

कौकुण्डिहि kaukundihi, *is, m.*, N. of a Rishi.

कौकुन्तक kaukuntaka. See ^okutṭaka.

कौकुर kaukura, *ās*, m. pl. (fr. *kukura*), N. of a people, MBh. ii, 1804 & 1871; xvi, 134.

कौकुरुण्डि kaukurundi, *is, m.*, N. of a teacher, SaṁhUp. v.

कौकुलिका kaukulikā, *f.*, N. of one of the mothers in Skanda's retinue, MBh. ix, 2633.

कौकुवादि kaukuvādi, *is, m.* patr. (fr. *kukku-vāda* = *vāc* ?), Pravar.

कौकुस्त kaukustā, *as, m.*, N. of a man, ŠBr. iv.

कौकृत्य kaukritya, *am, n.* (fr. *ku-kṛita* or *-kṛitya*), evil doing, wickedness, L.; repentance, L.

कौकुट kaukkuta, mfn. (fr. *kukkō*), relating to a cock or domestic fowl, gallinaceous, R. ii, 91, 65; Suśr.; (*am*), n. (scil. *āsana*) a particular manner of being seated, NārP.

Kaukkuti, *ka*, m. a poultreer, one who sells fowls, L.; a kind of low caste, Kāraṇḍ.; (Pāṇ. iv, 4, 46) a kind of mendicant who walks with his eyes fixed on the ground for fear of treading upon insects &c., L.; a hypocrite, L.; a pigeon, L.

Kaukkuti-kandala, *as, m.* a species of snake, L.; (cf. *kukkuṭabha* and ^oṭāhi.)

Kaukuḍīvaha, *am, n.*, N. of a village of the Bāhikas, Pāṇ. iv, 2, 104, Vārtt. 26 (v.l. ^okkuti^{iv}).

Kaukkudīvahaka, mfn. coming from that village, ib. (v.l. ^okkuti^{iv}).

कौक्षि kaukṣha, mfn. (fr. *kukṣhi*), abdominal, ventral, Pāṇ. iv, 2, 96, Kāś.

Kaukshaka, mfn., gaṇa *dhūmāddi*.

Kauksheya, mfn. being in the belly, Pāṇ. iv, 3, 56; (*as*), m. 'sheathed,' a sword, Bhaṭṭ. iv, 31.

Kauksheyaka, *as, m.* (Pāṇ. iv, 2, 96) 'being in a sheath,' a sword, Daś.; Pratāpar.; a scymitar, knife, Kād.

कौक्षि kaunika, *as, m.* the country Koṅka (= *koṅkāna*), L.

Kauṅkāna, *ās*, m. pl. (= *koṅkō*), N. of a people, MBh. vi, 367 (*koṅkō*, ed. Bomb.); VarBrS. xvi, 11.

Kauṅkāṇḍabhūta, mfn. coming from Koṅkāna (as a horse of good breed), Gal.; (cf. *koṅkāna*.)

Kauṅkiṇa, *ās*, m. pl. = ^okāṇa, L.

कौकुम kaunkuma, mf(i)n. consisting of saffron (*kuṇkuma*), Hcat.; dyed with saffron, Hariv. 7072; of saffron colour, Viddh.; (*ās*), m. pl., N. of sixty particular Ketus, VarBrS. xi, 21.

कौचवार kaucavāra, *as, m.* patr. fr. *kūca-vāra*, gaṇa *bīdāddi*.

Kaucavārya, mfn. coming from Kūcavāra, Pāṇ. iv, 3, 94.

कौचहस्ति kaucahasti, *is, m.* patr. fr. *kuc-hasta*, Saṁskārak. (pl.)

कौचापाक kauca-pāka, *as, m.* a kind of decoction.

कौचुमारयोग kaucumāra-yoga, *as, m.* (fr. *kucō*), a particular art (*kalā*), BhP. x, 45, 36, Sch.

कौज kauja, mfn. (fr. *ku-ja*), relating or belonging to the planet Mars, VarBr. viii, xviii, xxiv; (said of Tuesday), Vishn. lxxviii, 3.

Kaujapa, *as, m.* patr. fr. *kuja-pa*, Pāṇ. vi, 2, 37.

कौच्चि kauñca, *as, m.* (for *krauñca*?), N. of a mountain (part of the Himālaya range), L.; (*i*), f. N. of a locality, Romakas. **Kauñcādri**, m. the Kauñca mountain, Bālar.

