

कौकुण्डिहि *kaukuṇḍihi*, is, m., N. of a Rishi.

कौकुण्टक *kaukuntaka*. See °*kuṭṭaka*.

कौकुर *kaukura*, ās, m. pl. (fr. *kukura*), N. of a people, MBh. ii, 1804 & 1871; xvi, 134.

कौकुरिड *kaukurūḍi*, is, m., N. of a teacher, SamhUp. v.

कौकुलिका *kaukulikā*, f., N. of one of the mothers in Skanda's retinue, MBh. ix, 2633.

कौकुवादि *kaukuvādi*, is, m. patr. (fr. *ku-kuvāda* = -*vāc*?), Pravar.

कौकुस्त *kaukustā*, as, m., N. of a man, ŚBr. iv.

कौकृत्य *kaukritya*, am, n. (fr. *ku-kṛita* or -*kṛitya*), evil doing, wickedness, L.; repentance, L.

कौकुट *kaukkuṭa*, mfn. (fr. *kukk*°), relating to a cock or domestic fowl, gallinaceous, R. ii, 91, 65; Suśr.; (am), n. (scil. *āsana*) a particular manner of being seated, NārP.

कौकुटिका, m. a poulterer, one who sells fowls, L.; a kind of low caste, Kāraṇḍ.; (Pāṇ. iv, 4, 46) a kind of mendicant who walks with his eyes fixed on the ground for fear of treading upon insects &c., L.; a hypocrite, L.; a pigeon, L.

कौकुटि-कण्डला, as, m. a species of snake, L.; (cf. *kukkuṭābha* and °*tāhi*.)

कौकुडिवहा, am, n., N. of a village of the Bāhikas, Pāṇ. iv, 2, 104, Vārtt. 26 (v. l. °*kkuṭiv*°).

कौकुडिवहका, mfn. coming from that village, ib. (v. l. °*kkuṭiv*°).

कौकुश *kauksha*, mfn. (fr. *kukshī*), abdominal, ventral, Pāṇ. iv, 2, 96, Kāś.

कौकुशका, mfn., gaṇa *dhūmādi*.

कौकुशेया, mfn. being in the belly, Pāṇ. iv, 3, 56; (as), m. 'sheathed,' a sword, Bhaṭṭ. iv, 31.

कौकुशेया, as, m. (Pāṇ. iv, 2, 96) 'being in a sheath,' a sword, Daś.; Pratāpar.; a scymitar, knife, Kād.

कौकुका *kauṅka*, as, m. the country Koṅka (= *koṅkaṇa*), L.

कौकुका, ās, m. pl. (= *koṅk*°), N. of a people, MBh. vi, 367 (*koṅk*°, ed. Bomb.); VarBrS. xvi, 11.

कौकुकाण्डभृता, mfn. coming from Koṅkaṇa (as a horse of good breed), Gal.; (cf. *koṅkaṇa*.)

कौकुकिणा, ās, m. pl. = °*kaṇa*, L.

कौकुम *kauṅkuma*, mf(i)n. consisting of saffron (*kuṅkuma*), Hcat.; dyed with saffron, Hariv. 7072; of saffron colour, Viddh.; (ās), m. pl., N. of sixty particular Ketus, VarBrS. xi, 21.

कौकुवारा *kaukavāra*, as, m. patr. fr. *kūcavāra*, gaṇa *biddādi*.

कौकुवारीया, mfn. coming from Kūcavāra, Pāṇ. iv, 3, 94.

कौकुहस्ति *kaukahasti*, is, m. patr. fr. *kūcahastā*, Saṃskārak. (pl.)

कौकुपाक *kaukā-pāka*, as, m. a kind of decoction.

कौकुमारयोग *kaukumāra-yoga*, as, m. (fr. *kuc*°), a particular art (*kalā*), BhP. x, 45, 36, Sch.

कौकुज *kauja*, mfn. (fr. *ku-ja*), relating or belonging to the planet Mars, VarBr. viii, xviii, xxiv; (said of Tuesday), Viṣṇu. lxxviii, 3.

