Kauśalya, as, m. a kind of pavilion, Vāstuv.; (am), n. (gana brāhmaṇḍi) welfare, well-being, prosperity, MBh.; R.; cleverness, skilfulness, experience (ifc.), SaddhP.; Bhpr.; (ā), f., see *kauśalya*.

कौशाम्बा kauśāmba, mfn. (fr. kuś^o), belonging to Kauśāmbī (as a territory, *maṇḍala*), Inscr.; (ī), f. (g. *nady-ādi*), N. of an ancient city (now represented by the village of Kosam, on the Jumnā, near Allahābād; also called *vatsa-pattana*), R. i, 34, 6; Divyāv. xxxvi f.; Pāṇ. iv, 2, 68, Kāś.; Kathās. iv, 18; ix, 5; lxvi, 193; MatsyaP.; Hit.

Kauśāmbī, is, f. = ^obī, VarBrS. xvi, 3.

Kauśāmbikā, f., N. of a woman, Ratnāv.

Kauśāmbīya, mfn. coming from Kauśāmbī, ib.

Kauśāmbeṭā, as, m. (gana *śubhrddi*) patr. fr. *kauśāmba*, ŠBr. xii, 2, 2, 13; GopBr. i, 4, 24; mfn. fr. *kauśāmbī*, gana *nady-ādi*.

Kauśāmbya, as, m. a prince of Kauśāmbī, Hariv. 5017 & 5498.

Kauśila, as, m. a familiar N. for Kauśika, Vām. v, 2, 63.

Kauśilya, as, m. patr. of the prince Hiranya-nābha, VāyuP.

कौशिन kauśīja, ās, m. pl., N. of a people, MBh. vi, 349 (v. l. *kosala*).

कौशिल kauśīla, ^olyā. See 3. *kauśikā*.

कौशारव kauśārava, as, m. patr. fr. Kushāru, AitBr. viii, 28 (N. of Maitreya); BhP. i, 13, 2; iii.

कौषीतक kaushītaka, as, m. patr. fr. *kushō*, N. of Kahoda, ĀśvGr.; (ī), f. patr. of Agastya's wife, L.; N. of a Śākhā of the RV.; (am), n., N. of a Brāhmaṇa, ŚāṅkhBr.; ŚāṅkhŚr.; Bādar. iii, 3, 1, Sch.

Kaushītaki, is, m. (Pāṇ. iv, 1, 124, Kāś.) patr. fr. *kaushītaka*, ŠBr. ii; TāndyaBr. xvii (pl.); ŚāṅkhŚr.; ChUp.; Pravar. — **brāhmaṇa**, n., N. of a Brāhmaṇa (= ŚāṅkhBr.); = KaushUp., Bādar. i, 4, 16, Sch. & iii, 3, 10, Sch.; ^onōpanishad, f. id., i, 1, 28, Sch. — **rahasya**, n. id., iii, 3, 26, Sch.; -brāhmaṇa, n. id., Comm. on Mn. iv, 23. **Kaushītaky-upanishad**, f., N. of an Up.

Kaushītakin, *inas*, m. 'the pupils of ^oka,' N. of a school, ĀśvGr. i, 23, 5; Bādar., Sch.

Kaushītakeya, as, m. = ^oka, N. of Kahoda, ŠBr. xiv, 6, 4, 1; of a Kāsyapa, Pāṇ. iv, 1, 124.

कौषीद्य kaushīdya. See *kauśīdya*.

कौषेय kausheya, as, m. (fr. *koshā*), N. of a Rishi, R. vii, 1, 4; also v. l. for *kauśeya* (q. v.), R. iii, iv; MārkP. xv, 27.

Kaushīhya, as, m. patr. fr. *koshā*, Kāṭh. xxii, 6f.; ŠBr. x, 5, 5, 1.

कौष्टिक *kaushītacitka*, mfn. fr. *kushṭa-cit*, gana *kathādī* (Kāś.), v. l. for ^oshṭhavitka.

कौष्टुष्मा kaushītā, mfn. (fr. *koshṭha*), being in the stomach or abdomen, Sarvad.; being in a store-room, ŠBr. i, 1, 2, 7.

कौष्माण्डा *kaushmāṇḍa*, mfn. addressed to the demons called Kūshmāṇḍa (as a Mantra), VarBrS.

Kaushmāṇḍīka, mfn. id., AV. Pariś. xlii, 2.

कौष्मा *kaushīhya*. See *kauśeya*.

कौसला *kausala* (often spelt *kauśala*), mfn. belonging to the Kosalas (a country), Divyāv. vii, xii; (ās), m. pl., N. of a people, VarBrS. x, 14; Romakas.; Śāṅkar.; of a dynasty, BhP. xii, 1, 33; v. l. for *kos^o*, q. v.; (ās), f., N. of one of Krishṇa's wives, x, 83, 6; (ī), f., N. of one of Vasu-deva's wives, VP.

Kausalaka, ās, m. pl. (spelt *kausāl^o*), N. of a people, VarBrS.; (mfn.) belonging to the Kosalas, ib.

