गोह **gōha**, m. (\sqrt{guh}) a hiding-place, lair, RV. iv, 21, 6-8; 'a secret place for hiding refuse or filth,' see *ubadhya*.

Gohana, mfn., see *avadya*-.

Gohi, g. *suvāstv-ādi*, v. l.

Gohira, n. 'hidden part (?)', the heel, L.

Gohila, m., g. *sakhy-ādi* (Kāś.)

Gohilla, m., N. of a man, Jyotirv. x, 112, Sch.

Gohya, mfn. (Pāṇ. iii, 1, 109; g. *suvāstv-ādi*, Kāś.) 'to be concealed,' see *ā*; m., N. of an Agni in the water, MantraBr. i, 7, 1.

गोहत्या **go-hatyā**, -hán, &c. See **gō**, p. 367.

गोहालिया **goḥāliyā**, f., N. of a plant, GarP.

गोहिर **gohira**, &c. See **gōha**.

गौकक्ष **gaukaksha**, m. pl. of *okshya*, g. *kanvāddi*; Pāṇ. iv, 3, 130, Kāś.; (i), f. of *okshya*, only in comp.

Gaukakshī, f., see *oksha*. — **pati**, m. the husband of Gaukakshī, Gaṇar. 37, Sch. — **putra**, m. the son of Gaukakshī, Pāṇ. iv, 1, 74, Pat.

Gaukakshya, m. a patr. fr. *go-kaksha*, g. *gar-gāddi*; (ā), f., g. *kraudy-ādi*.

Gaukakshyā, f. of *okshya*, q. v. — **pati**, m. = *okshī-pō*, Gaṇar. 37, Sch. — **putra**, m. = *okshī-pō*, Pāṇ. iv, 1, 74, Pat.

Gaukakshyāyana, m. patr. fr. *okshya*, f. ī, a female descendant of *okshya*, 75, Pat.

Gaukakshyāyani, m. = *na*, g. *tikāddi*.

गौगुलव **gauggulava**, mfn. (fr. *gūggulu*), made from bdellium (an unguent), TāṇḍyaBr. xxiv, 13, 4 (v. l. *gaulgō*); m. patr., f. ī, g. *sāringaravāddi*.

गौङ्गव **gaungava**, n. (fr. *guṅgū*), N. of several Sāmans, xiv, 3, 18 f.

गौञ्जिक **gauñjika**, m. (fr. *guñjā*), a jeweller, L.

गौड **gauḍa**, mf(i)n. (fr. *guda*), prepared from sugar or molasses, MBh. viii, 2050; Suśr.; Hcat.; relating or belonging to the Gauḍas, Vātsyā.; Kāvyād. i, 35; Sarvad. xv; (esp. f. ī with *rīti*, the Gauḍian style of poetry, viz. the bold and spirited style, Kāvyād. i, 40; Vām.; Pratāpar. &c.); m. (scil. *deśa*) or n. (scil. *nāshṭra*) 'sugar country,' N. of a country (district of Gaur, central part of Bengāl, extending from Vaṅga to the borders of Orissa; the ruins of its capital called by the same N. are still extensive), Rājat.; Prab. ii, 7; Hit.; m. pl. the inhabitants of that country, Vātsyā.; Rājat.; Śūdradh.; m. sg. a prince of the Gauḍas, Kathās. cxxii, 3; N. of a lexicographer; n. sweetmeats, R. i, 53, 4; vii, 92, 12; (i), f. with *rīti*, see before; rum or spirit distilled from molasses (RTL. p. 193), Mn. xi, 95; MBh. viii, 2034; Grīhyās. ii, 16; (in music) N. of a Rāgini. — **grantha**, m., N. of a work. — **tithitattva**, n., N. of a work. — **desa**, m. the Gauḍa country, SkandaP. — **desīya**, mfn. coming from the Gauḍa country, Pañcad. — **nibandha**, m., N. of a work. — **pāda**, m.; N. of a commentator on several Upanishads and on Sāṃkhyak. — **pura**, n., N. of a town, Pāṇ. vi, 2, 100. — **bhritya-pura**, n., N. of a town, ib., Siddh.; (cf. *andhra-bhritya*). — **mālava**, m. Gaudaka, m. pl., N. of a people living to the east of Madhya-deśa, VarBīS. xiv, 7. — **mṛiga**, m. a wild horse, L.; (cf. *gaura-khara*.)