कौकुजा, as, m. patr. fr. *kuja-pa*, Pāṇ. vi, 2, 37.

कौकुञ्च *kauñca*, as, m. (for *krañca*?), N. of a mountain (part of the Himālaya range), L.; (ī), f., N. of a locality, Romakas. **कौकुञ्चद्री**, m. the Kauñca mountain, Bālar.

कौकुञ्चिकी, f. (with Kaulas) one of the eight A-kulas, Kulārṇ.

कौकुञ्जर *kauñjara*, mf(i)n. (fr. *kuñj*°), belonging to an elephant, MBh. xii, 8932 (= xiii, 5580); BhP. viii, 4, 12; (am), n. a particular method of sitting, NārP.

कौकुञ्जयान *kauñjāyana*, ās, m. pl. (fr. *kuñja*), N. of a mountain tribe (descended from Kuñja), Pāṇ. iv, 1, 98 & v, 3, 113; (ī), f. a princess of that tribe (or the wife of a Brāhman or of any venerable personage belonging to that tribe, L.), ib.

कौकुञ्जयान्या, as, m. a prince of the Kauñjāyanas, ib.

कौकुञ्जि, m. patr. fr. *kuñja*, Pāṇ. iv, 1, 98, Kāś.

कौट 1. *kauṭa*, mfn. (fr. *kuṭi*), living in one's own house, independent, free, Pāṇ. v, 4, 95; (as), m. (= *kuṭa-ja*) *Wrightia antidysenterica*, Bhpr. i, 206. — **तक्ष**, m. an independent carpenter (who works at home on his own account and not for a village or corporation), Pāṇ. v, 4, 95. — **फला**, n. a fruit of *kauṭa*, Car. viii, 11.

कौताजा, mfn. coming from the plant *Wrightia antidysenterica* (*kuṭa-ja*), Suśr.; (as), m. the plant *Wrightia antidysenterica*, Bhpr. iii, 159.

कौताजभारिका, mfn. (fr. *kuṭaja-bhāra*), carrying or bearing a load of *Wrightia antidysenterica*, gaṇa *vanśādi*.

कौताजिका, mfn. id., ib.

कौतायाना, as, m. patr. fr. *kuṭa*, gaṇa *śivādi*.

कौति, is, m. id., g. *kraudy-ādi* (not in Kāś.)

1. **कौत्या**, as, m. id., gaṇa *kurv-ādi*; (ā), f. of *kuṭi*, gaṇa *kraudy-ādi* (not in Kāś.)

कौट 2. *kauṭa*, mfn. (fr. *kūṭa*), fraudulent, dishonest; snared, wired, W.; (am), n. fraud, falsehood, W. — **सक्षिन्**, m. a false witness (= *kūṭa-s*°), Comm. on Yājñ. — **सक्ष्या**, n. false evidence, Gaut.; Mn. viii, 117 & 122 f.; xi, 56.

कौताकिका, mfn. one whose occupation is to catch animals in traps or caves &c., L.; (as), m. a vendor of the flesh of birds or beasts, hunter, poacher, butcher, &c., L.

कौतास्थ्या, am, n. the state of being *kūṭa-stha*, i. e. uniform or unchangeable, Sarvad.; Sch. on Śaṃk. on Bādar. ii, 2, 10.

कौतिका, mfn. (gaṇa *kumudādi*; = *kautakika*) one whose business is to catch animals in traps &c., L.; relating to a snare or trap, W.; fraudulent, dishonest, W.; (as), m. one who kills animals and sells their flesh for his own subsistence, poacher, L.

कौतिया, mfn., gaṇa *kṛisāśvādi*.

2. **कौत्या**, mfn., gaṇa *saṃkāsādi*.

कौतभी *kauṭabhī*, for *kauṭ*°, q. v.

कौतलि *kauṭali*, is, m. patr., Saṃskārak.

कौताल्या, as, m. (for °*ṭilya*), N. of Cāṇakya, L.

कौतवी *kauṭavī*, f. = *koṭ*°, a naked woman, L.

कौतास्थ्य *kauṭasthya*. See 2. *kauṭa*.

