

Kulāyin, mfn. forming a nest, shaped like a nest, RV. vi, 15, 16; VS.; TS.; (*inī*), f. an aviary, Gal.; N. of a liturgical service, TāṇḍyaBr.; Lāty.; Comm. on Nyāyam.

कुलायन् *kulāyana*. See *kūla*.

कुलाल *kūlālā*, as, m. (fr. *√kul*, Uṇ. i, 117), a potter, VS. xvi, 27; Pāṇ.; Bhartṛ. &c.; a wild cock (Phasianus gallus), L.; an owl, L.; N. of a prince, VP.; (*i*), f. the wife of a potter, Rājat. viii, 138; (= *kulatthā*) the plant Glycine labialis, L.; a blue stone applied as a collyrium to the eyes, L. — **कुकुता**, m. a wild cock (Phasianus gallus), VarBrS. — **कृता** (*kūlō*), mfn. made by a potter, MaitrS. i, 8, 3. — **काक्रा**, n. a potter's disk, BhP. v, 22, 2. — **वात**, ind. like a potter. — **साला**, f. a potter's workshop, JābālaUp.

कुलालिका *kulālikā*, for *°lāyikā*, q. v.

कुलाह *kulāha*, as, m. a horse of a light-brown colour with black knees, L.

कुलाहका, as, m. a lizard, chameleon, L.; the plant Celsia coromandelina, L.

कुलाहल *kulāhala*, as, m., N. of a plant (= *alambusha*, *gocchāla*, *bhū-kadamba*, commonly Kokāśīmā, *Coryza terebinthina* or *Celsia coromandelina* [see *kulāhaka*], a plant which dogs are fond of smelling before they expel urine), Suśr.

कुलि *kuli*, is, m. the hand, L.; (*is*), f. (= *°li*) Solanum Jacquinii (prickly nightshade), L.

कुलिक *kulika*. See *kūla*.

कुलिङ्क *kulinkaka*. See *°lingaka*.

कुलिंग *ku-linga*, *°ngaka*. See 1. *ku*.

कुलिज *kulija*, am, n. a particular vessel, Kāś. 12 & 43; a sort of measure, Pāṇ. v, 1, 55 (ifc. f. *ā* [Kāś.] or *i*).

Kulijika, mf(*i*)n. ifc. fr. *kulija*, Pāṇ. v, 1, 55. **Kulijina**, mf(*ā*)n. id., ib.

कुलिन् *kulin*. See *kūla*.

कुलिन्द *kulinda*, ās, m. pl., N. of a people, MBh.; (*as*), m. a prince of the Kulindas, ib. **Kulindopatyaka**, ās, m. pl., N. of a people, MBh. vi, 363.

कुलिर *kulira*, for *°līra*, q. v., L.

कुलिश *kulisa*, as, m. (fr. 1. *ku* and *liša* for *riša* fr. *√riš*), an axe, hatchet, RV. i, 32, 5 & iii, 2, 1; AV.; MBh.; (*am*), n. [*as*, m., Naigh.; Nir. & L.] the thunderbolt of Indra, MBh.; Ragh.; Bhartṛ. &c.; (= *vajra*) a diamond, Megh.; Rājat. vi, 273; (*as*), m. a sort of fish, Suśr.; (*as*, *am*), m. n. the plant Heliotropium indicum, L.; (*i*), f., N. of a river (supposed to be in the middle region of the sky), RV. i, 104, 4. — **द्रुमा**, m. a sort of Opuntia tree, Npr. — **धरा**, m. ‘holding the thunderbolt,’ N. of Indra, VarBrS. — **नायका**, m. a kind of coitus. — **पानि**, m. = *-dhara*, Śiś. xi, 43. — **भृत**, m. = *-dhara*, VarBrS. — **लेपा**, m. = *vajra-p*, q. v., VarBrS. **Kulisāñkusā**, f., N. of one of the sixteen Vidyā-devis, L. **Kulisāsana**, m. ‘having a diamond seat,’ N. of Śākyā-muni, L.

Kulisāya, Nom. Ā. *°yate*, to be equal to the thunderbolt or to a diamond (in hardness), Hcar.

कुलिशासन *kulisāsana* = *kulisāsana*, q. v. (s.v. *kulisa*) or = *kuli-sāsana*, ‘one who commands with his hand (*kuli*)’, N. of Śākyā-muni, L.

कुली *kuli*. See *kūla*.