Gaudika, mfn. prepared with sugar or molasses, Suśr. i, 46, 9, 3; fit for the preparation of sugar, Pāṇ. iv, 4, 103; n. rum (prepared with sugar), Suśr. vi, 58, 28.

Gaudiya, mfn. relating to Gauḍa or Bengāl (as *mārga* [Kāvyād. i, 40] or *rīti* [Vām.; Pratāpar. &c.], 'the Gauḍian style').

गौण **gauna**, mf(i)n. (fr. *gunā*), relating to a quality, MBh. xii, 13138f.; having qualities, attributive, W.; subordinate, secondary, unessential,

MBh. xii, xiii; Pat.; KapS. &c. (with *karman*, [in Gr.] the less immediate object of an action, Vop. xxiv, 13); metaphorical, figurative, W.; secondary (applied to the month reckoned from full moon to full moon), W.; relating to multiplication or enumeration, W. — **tva**, n. the state of being subordinate or secondary, Vop.; Kātyār., Sch. — **pakṣa**, m. the minor or weaker side of an argument, W. — **sādhy-avasānā**, f. (scil. *lakṣaṇā*) a kind of ellipse, Sarvad. xv, 289. — **sāropā**, f. (scil. *lakṣaṇā*) a kind of ellipse, ib.

1. Gaunika, mf(i)n. relating to the three qualities (of *sattva*, *rajas* & *tamas*), Mn. xii, 41; = *gune sādhu*, g. *kathādi*; = *guṇam adhīte veda vā*, *gaṇas ukthādi* & *vasantādi*; relating to or connected with qualities, W.; subordinate, W.

Gaunya, m. merit, Hariv. 5907; n. subordination, secondariness, Vop.; the being a merit, Hariv. 14240.

गौणिक 2. **gaunika**, mf(i)n. (fr. *goṇī*), resembling a sack, g. *anguly-ādi*.

गौणकिरी **gaunḍa-kirī**, f. (in music) N. of a Rāgini (cf. *gonḍ*).

गौतम **gautamā**, mf(i)n. relating to Gotama (with *pada-stobha*, m. pl., N. of a Sāman); m. patr. fr. Gotama (N. of Kuśri, Uddālaka, Aruṇa, ŚBr.; of Śaradvat, Hariv.; Mṛicch. v, 30; VP.; of Śatānanda, L.; of Śākyā-muni; of Nodhas & Vāma-deva, RAnukr.; of a teacher of ritual, Lāty.; Āśvār.; ĀśvGr.; of a grammarian, TPrāt.; Lāty. [with the epithet *sthavira*]; of a legislator, Yājñ. i, 5; the father of Ekata, Dvita, and Trita, MBh. ix, 2073); (= *gotō*) N. of the first pupil of the last Jina (one of the three Kevalins); N. of a Nāga (also *maka*), Divyāv. ii; m. pl. Gautama's family, Hariv. 1788; Pravar.; a kind of poison, L.; n., N. of several Sāmans, ĀrshBr.; Lāty. iv, 6, 16; fat (cf. *bhāradvāja*, 'bone'), L.; (*gaitamī*), f. (*gaṇas gaurāddi* & *sāringaravāddi*) a female descendant of Gotama (N. of Kṛipi, Hariv.; BhP.; of Mahā-prajāpatī, Lalit. vii, xv), MBh. xiii, 17 ff.; Śak.; N. of Durgā, Hariv. 10236; of a Rākshasi, L.; of a river (= *go-dāvarī* or *go-mati*), MBh. xiii, 7647; R. vi, 2, 27; the bile-stone of cattle (*go-rocanā*), L.; = *rājanī*, L. — **nyagrodha**, m. 'Gautama's pond,' N. of a lake, SkandaP. — **svāmin**, m. = *gotō*, HParī. **Gautamāraṇya**, n., N. of a forest, Hit. iv. **Gautamārdhika**, mfn. belonging half to the Gautama family, Pāṇ. iv, 3, 4, Vārtt. 1, Pat. & Kāś. **Gautamāśrama**, m. N. of a hermitage, GaṇP. ii, 95. **Gautamēśa**, m. N. of a Linga. **Gautamēśvara-tīrtha**, n., N. of a Tīrtha, RevāKh. ciic, cclvi.

Gautamaka, m. N. of a Nāga king, Divyāv. ii.