कौतायन *kauṭāyana*, °ṭi. See 1. *kauṭa*.

कौतिक *kauṭika*. See 2. *kauṭa*.

कौतिया *kauṭiryā*, v. l. for °*ṭiryā*.

कौतिलिक *kauṭilika*, as, m. (fr. *kuṭilikā*; Pāṇ. iv, 4, 18) 'deceiving the hunter [or the deer, Sch.] by particular movements,' a deer ['a hunter,' Sch.], Kāś.; 'using the tool called *kuṭilikā*,' a blacksmith, ib.

कौतिया, as, m. (fr. *kuṭila*), N. of Cāṇakya, Daś.; Mudr.; N. of a grammarian (?), Hemac.; Mallin. on Kum. vi, 37 & on Ragh. iii f., xv & xvii f.; (am), n. crookedness, curvature, curliness of the hair, Pāṇ. iii, 1, 23; Pañcat.; falsehood, dishonesty, Pañcat.; Rājat.; a kind of horse-radish, L. — **सास्त्रा**, n. Cāṇakya's doctrine (diplomacy), Kād.

कौटीगव *kauṭīgava*, mfn. fr. °*vya*, gaṇa *kaṇvādi*.

कौटीगव्या, m. patr. fr. *kuṭi-gu*, g. *gargādi*.

कौटीय *kauṭīya*. See 2. *kauṭa*.

कौटीर *kauṭīra*, mfn. belonging to or made from the plant *Kuṭira*, gaṇa *bilvādi*.

कौटिर्या, f. 'living in a hut (? *kuṭīra*),' N. of Durgā, Hariv. 10245 (v. l. °*ṭiryā*).

कौटुम्ब *kauṭumba*, mfn. (fr. *kuṭ*°), necessary for the household, ĀśvGr. ii, 6, 10; (am), n. family relationship, Rājat. v, 395.

कौटुम्बिका, mfn. belonging to or constituting a family, BhP. v, 14, 3; (as), m. the father or master of a family, BhP. iv, 28, 12 & v, 13, 8.

कौटुम्ब्या *kauṭumbya*, am, n. (fr. *kuṭṭanī*), the procuring of women for immoral purposes, Rājat. vii, 289 & 297.

कौट्य 1. & 2. *kauṭya*. See 1. & 2. *kauṭa*.

कौठार *kauṭhāra*, as, m. patr. fr. *kuṭhāra*, gaṇa *śivādi*.

कौठारिकेया, as, m. metron. fr. *kuṭhārikā*, gaṇa *śubhrādi*.

कौठुम *kauṭhuma*, mf(i)n. fr. *kuṭhumi*, W.; (cf. *kauṭhuma*.)

कौडविक *kauḍavika*, mf(i)n. (Kāś. on Pāṇ. v, 1, 52 & vii, 3, 17) sown with a *Kuḍava* of grain (as a field &c.), containing a *Kuḍava*, Car. vi, 17.

कौडेयक *kauḍeyaka*, mfn. fr. *kudyā*, gaṇa *kattry-ādi*.

कौडोदरि *kauḍodari*, is, m. (for *kauṇḍ*°? fr. *kuṇḍōdara*), N. of a man, Pravar.

कौड्य *kauḍya*, v. l. for *koḍya*, q. v.

कौणकुत्स *kaunakutsya*, as, m. (cf. *kūṇa-kuccha*), N. of a Brāhman, MBh. i, 962.

कौणप *kaunapa*, mfn. (fr. *kūṇ*°), coming from corpses, Bālar.; (as), m. 'feeding upon corpses,' a Rākshasa or goblin, MBh. i, 6450; Śak. (v. l.); BhP. x, 12, 29; N. of a Nāga (these beings are supposed to eat human flesh), MBh. i, 2147. — **दन्ता**, m., N. of Bhīshma (uncle of the Pāṇḍus), L. **कौणपāsana**, m., N. of a Nāga, MBh. i, 1559.

कौणिन्द *kauninda*, ās, m. pl. (v. l. *kaulin-da*, q. v.), N. of a people, VarBrS. xiv, 30; (as), m. a prince of that people, ib. 33.

