

**अवृधा**, mfn. not rendering prosperous or refreshing (the gods with sacrifices), RV. vii, 6, 3.

**अवृष्टि** á-vr̥iṣṭi, is, f. want of rain, drought (famine), ŠBr. xi; Kauś.; VarBṛS. — **कामा**, mfn. not wishing rain, ĀpŚr.

**अवृह** a-vriha, ās, m. pl. a class of Buddhist divinities, Lalit.

**अवे** avé (✓i), -eti (impf. -ayat; Pot. i. sg. -iyām; pr. p. f. avā-yati, RV. viii, 91, 1) to go down, go down to (acc.), go to, RV.; (Imper. 3. pl. Ā. ávāyatām) to rush down, AV. xi, 10, 8 (cf. ávē); (Imper. ávātū) to go away, RV. v, 49, 5; AV. i, 11, 4; to look upon, consider, Śak.; Vikr.; Bhāṭṭ.; to perceive, conceive, understand, learn, know, MBh. &c.; (with Inf.) Kathās.: Intens. (i. pl. -imāhe) to beg pardon for, conciliate, RV. i, 24, 14 & vii, 58, 5.

**अवेता**, mfn. elapsed, passed, (ádn-, neg.) TS.; one who has gained, obtained (with acc.), Pāṇ. v, 1, 134.

**अवेक्ष** avēksh (✓iksh), avēkshate, to look towards, look at, behold, TS.; ŠBr. &c.; (i. sg. ikshē) to perceive, observe, experience, RV. viii, 79, 9; R.; Bhag. &c.: Ā. (rarely P., e. g. 2. sg. avēkshasi, MBh. ii, 2158) to have in view, have regard to, take into consideration, Mn.; MBh. &c.: Caus. avēkshayati, to cause to look at, Kātyāśr.

**अवेक्षणा**, am, n. looking towards or at, Gaut.; Sāh.; (said of planets) the being in sight, VarBṛS.; the act of considering, attention, observation, Ragh. xiv, 85, &c.

**अवेक्षणीया**, mfn. to be respected, Ragh. xiv, 67.

**अवेक्षाः**, f. observation, care, attention to (loc.), Mn. vii, 101; R.; BhP.

**अवेक्षिताव्या**, mfn. to be observed attentively, Suśr.

**अवेक्षिन**, mfn. looking towards or at, Pañcat.; attentive to (acc.), MBh. v, 1423.

**अवेक्ष्या**, mfn. to be attended to, MBh. ii, 2591; Yājñ. iii, 63; R.

**अवेणि** a-veni, mfn. having no braid of hair, L.; not commingled (as the waters of rivers), L.; single, being by itself, Buddh.; (cf. ávenīka.)

**अवेद** á-veda, ās, m. pl. not the Vedas, ŠBr. xiv. — **विद**, mfn. not knowing the Vedas, GopBr.; Mn. iv, 192. — **विद्वा**, m.(dat. -vidushe)fn. id., MBh. xii, 8967. — **विहिता**, mfn. not prescribed in the Vedas, Mn. v, 43. **अवेदोक्ता**, mfn. id., MBh. xiii, 4397.

i. **अवेदना**, am, n. not knowing, Mn. v, 60.

**अवेदयाना**, mfn. (pr. p. Ā.) not knowing, not ascertaining, Mn. viii, 32.

i. **अवेदि**, is, f. ignorance, BrĀrUp.

**अवेदिन**, mfn. having no knowledge, ŠBr. xiv; BhP.; MārkP.

i. **अवेद्या**, mfn. not to be known, unascertainable, MBh. xii, 11765; (ā), f. (in Sāṅkhya phil.) non-admission of the Ahamkāra.

**अवेदन** 2. a-vedana, mfn. painless, Suśr.

**अवेदि** 2. a-vedi, mfn. without a Vedi or sacrificial altar, Kātyāśr.

**अवेद्या** a-vedya, mf(ā)n. (✓3. vid), not to be married, Mn. x, 24; (as), m. a calf, L.

**अवेध्या** a-vedhya, mfn. unpierceable, not to be pierced, Kathās.

**अवेनत्** á-venat, mfn. not having any wish or desire, RV. x, 27, 16.

**अवेन्व** avēnv (✓inv), (Imper. 2. du. -invatam) to send down (as rain), RV. vii, 64, 2.

**अवेल** a-vela, as, m. (?), denial or concealment of knowledge, L.; (ā), f. wrong time, Lāty.; chewed betel, L.; (am), ind. untimely, Kathās.