Kauñcikī, f. (with Kaulas) one of the eight A-kulas, Kulārṇ.

कौञ्जर kauñjara, mf(i)n. (fr. *kuñjō*), belonging to an elephant, MBh. xii, 8932 (= xiii, 5580); BhP. viii, 4, 12; (*am*), n. a particular method of sitting, NārP.

कौञ्जायन kauñjāyana, *ās, m. pl.* (fr. *kuñja*), N. of a mountain tribe (descended from Kuñja), Pāṇ. iv, 1, 98 & v, 3, 113; (*i*), f. a princess of that tribe (or the wife of a Brāhmaṇ or of any venerable personage belonging to that tribe, L.), ib.

Kauñjāyanya, *as, m.* a prince of the Kauñjāyanas, ib.

Kauñji, *m.* patr. fr. *kuñja*, Pāṇ. iv, 1, 98, Kāś.

कौट 1. **kauṭa**, mfn. (fr. *kuṭi*), living in one's own house, independent, free, Pāṇ. v, 4, 95; (*as*), m. (= *kuṭa-ja*) Wrightia antidyserterica, Bhpr. i, 206. — **taksha**, m. an independent carpenter (who works at home on his own account and not for a village or corporation), Pāṇ. v, 4, 95. — **phala**, n. a fruit of *kauṭa*, Car. viii, 11.

Kauṭaja, mfn. coming from the plant Wrightia antidyserterica (*kuṭa-ja*), Suśr.; (*as*), m. the plant Wrightia antidyserterica, Bhpr. iii, 159.

Kauṭajabhbārika, mfn. (fr. *kuṭaja-bhbāra*), carrying or bearing a load of Wrightia antidyserterica, gaṇa *vanzāddi*.

Kauṭajika, mfn. id., ib.

Kauṭayana, *as, m.* patr. fr. *kuṭa*, gaṇa *asvāddi*.

Kauṭi, *is, m.* id., g. *kraudyāddi* (not in Kāś.)

1. **Kauṭya**, *as, m.* id., gaṇa *kurvāddi*; (*ā*), f. of *kauṭi*, gaṇa *kraudyāddi* (not in Kāś.)

कौट 2. **kauṭa**, mfn. (fr. *kuṭa*), fraudulent, dishonest; snared, wired, W.; (*am*), n. fraud, falsehood, W. — **sākshin**, m. a false witness (= *kuṭa-sō*), Comm. on Yājñ. — **sākshya**, n. false evidence, Gaut.; Mn. viii, 117 & 122 f.; xi, 56.

Kauṭakika, mfn. one whose occupation is to catch animals in traps or caves &c., L.; (*as*), m. a vendor of the flesh of birds or beasts, hunter, poacher, butcher, &c., L.

Kauṭasthya, *am, n.* the state of being *kūṭa-stha*, i.e. uniform or unchangeable, Sarvad.; Sch. on Saṁk. on Bādar. ii, 2, 10.

Kauṭika, mfn. (gaṇa *kumuddī*; = *kauṭakika*) one whose business is to catch animals in traps &c., L.; relating to a snare or trap, W.; fraudulent, dishonest, W.; (*as*), m. one who kills animals and sells their flesh for his own subsistence, poacher, L.

Kauṭiya, mfn., gaṇa *kṛiśāsvāddi*.

2. **Kauṭya**, mfn., gaṇa *saṁkāśāddi*.

कौटभी kauṭabhi, for *kaiṭō*, q.v.

Kauṭali kauṭali, *is, m.* patr., Saṁskārak.

Kauṭalya, *as, m.* (for ^oṭilya), N. of Cāṇakya, L.

कौटवी kauṭavī, f. = *koṭō*, a naked woman, L.

कौटस्य kauṭasthya. See 2. *kauṭa*.

कौटायन kauṭāyana, ^oti. See 1. *kauṭa*.

कौटिक kauṭika. See 2. *kauṭa*.

कौटिया kauṭiryā, v.l. for ^oṭiryā.

कौटिलिक kauṭilikā, *as, m.* (fr. *kuṭilikā*; Pāṇ. iv, 4, 18) 'deceiving the hunter [or the deer, Sch.] by particular movements,' a deer ['a hunter,' Sch.], Kāś.; 'using the tool called *kuṭilikā*', a blacksmith, ib.

