be urged that,' e. g. क्रग्वेदमधेयमीत्यादि वाक्यं प्रमाणभिति चेत्र. अयचेत् 'but if.'

चेति *m. pl.* The name of a country, संतु चेदयः। आस्माकदं-तिसाचिधाद्यामनाप्रतभूहः: Sis. ii. 63. COMP.—पति, भूतृ, राज्, राज्, *m.* a name of S'is'upāla, son of Damaghosha, and king of the Chedis, Sis. ii. 96.

चेत्य *a.* (*f.* आ) 1 To be piled up; 2 to be gatherd.

चेल् *vt.* or *vi.* 1. P (*pres.* चेलति) 1 To go, to move; 2 to shake, to be disturbed.

चेल् *n.* 1 A garment; 2 vile, wicked, bad, (at the end of a compound, e. g. धायोचेलम् 'a bad wife'). COMP.—प्रसात-लक *m.* a washerman.

चेलिका *f.* A bodice.

चेष्ट *vt.* or *vi.* 1. A (*pp.* चेष्टि-त; *pres.* चेष्टते) 1 To be endowed with life or vitality, यदा स देहे जगाति तदेदं चेष्टते जगत् M. i. 52; 2 to move the limbs, to stir, to make effort, to be active; 3 to act, to behave. With वि-1 to move, to stir, to be in motion; 2 to act, to behave.

चेष्टक *m.* A particular mode of sexual enjoyment.

चेष्टन *n.* Motion, effort.

चेष्टा *f.* 1 Motion; 2 jester, action, चेष्टा भाषणेऽच | नेववचनविकारैषं लक्ष्यतेऽतगतं मनः M. viii. 26; 3 effort, exertion. COMP.—नाश *m.* destruction of the world. —निरुपण *n.* observing a person's actions.

चेष्टित I *a.* (*f.* ता) Moved, stirred, (*pp.* of चेष्ट, q. v.).

II *n.* 1 Motion, jesture; 2 action, behaviour, कपोलपाद-

लादेशि व भूव रघुचोष्टितम् R. iv. 68.

चैतन्य *n.* 1 Spirit, life, vitality; 2 the supreme spirit considered as the essence of all being and source of all sensation, (in Vedanta Phil.).

चैत्य *m. n.* 1 A pile of stones forming a boundary; 2 a monument, a tomb-stone; 3 a sacrificial shed; 4 a temple; 5 a *Buddha* or *Jaina* temple; 6 the religious fig-tree. See Megh. i. 23. COMP.—तरु, इम्,

चूल *m.* a fig-tree standing on a sacred spot. —पाल *m.* the guardian of a sanctuary. —सुख *m.* an anchorite's water-pot.

चैत्र I *m.* 1 Name of a lunar month in which the full moon stands in the constellation *Chitra'*; 2 a Buddhist mendicant. II *n.* A temple. COMP.—आवलि *f.* the full moon day of *Chaitra*. —सख *m.* an epithet of the god of love.

चैत्ररथ (ध्य) *n.* Name of the garden of Kubera, एको यथो चैत्ररथमदेशात् सौता-ज्यरम्यानपरो विदर्भात् R. v. 60.

चैत्रि *{m.* The lunar month **चैत्रिक** *{f.* Chaitra.

चैत्री *f.* The day of full moon in the month of *Chaitra*.

चैद्य *m.* A name of S'is'upāla, अभिचैद्यं प्रतिष्ठासु: Sis. ii. 1.

चैल *n.* A piece of cloth, a garment. COMP.—धाव *m.* a washerman.

चोक्ष *a.* (*f.* आ) 1 Pure, clean; 2 honest; 3 clever, dexterous; 4 pleasing, agreeable.

चोच *n.* 1 A bark, a rind; 2 a hide; 3 the cocoanut.