Kausaleya, as, m. = ^olyēya, L.

Kaushalyā, mfn. (often spelt *kaus^o*) belonging to the people of the Kosalas; (as), m. (Pāṇ. iv, 1, 171) a prince of the Kosalas, ŠBr. xiii; ŚāṅkhŚr.; PraśnUp.; Hariv. &c.; (ās), f. 'daughter of a prince of the Kosalas,' N. of the wife of Pūru and mother of Janam-ejaya, MBh. i, 3764; of the wife of Satvat, Hariv. 1999; of Daśa-ratha's wife (mother of Rāma-candra), MBh. iii, 15879; R.; of the mother of Dhṛita-rāshṭra, L.; of the mother of Pāṇdu, L.

Kausalyā (f. of ^olyā, q. v.) — **nandana**, m. 'son of Kausalyā,' Rāma, L. — **mātri**, m. 'having Kausalyā for his mother,' Rāma, MBh. iii, 16572.

Kausalyāyani, is, m. patr. fr. ^olyā, Pāṇ. iv, 1, 155; metron. fr. ^olyā (or patr. fr. *kosala*), N. of Rāma, Bhatt. vii, 90.

Kausalyeyā, as, m. metron. fr. ^olyā, N. of Rāma-candra, Prasannar.

कौसित *kausitā*, as, m., N. of a pool (mentioned in connection with *kusitāyi*, q. v.), MaitrS. ii, 1, 11; MāṇGr. i, 6.

Kausida, as, m. (spelt *kos^o*) id., Kāṭh. x, 5.

Kausida, mf(ī)n. (fr. *kuś^o*), connected with or relating to a loan, usurious, Mn. viii, 143.

Kausidya, am, n. sloth, indolence, Lalit. (printed ed. *kaush^o*); the practice of usury, L.

कौसुम *kausuma*, mf(ī)n. (fr. *kuś^o*), coming from or belonging to flowers (as pollen), Sāh.; made of flowers, Naish. vii, 28; AgP. xlivi, 10; Kathās. civ, 13; Bālar.; (am), n. (= *kusumāñjana*) the ashes of brass (used as a collyrium), L.

Kausumāyudha, mfn. (fr. *kuś^o*), relating to the god of love, Vet. xx, 19.

क्रकच *krakaca*, as, am, m. n. a saw, MBh. &c.; (as), m. a kind of musical instrument, MBh. vii, 1676; ix, 2676; Ardea virgo, NPr.; N. of a plant (Capparis aphylla, L.), Kād.; of a hell, PadmaP.; of a Kāpālika priest, Śāṅkar.; (ās), f. = *-cchada*, L. — *cchada*, m. 'saw-leaved,' Pandanus odoratissimus, L. — *tvac*, m. id., NPr. — *pattra*, m. the teak

कौसुम्भा *kausumbha*, mf(ī)n. prepared with safflower, Suṣr.; (Pāṇ. iv, 2, 1, Kāś.) dyed with safflower, orange, Ratnāv.; (as), m. wild safflower, L.; (am), n. (with *sāka*) safflower prepared as a pot-herb, VārP.; anything dyed with safflower, Cāṇ.

Kausumbhaka, mfn. dyed with safflower, AgP.

कौसुरविन्द *kausurubinda*, as, m. patr. fr. *kuś^o*, GopBr. i, 4, 24; N. of a Daśa-rātra ceremony, Kātyār. xxiii f.; Drāhy. xxx, 3.

Kaúsurubindi, is, m. patr. fr. *kusurubinda*, ŠBr. xii, 2, 2, 13.

कौसुतिक *kausritika*, as, m. (fr. *ku-sṛiti*), a juggler, conjurer, Pāṇ. v, 2, 75, Kāś.

कौस्तुभ *kaustubha*, as, am, m. n. (cf. *kust^o*), N. of a celebrated jewel (obtained with thirteen other precious things at the churning of the ocean and suspended on the breast of Krishṇa or Vishṇu), MBh.; Hariv.; R. &c.; (as), m. a manner of joining the fingers, Tantras.; = *kimtughna*, AV. Jyot.;

(am), n. a kind of oil (*sarshapādbhava*), Kātyār. i, 8, 37, Sch.; N. of a work. — **dhāman**, m. 'abode of the Kaustubha,' Vishṇu, Prasannar. — *bhṛit*, m. 'wearing the Kaustubha,' id., KPr. — *lakṣhaṇa*, m. 'whose mark is the Kaustubha,' id., W. — *vakshas*, m. 'whose breast is decorated with the Kaustubha,' id., L. **Kaustubhōras**, m. id., Gal.

Kaustubhiya, mfn. relating or belonging to the Kaustubha jewel, Bālar.

कौस्त्र *kaustra*, am, n. the state of being a bad wife (*ku-strī*), gana *yuvādī*.

कौहड *kauhāda*, as, m. patr. fr. *koh^o*, gana *sivādī*; Pāṇ. ii, 4, 58, Kāś.

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