कौणिय *kauneyā*, as, m. (fr. *kuṇi*), patr. of Rajana, TS. ii, 3, 8, 1; TāṇḍyaBr. xiii, 4, 11; (*koṇeya* & °*yana*) Kāth. xi, 1.

कौणरव्य *kaunṭharavya*, as, m. patr. fr. *kuṇṭha-rava*, AitĀr.

कौण्ठ्या, am, n. (fr. *kuṇṭha*), bluntness, VarBrS. 1, 26.

कौण्डपायिन *kaunḍapāyina*, mfn. with *ayana*, N. of a Soma libation (= *kunḍa-pāyinām ay*°), Lāṭy.; *kaunḍapāyinām ay*° for °*nam ay*° or for *kunḍa-pāyinām ay*°, ŚāṅkhŚr. xiii, 24, 1; Lāṭy. i, 4, 23, Sch.; KātyŚr. iv, 1, 1, Sch.; Bādar. iii, 3, 40, Sch.

कौण्डल *kaunḍala*, mfn. (fr. *kuṇḍ*°), furnished with rings, gaṇa *ḥyotsnādi*.

कौण्डालिका, mfn. id., gaṇa *kumudādi*.

कौण्डाग्नक *kaunḍāgnaka*, v. l. for *kāṇḍ*°.

कौण्डायाना, mfn. fr. *kuṇḍa*, gaṇa *pakshādi*.

कौण्डिन *kaunḍina*, mfn. fr. °*nya*, gaṇa *kaṇvādi*; (ī), f. of °*nya*, see *pārāsari-kaunḍinī-pūtra*.

कौण्डिनेयक *kaunḍineyaka*, mfn. fr. *kuṇḍina*, gaṇa *kattry-ādi*.

कौण्डिन्या, as, m. patr. fr. *kuṇḍina* (or metron. fr. *kuṇḍinī*, gaṇa *gargādi*), ŚBr. xiv; ĀśvŚr.; Pravar.; MBh. ii, 111; Lalit.; Divyāv. xxxii; N. of an old grammarian, TPrāt. i, 5 & ii, 5 ff.; (*vyākaraṇa*-) Buddh.; of Jaya-deva; (cf. *vidarbhī-k*° and *ājñā-ta-k*°); mfn. coming from *Kuṇḍina*, Prasannar.

कौण्डिन्याका, am, n., N. of a Kalpa-sūtra, Comm. on Jaini. i, 3, 11.

कौण्डिन्यायाना or °*nā*, as, m. patr. fr. °*nya*, ŚBr. xiv, 5, 5, 20 & 7, 3, 26.

कौण्डिला, °*lya*, for °*nya*, Lalit.; Hit.

कौण्डिल्यक *kaunḍilyaka*, as, m. a kind of venomous insect, Suśr.

कौण्डिवृष *kaunḍi-vṛiṣha*, ās, m. pl. = *kuṇḍi-viṣha*, MBh. vi, 2410 (*kuṇḍ*°, ed. Bomb.)

कौण्डिवृषि, ?, Pāṇ. vi, 3, 34, Vārtt. 4, Pat.

कौण्डिवृष्या, ?, ib.; (cf. *koṭi-varsha*.)

कौण्डोदरि *kaunḍōdari*. See *kauḍ*°.

कौण्डोपारथा, ās, m. pl., N. of a warrior-tribe, Pāṇ. v, 3, 116.

कौण्डोपारथिया, a prince of that tribe, ib.

कौण्य *kaunya*, am, n. (fr. *kuṇi*), paralysis of the hands, Suśr.

कौत *kauta*, v. l. for *koḍya*, q. v.

कौतप *kautapa*, mfn. fr. *ku-tapa*, gaṇa *ḥyotsnādi*.

कौतस्तुत *kautaskuta*, mfn. fr. *kuṭaḥ kuṭaḥ*, gaṇa *kāśādi*.

कौतस्त *kautasta*, as, m. patr. fr. *kuṭasta*, TāṇḍyaBr. xxv, 15, 3.