कुलीकय *kulikāya*, as, m. a kind of aquatic animal, TS. v, 5, 13, 1; (*kulipāya*) VS. xxiv, 21 & 35. **कुलिका**, f. a kind of bird, VS. xxiv, 24.

कुलीन *kulina*, &c. See *kūla*.

कुलीनस *kulinasa*, am, n. water, L.

कुलोपय *kulipāya*. See *°likāya*.

कुलीर *kulira*, as, m. a crab, Suśr.; Pañcat.; the sign of the zodiac Cancer, R. i, 19, 8; VarBr. — **विशानिका**, f. a kind of oak-apple, Bhpr. — **श्रिंगी**, f. id., ib. **Kulirād**, m. ‘eating i.e. destroying crabs,’ a young crab (the old crab being supposed to perish on producing young), L.

Kuliraka, as, m. a small crab, Pañcat.

कुलीश *kulīsha*, as, am, m. n. (= *kuliša*) Indra's thunderbolt, L.

कुलुक *kuluka*, am, n. the fur or foulness of the tongue, L. (v.l. *kulvaka*).

कुलुङ्गा *kulukka-guijā*, f. (for *ulkā-g*?) a firebrand, L.

कुलुङ्गा *kulunga*, as, m. (= *kulaṅgā*) an antelope, VS. xxiv; TS. v.

कुलुच्च *ku-luñcā*. See 1. *ku*.

कुलूत *kulūta*, ās, m. pl., N. of a people, VarBrS.; Kād. &c.

कुलूतका, ās, m. pl. id., VarBrS.; (*as*), m. sg. a Kulūta man, Pratāpar.

कुलून *kulūna*, N. of a place, gaṇa *kacchādi* (Kāś.)

कुलेचर *kule-cara*, &c. See *kūla*.

कुल्फ *kulphā*, as, m. (= *gulphā*; √3. *kal*, Un.) the ankle, RV. vii, 50, 2; ŠBr. xi; (*as*, *am*), m. n. a disease, L. — **दग्धना**, mfn. reaching down to the ankle, ŠBr. xii.

कुल्मल *kúlmala*, am, n. the part of an arrow or spear by which the head is attached to the shaft, MaitrS.; AV. (once *kírmala*); ŠBr. iii; sin, Un. iv, 189. — **बर्हिशा**, m., N. of a Vedic poet (author of RV. x, 126), RAnukr. — **बर्हिस**, m. id., TāṇḍyaBr. xv.

कुल्माष *kulmāsha*, as, m. (also ās, m. pl.) sour gruel (prepared by the spontaneous fermentation of the juice of fruits or of boiled rice), Suśr.; an inferior kind of grain, half-ripe barley, ChUp.; BhP. v, 9, 12; Bhpr.; (*as*), m. a kind of disease, L.; (*am*), n. sour gruel, L.; forced rice, L.; a sort of Phaseolus (= *rāja-māshā*), L.; a species of Dolichos (= *yāvaka*), L.; (*i*), f., N. of a river, Hariv. 9507. — **खादा**, mfn. eating sour gruel, Pāṇ. iii, 2, 81, Kāś. **Kulmāshabhishuta**, n. sour gruel, L.

कुल्मि *kulmī*, is, m. or f. a herd, TS. ii.

कुल्य 1. *kulya*, 1. *kulyā*. See *kūla*.

कुल्य 2. *kúlya*, mfn. (fr. 2. *kulyā*), presiding over a river (as a deity), VS. xvi, 37.

2. **कुल्या**, f. a small river, canal, channel for irrigation, ditch, dyke or trench, RV.; VS.; AV. &c.; (ifc. f. *ā*) Ragh. vii, 46; N. of a river, MBh. xiii, 1742.

कुल्या, Nom. Ā. *°yate*, to become a river, Bhartṛ. ii, 78.

3. **कुल्या**, am, n. a receptacle for bones (left from a burnt corpse), MBh. i, 150, 13; Hariv. 2098; a bone, L.; flesh, L.; a winnowing basket, L.; a measure of eight Dronas, L.

कुल्लुक *kulluka*, as, m., N. of a celebrated commentator on Manu (he was born in Gaur, and lived about 300 years ago); (*ā*), f. (with Śāktas) N. of certain syllables preceding a Mantra. — **भट्टा**, m. title given to the commentator Kullūka.

कुल्व *kulva*, mfn. bald, KātySr.; (cf. *áti-k*º). [Lat. *calvus*.]