Gautami, m. patr. fr. *mā*, SāṅkhGr. iv, 10, 3; Parāś. Introd. 4.

Gautami-nandana, m. (metrically for *mī-nō*) metron. of Āśvatthāman, MBh. vii, 6847.

Gautamī, f. of *mā*, q. v. — **tantra**, n., N. of a Tantra. — **pūtra** (*gautī*), m. 'son of Gautamī,' N. of a teacher, ŚBr. xiv, 9, 4, 31. — **suta**, m. = *mī-nandana*, MBh. vii, 6857.

Gautamīya, mfn. belonging to or coming from Gautama, Lāty. &c. (f. *yā* with *mitāksharā*, N. of Hara-datta's Comm. on Gaut.)

गौतमस **gautamasa** = *ma-sa* (q. v.) or fr. *go-tamas*?

गौदनेत्र **gaudanetra**, m. patr. fr. *go-danta*, g. *subhrāddi* (not in Kāś., but in Gaṇar. 223).

गौदपरिणाद्धि **gaudapariṇaddhi**, m. patr. fr. *guda-pariṇaddha*, Gaṇar. 33. Sch. (*svāgudapō*, Kāś.)

Gaudāyana, m. patr. fr. *guda*, Pravar. i, 4 (v. l. *godō*); also *godāyani*, pl. iv, 8.

Gaudēya, m. metron. fr. *gudā*, g. *subhrāddi* (Kāś.)

गौदानिक **gaudānika**, mfn. (g. *māhānāmny-ādi*) relating to the Godāna ceremony, ĀśvGr. iii, 8, 6; (*godō*, Gobh.)

गौधार **gaudhāra**, m. (metron. fr. *godhā*, Pāṇ. iv, 1, 130) = *godhō*, an Iguana, L.

Gaudhāsanika, v. l. for *gauvāsanō*.

Gaudheya, m. (g. *subhrāddhi*) = *dhāra*, L.; pl. N. of a school of the black Yajur-veda (v. l. *baudhō*).

Gaudhera, m. (Pāṇ. iv, 1, 129) = *dhāra*, L.

Gatidheraka, m. a kind of small venomous animal, Suśr. v, 8, 26; cf. *godhō*.

Gaudherakāyāṇi, m. patr. fr. *ra*, g. *vākināddi*.

गौधिल **gaudhili**, pl. patr., Pravar. vi, 1.

गौधूम **gaudhūmā**, mf(i), g. *bilvāddi*n. made of wheat, MaitrS. i; Hcat. i, 7 (f. ā); made of wheat straw, ŚBr. v, 2, 1, 6; Kātyār. xiv, 1, 22 & 5, 7.

Gaudhūmra, N. of the author of part of ŚatarUp.

Gaudhenuka, n. (fr. *go-dhenu*), a herd of milch-cows, L.

गौधेय **gaudheya**, &c. See *dhāra*.

गौनर्द **gaunarda**, mfn. fr. *go-nō*, Pāṇ. i, 1, 75, Siddh.

गौप **gaupa**, m. patr. fr. *go-pá*, TāṇḍyaBr. xiii, 12, 5, Sch. (for *go-pá*?).

Gaupatyā, n. (fr. *go-pati*), the possession of cattle, VS. iii, xi; TS. i, iii; Gobh. iv, 5, 18.

Gaupanya, m. pl. patr., Pravar. iii, 1 (*gopana*, MatsyaP. cvci, 3).

Gaupavana, m. (g. *bidāddi*) patr. fr. *go-pō*, BrĀrUp.; Pravar. iii, 1 & 5; (pl.) Pāṇ. ii, 4, 67; n., N. of a Sāman.

Gaupāyana, m. pl. the descendants of *go-pá* (or *gaupa*, TāṇḍyaBr., Sch.), TāṇḍyaBr. xiii; Pravar. vi, 1 (*gopō*); (authors of RV. x, 57-60) RAnukr.

Gaupālapaśupālikā, f. the state or office of Gopālas (cowherds) and Paśupālas (herdsman), Pāṇ. v, 1, 133, Kāś.

Gaupālāyana, m. patr. fr. *go-pālā*, MaitrS. iii, 10, 4; AitBr. iii, 48, 9.

Gaupāli, m. id., Pāṇ. ii, 4, 9, Kāś. (mentioned as having had a quarrel with the Śālāṅkāyanas); cf. *gopō*.