**अवेष्टि** á-vēsh̥ti, is, f. (✓yaj), appeasing or expiation by sacrifices, ŠBr.; TBr.

**अवैदिक** a-vaidika, mfn. non-Vedic.

**अवैद्या**, mfn. unlearned, Gaut.; Jaim.

**अवैष** a-vaidha, mfn. not conformable to rule, unprescribed, Comm. on Mn. v, 50 & 55; vi, 31.

**अवैध्या** a-vaidhavya, am, n. non-widowhood, MBh. iii, 16725 & 16873; v, 362.

**अवैभीदक** á-vaihbīdaka, mfn. not having its origin on a Vibhīdaka tree, MaitrS.

**अवैरहत्य** a-vairahatyā, am, n. the non-destruction of men, AV. vi, 29, 3; (a-virahatyā) ĀpŚr.

**अवोक्षण** avōkshāna, am, n. besprinkling, bedewing with (in comp.), Sāy. on ŠBr.; bedewing one's self, Gaut.

**अवोद** avōda, mfn. (Pāṇ. vi, 4, 29), dripping, wet, L.

**अवोदेव** avō-deva. See 2. avás.

**अवोष** avōsha, as, m., N. of a king of ants.

**अवोशिया** or **अवोश्या**, mfn. relating to avōsha, (gāna apūpāḍdi, q. v.)

**अवोह** avōh (✓i. uh), (Pot. ávōhet) to push down, TS. vi.

**अव्या** ávyā, mfn. (said of the woollen Soma strainer) coming from sheep (ávi, q.v.), RV.; (as, am), m. n. the woollen Soma strainer, RV.

**अव्यक्त** a-vyakta, mfn. undeveloped, not manifest, unapparent, indistinct, invisible, imperceptible, Up.; Pāṇ.; Mn. &c.; (in alg.) unknown as quantity or number; speaking indistinctly; (as), m. (= paramātman) the universal Spirit, Mn. ix, 50; N. of Vishṇu, L.; of Śiva, L.; of Kāma, L.; a fool, L.; N. of an Upanishad; (am), n. (in Sāṅkhya phil.) 'the unevolved (Evolver of all things)', the primary germ of nature, primordial element or productive principle whence all the phenomena of the material world are developed, KāṭhaUp.; Sāṅkhya &c.; (am), ind. indistinctly. — **क्रिया**, f. algebraic calculation, L. — **गणित**, n. id. — **गति**, mfn. going imperceptibly. — **पदा**, mfn. inarticulate. — **रङ्गा**, m. dark-red (the colour of the dawn), L. — **राशि**, m. (in alg.) an unknown number or indistinct quantity. — **लक्षणा**, mfn. 'whose marks are imperceptible', N. of Śiva. — **व्यक्ता**, mfn. id. — **सम्या**, n. equation of unknown quantities. **अव्यक्तानुकारणा**, n. the imitating of inarticulated sound, Pāṇ. v, 4, 57 & vi, 1, 98.

**अव्याज्ञा**, mf(ā)n. without the marks of puberty; without consonants, Up.; (as), m. an animal without horns (though of age to have them), L.

**अव्यग्र** a-vyagra, mf(ā)n. unconfused, steady, cool, deliberate, MaitrUp.; MBh. &c.; unoccupied, Uttarar.; not in danger, undisturbed, safe, MBh.; R.; (am), ind. coolly, deliberately, Hariv. 9034; R. &c.

**अव्याङ्ग** 1. a-vyaṅga, mf(ā)n. not mutilated, perfect, Kātyāśr.; BhP. &c.; (ā), f. (for adhyāndā, q.v.) the plant Carpopogon Pruriens Roxb., L. — **ता**, f. the not being mutilated, MBh. xiii, 5599 seqq. **अव्याङ्गांगा**, mf(ā)n. perfect, entire, Mn. iii, 10.

**अव्याङ्ग** 2. avyaṅga, as or am, m. n. the girdle of the Maga priests, BhavP. i; (vyāṅga or viyāṅga) VarBṛS. [cf. Zend aiwyāñhāna].

**अव्यच्चस** á-vyacas, mfn. not spacious, AV. xix, 68, 1.

**अव्यग्रा** avy-añḍā = adhy-a°, q. v., L.

**अव्यत्** á-vyat, mfn. (✓vi; cf. a-vi), only f. °ti, not longing for copulation, RV. x, 95, 5.

**अव्यतिक्रम** a-vyatikrama, as, m. non-transgression, Āp.

**अव्यतिकीर्ण** a-vyatikirṇa, mfn. unmixed, unblended, distinct, separate, L.

**अव्यतिचार** a-vyaticāra, as, m. the absence of mutual permutation, Āśvāśr.

**अव्यतिमोह** á-vyatimoha, as, m. the not confounding by error, ŠBr. xiii.

**अव्यतिरेक** a-vyatireka, as, m. non-exclusion, non-exception, Jaim.; Nyāyad.; (mfn.), (= a-vyabhicārin) unerring, L.

**अव्यतिरेक** a-vyatirekin, mfn. unerring.

**अव्यतिष्ठक्त** á-vyatishakta, mfn. not intermingled, ŠBr. xii.

**अव्यतिष्ठांगम**, ind. without exchanging one for another, ĀpŚr.

**अव्यथ** a-vyatha, mfn. untroubled; intrepid,

Daś.; painless, L.; (as), m. a snake, L.; (ā-vyathā), f. absence of tremor, firmness, VS.; TBr.; the plant Terminalia Citrina Roxb., L.; the plant Hibiscus Mutabilis, L. — **त्वा**, n. painlessness, Bhpr.