Kautilya, *as, m.* (fr. *kuṭila*), N. of Cāṇakya, Daś.; Mudr.; N. of a grammarian (?), Hemac.; Mallin. on Kum. vi, 37 & on Ragh. iii f., xv & xvii f.; (*am*), n. crookedness, curvature, curliness of the hair, Pāṇ. iii, 1, 23; Pañcat.; falsehood, dishonesty, Pañcat.; Rājat.; a kind of horse-radish, L. — **sāstra**, n. Cāṇakya's doctrine (diplomacy), Kād.

कौटीगव kauṭigava, mfn. fr. ^ovya, gaṇa *kaṇvāddi*.

Kauṭigavya, m. patr. fr. *kuṭi-gu*, g. *gargāddi*.

कौटीय kauṭiya. See 2. *kauṭa*.

कौटीर kauṭira, mfn. belonging to or made from the plant *Kuṭira*, gaṇa *bilvāddi*.

Kauṭīryā, f. 'living in a hut (? *kuṭira*)', N. of Durgā, Hariv. 10245 (v.l. ^oṭiryā).

कौटुम्ब kauṭumba, mfn. (fr. *kuṭō*), necessary for the household, ĀśvGr. ii, 6, 10; (*am*), n. family relationship, Rājat. v, 395.

Kauṭumbika, mfn. belonging to or constituting a family, BhP. v, 14, 3; (*as*), m. the father or master of a family, BhP. iv, 28, 12 & v, 13, 8.

कौटुम्बि kauṭumbī, mfn. (fr. *kuṭanī*), the procuring of women for immoral purposes, Rājat. vii, 289 & 297.

कौट्य 1. & 2. *kauṭya*. See 1. & 2. *kauṭa*.

कौठार kauṭhāra, *as, m.* patr. fr. *kuṭhāra*, gaṇa *śivāddi*.

Kauthārikeya, *as, m.* metron. fr. *kuṭhārikā*, gaṇa *śubhrāddi*.

कौदुम kauṭhuma, mf(i)n. fr. *kuṭhumi*, W.; (cf. *kauthuma*.)

कौडविक kaudavika, mf(i)n. (Kāś. on Pāṇ. v, 1, 52 & vii, 3, 17) sown with a Kuḍava of grain (as a field &c.), containing a Kuḍava, Car. vi, 17.

कौडेयक kauḍeyaka, mfn. fr. *kuḍyā*, gaṇa *kattrī-ādi*.

कौडोदरि kaudodari, *is, m.* (for *kaundō?* fr. *kundōdara*), N. of a man, Pravar.

कौड्य kaudya, v.l. for *koḍya*, q.v.

कौणकुत्स्य kauṇakutsya, *as, m.* (cf. *kūṇa-kuchcha*), N. of a Brāhmaṇ, MBh. i, 962.

कौणप kauṇapa, mfn. (fr. *kūṇō*), coming from corpses, Bālar.; (*as*), m. 'feeding upon corpses,' a Rākshasa or goblin, MBh. i, 6450; Śak. (v.l.); BhP. x, 12, 29; N. of a Nāga (these beings are supposed to eat human flesh), MBh. i, 2147. — **danta**, m., N. of Bhishma (uncle of the Pāṇḍus), L. — **Kauṇapāśana**, m., N. of a Nāga, MBh. i, 1559.

कौणिन्द kauṇinda, *ās, m.* pl. (v.l. *kaulin-da*, q.v.), N. of a people, VarBrS. xiv, 30; (*as*), m. a prince of that people, ib. 33.

कौणेय kauṇeyā, *as, m.* (fr. *kuni*), patr. of Rajana, TS. ii, 3, 8, 1; TāṇḍyaBr. xiii, 4, 11; (*koneya* & *o*yana) Kāṭh. xi, 1.

कौणदरव्य kauṇṭharavya, *as, m.* patr. fr. *kuṇṭha-rava*, AitĀr.

Kauṇṭhya, *am, n.* (fr. *kuṇṭha*), bluntness, VarBrS. i, 26.

कौणपायिन kauṇḍapāyina, mfn. with *ayana*, N. of a Soma libation (= *kunda-pāyinām ayō*), Lāty.; *kaundapāyinām ayō* for *nam ayō* or for *kunda-pāyinām ayō*, ŚāṅkhŚr. xiii, 24, 1; Lāty. i, 4, 23, Sch.; KātyŚr. iv, 1, 1, Sch.; Bādar. iii, 3, 40, Sch.

कौणल kauṇḍala, mfn. (fr. *kuṇḍō*), furnished with rings, gaṇa *jyotsnāddi*.