कुल्वक *kulvaka*. See *kuluka*.

कुल्हरिका *kulharikā*, f. a pot, Bhpr.

कुल्हरी, f. id., ib.

कुव *kuva*, am, n. a water-lily, lotus, L.; (cf. *kuvala*, &c.)

कुवकालुका *kuvakālukā*, f., N. of a vegetable (= *gholī-sāka*), L.

कुवक्र *ku-vakra*, &c. See 1. *ku*.

कुवम *kuvama*, as, m. the sun [Comm.], MBh. xiii, 4486.

कुवय *kuvāya*, as, m. (= *kvāyi*) a kind of bird, MaitrS. iii, 14, 20.

कुवर *kuvara*, mfn. (= *tuv*º) astringent in flavour, L.; (*i*), f. a sort of fish, Gal.

कुवर्त्मन् *ku-vartman*, &c. See 1. *ku*.

कुवल *kúvala*, as, ī, m. f. (gaṇa *gaurādi*) the jujube tree (Zizyphus Jujuba), L.; (*am*), n. the fruit of that tree, Kāṭh.; VS.; ŠBr.; KātySr.; (= *ku-*

valaya) the water-lily, Kathās. lili, 88; a pearl, L.

— **कुपा**, m. the time when the tree Zizyphus Jujuba bears fruits, gaṇa *pīlv-ādi*. — **प्रस्था**, m., N. of a town, gaṇa *karky-ādi* (v.l. for *kurala-pr*º).

— **सक्तु**, avas, m. pl. Jujuba fruits and barley grains, ŠBr. xii. **कुवलास्वा**, m., N. of the prince Dhundhumāra, MBh. iii, 13486; Hariv. 671; (vv. ll. *kubal'*, *kuvalayāsva* and *°svaka*, q. v.) **कुवलेस्या**, m. ‘resting on a water-lily,’ N. of Vishṇu, MBh. xiii, 7012.

कुवलय 1. *kuvalaya*, am, n. the water-lily (especially the blue variety, the flower of which opens at night), MBh.; Suśr.; Megh. &c.; (ifc. f. *ā*) Kathās.; (*as*), m., N. of the horse of Kuvalayāsva, MärkP.; (cf. *kuvala*). — **द्रिस**, f. ‘lotus-eyed,’ a handsome woman, Bhartṛ.; Sāntiś. &c. — **नायना**, f. id., Mālav. — **पुरा**, n., N. of a town. — **मया**, mfn. consisting of blue water-lilies, Prasannar.

— **माला**, f., N. of a mare, Kathās. — **वती**, f. ‘possessing water-lilies,’ N. of a princess, Kathās. lxx, 215. **कुवलयादित्या**, m., N. of a prince (= *yāpīda*), Rājat. iv, 355. **कुवलयानन्दा**, m., N. of a work on rhetoric by Apya-dikṣita. **कुवलयापीदा**, m., N. of a prince (= *yāditya*), Rājat. iv, 362 ff.; N. of a Daitya (who, changed to an elephant, became the vehicle of Kansa), Hariv.; Git.; N. of an elephant, Kathās. cxiii, 19. **कुवलयावली**, f., N. of a princess, Kathās. xx, 49. **कुवलयास्वा**, m., N. of the prince Dhundhumāra, VP.; N. of the prince Pratardana, MärkP. (v.l. *kubal'*); BhP. ix, 17, 6; -*caritra*, n. ‘the adventures of Kuvalayāsva,’ N. of a Prākṛit poem (composed by Viśvanātha Kavi-rāja), Sāh. **कुवलयास्वाका**, m., N. of the prince Dhundhumāra, BhP. ix, 6, 21. **कुवलयास्विया**, n. the story of Kuvalayāsva, MärkP.

कुवलयिता, mfn. (gaṇa *tārakādi*) decorated with water-lilies, Ragh. xi, 93.

कुवलयिनी, f. an assemblage of water-lilies, place abounding with them, L.

कुवलय 2. *ku-valaya*. See 2. *ku*.

कुवस्त्र *ku-vastra*, &c. See 1. *ku*.

कुवाट *kuvāṭa*, as, m. = *kav*º, L.

कुवाटका, as, m. id., Gal.

कुवाद *ku-vāda*, &c. See 1. *ku*.

कुवित्स *kuvīt-sa*; m. (fr. *kuvid*), any one, an unknown person, RV. vi, 45, 24.