**अव्यथामाना**, mfn. not trembling, VS.; TS.

**अव्यथि**, mfn. not tremulous, not unsteady, sure-footed, safe, RV.; unfailing (as help), RV. i, 112, 6; (is), f. sure-footedness, RV.

**अव्यथिन**, mfn., Pāṇ. iii, 2, 157.

**अव्यथिशा**, as, m. the sun, Un.; the ocean, Un.; (i), f. the earth, Un.; night, Un.

**अव्यथिश्याइ**, Ved. Inf. (Pāṇ. iii, 4, 10), for not trembling, for rendering sure-footed, KapS.; (ā-vyāthiśe!) MaitrS.

**अव्यथ्याइ**, mfn. (Pāṇ. iii, 1, 114), unshakable, RV. ii; 35, 5; AitBr.

**अव्यन्त** á-vyanat (4), mfn. not breathing, RV. x, 120, 2.

**अव्यन्त** a-vyanta, mfn. not very distant, growing near (abl.), ĀpŚr.

**अव्यपदेश** a-vyapadeśa, as, m. no designation or pointing to, Āp. — **रुपिन**, mfn. whose shape admits of no name or appellation, BhP.

**अव्यपदेश्या**, mfn. not to be defined, MāṇḍUp.; RāmatUp.

**अव्यपेत** a-vyapēta, mfn. not separated, contiguous, Kāvya.

**अव्यपोद्या** a-vyapōhya, mfn. undeniable, uncontested, Rājat.

**अव्यभिचार** a-vyabhicāra, as, m. non-failure, absolute necessity, Kap. &c.; 'non-deviation,' conjugal fidelity, Mn. ix, 101; non-transgression, Mn. viii, 122; (mfn.) constant, Bhag. xiv, 26; (āt, ena), ind. with absolute necessity, Pāṇ. Kāś. & Sch. — **वत्**, mfn. absolutely determined, inevitable, MBh. ii, 871.

**अव्याभिचारिन**, mfn. not going astray, unfailing, Śak.; Rājat. &c.; steady, permanent, MBh. xiv, 1111; Bhag. xiii, 10, &c.; faithful, Kathās. &c.

**अव्यय** 1. avyāya or rarely ávyaya [only RV. viii, 97, 2 & ix, 86, 34], mfn. (āvi) made of sheep's skin (as the woollen Soma strainer), RV.; belonging to or consisting of sheep, RV. viii, 97, 2.

**अव्यय** 2. a-vyaya, mf(ā)n. not liable to change, imperishable, undecaying, Up.; Mn. &c.; 'not spending,' parsimonious; (as), m. N. of Vishṇu or Śiva, L.; of a son of Manu Raivata, Hariv. 433; of a Nāga demon, MBh. i, 2157 (ed. Bomb.); the non-spending, parsimony; (am), n. [or (as), m., L.] an indeclinable word, particle, Pāṇ.; APrāt. &c.; (in Vedānta) a member or corporeal part of an organized body, L. — **त्वा**, n. imperishableness, Hit. (v. 1.); the state of an indeclinable word, Pat. — **वत्**, mfn. consisting of an indeclinable word, Pat. **अव्यायात्मन्**, mfn. imperishable, VP. **अव्यायी-भावा**, m. 'unchangeable state,' an indeclinable compound, Pāṇ.; (avyayībhāva)-samāsa, m. id., Pāṇ. i, 1, 41, Sch.

**अव्यर्ण** a-vyarna, mfn. (✓ard; cf. Pāṇ. vii, 2, 24) unoppressed, Bhāṭṭ.

**अव्यर्थ** a-vyarthā, mfn. not useless, profitable, fruitful; effectual, efficacious.

**अव्यर्घुक** a-vyārdhuka, mfn. not losing anything (instr.), TS.; TBr.

**अव्यर्घ्दा**, mfn. undiminished, ŠBr. xii.

**अव्यर्घ्दि**, is, f. no ill-success, AV. x, 2, 10.

**अव्यलीक** a-vyālīka, mfn. having no uneasiness or unpleasantness; well off, MBh. v, 698; not false, true, veracious, BhP.; Daśar.; (am), ind. truly, BhP.

**अव्यवच्छन्न** á-vyavacchinna, mfn. uninterrupted, ŠBr. & AitBr. (together with sāṃtata); Hariv. 3580; (am), ind. or in comp. avyavacchinna-[MBh. vii, 4746] uninterruptedly.
