टीटिभ *tītibha*, m. = *tīṭṭ°*, *Kathās.* lx, 165 ff.; (*ī*), f. = *tīṭṭ°*, li, 78; lx. - **सरस**, n. N. of a Tirtha, li.

टीकार *tīt-kāra*, m. a crack, *Bālar.* iii, 78.

टु *tu*, m. gold, L.; one who changes his shape at will, W.; love, god of love, W.

टुक्करी *tukkarī*, f. a kind of drum.

टुदुक *tuṭuka*, m. N. of a pot-herb, L.

टुदुक *tuṭuka*, mfn. small, minute, L.; cruel, harsh, L.; low, W.; m. *Calosantes indica*, *Car.* vi, 25, 66; *Suśr.* i, 36 & 38; iv; a kind of acacia, L.; the bird *Sylvia sutoria*, L.; (*ā*), f. = *ṭaṅginī*, L.

टुनाका *tuṇākā*, f. *Curculigo orchioides*, L.

टुपीका *tuṇ-tīkā*, f. collective N. of the last 8 books of the *Tantra-vārttika*. **टुब-दुशी**, f. id.

टुल्ल *tulla*, m. N. of a man, *Rājat.* vii.

टुकारी *tekarī*, f. = *ṭaṃ-k°*, *Bhpr.* vii.

टुदुक *teṭuka*, m. N. of a *Bignonia*, L.

टुपन *tepana*, n. (*√tip*) throwing, W.

टुरे *tera*, mfn. squinting, W. **टुरेकशा**, mfn. squint-eyed, *Buddh.* L. **टुरेका**, mfn. squinting, L.

टोट *toṭa*, °*tī*, v. l. for *doṭ°*, q. v.

टोटार *toḍara*, m. N. of a minister of *Akbar Shāh* (generally called *kshamāpati* or *-malla* or *°rēndra*). **टोटारानंदा**, m. 'Toḍara's delight,' N. of a compilation made at Toḍara's desire, *Nirṇayas*.

टोपर *topara*, a small bag, *Dhūrtas.* ii, 11.

टौक *tauḥ*, cl. 1. *Ā.*, v. l. for *√dhauk*.

टौदेश *tauṭēsa*, m. 'Tauṭa-lord,' N. of a *Kshetra-pāla*, *RevāKh.* cccv.

टुल *ṭval*, cl. 1. P. = *√tal*, *Dhātup.* xx, 5.

टुवाला, *ṭvāla*, g. *ṭvālādi*.

ठ 1. *ṭha*, the aspirate of the preceding consonant. - **करा**, m. the letter *ṭh*, *Pāṇ.* viii, 4, 41, *Kāś.*; °*raya*, Nom. (Desid. *tīh°yishati*), 54, *Kāś.*

ठ 2. *ṭha*, m. a loud noise (*ṭhaṭhaṃ ṭhaṭhaṃ ṭhaṃ ṭhaṭhaṃ ṭhaṭhaṃ ṭhaḥ*, an imitative sound as of a golden pitcher rolling down steps, *Māhān.* 2 iii, 5), L.; the moon's disk, L.; a disk, L.; a cypher, L.; a place frequented by all, L.; *Śiva*, L.

ठंसरी *ṭhaṃsarī*, f. N. of a stringed instrument. **ठक्क** *ṭhakka*, m. a merchant (= *ṭakka*), *Inscr.* (1st century A.D.)

ठक्कन *ṭhakkana*, m. N. of a prince, *Rājat.* vi, 230 ff. & 236 (vv. ll. *ḍhakka°*, *ṭhakka°*).

ठक्कुर *ṭhakkura*, m. a deity, object of reverence, man of rank, chief (the modern 'Thākūr, Tagore' added to names), vii f.; *Dhūrtas.* i, 1/2.

ठठ *ṭhaṭhaṃ, ṭhaṭhaṭhaṃ*. See 2. *ṭha*.

ठाकार *ṭhāt-kāra*, m. = *ṭāṃ-k°*, *Bālar.* iii.

ठार *ṭhāra*, rime, *KātyŚr.* xv, 4, 38, *Sch.*

ठिशिवा *ṭhiṣhā*, f. a gaming-house, *Kathās.* xcii, 15 & 21 (*ṭiṣh°*), cxxiv, 211; N. of a woman, *Rājat.* vii, 103. - **काराला**, m. N. of a gaming-house-keeper, *Kathās.* cxxi, 71 f.

ठेकृत *ṭhet-kṛita*, n. the roaring (of a bull), *Alaṃkārat.* **ठोखपद्धति** *ṭhoṅṭha-paddhati*, f. N. of a work, *Sūdradh.*

ड 1. *ḍa*, the 3rd cerebral consonant (pronounced like *d* in *drum* by slightly turning the tip

of the tongue upwards; and often in Bengal like a hard *r*). - **करा**, m. the letter *ḍ*, *TPrāt.* iv, 38, *Sch.*

ड 2. *ḍa*, m. a sound, L.; a kind of drum, W.; fear, L.; submarine fire, L.; *Śiva*, L.; (*ā*), f. a *Dākinī*, L.; a basket &c. carried by a sling, L.

डक्कारी *ḍakkārī*, f. the *Cāṇḍāla* lute, L.

डङ्गर *ḍaṅgara*, m. = *ḍiṅg°*, L.; throwing (or 'an expression of contempt'), L. (also *ḍiṅg°*); (*ī*), f. a kind of gourd, L. **डण्गारी**, f. = °*garī*, L.

डप *ḍap*, cl. 10. *Ā.* *ḍāpayate*, to accumulate, *Dhātup.* xxxiii, 4.

डम *ḍam*, cl. 1. P. (p. °*mat*) to sound (as a drum), *Prab.* iii, 14.

डम *ḍama*, m. a despised mixed caste (son of a *Cāṇḍāli* and a *Leṭa*), *BrahmavP.*

डमर *ḍamara*, m. (n., L.) a riot, tumult, *VarBṛS.*; *Kathās.* c; *Pārsvan.* iv, 186; cf. *dām°*.

डमरिन, m. a sort of drum, *BhP.* viii, 10, 7.

डमारु, (m., L.) id., *Rājat.* ii, 99; *Prab.* iii, 14; surprise, L. - **यन्त्रा**, n. a kind of pan, *Bhpr.*

डमारुका, m. (n., L.), °*kā*, f. = °*rin*, *Vātsyāy.* &c.

डम्प *ḍamp*, cl. 10. *Ā.*, v. l. for *√ḍap*.

डम्ब *ḍamb*, cl. 10. °*bayati*, to push, throw, *Vop.* (*Dhātup.* xxxii, 132); cf. *vi-*.

डम्बर *ḍambara*, m. great noise, loud assertion of (in comp.), verbosity, *Kathās.* cvii, 5; *Pratāpar.*; *Sāh.*; entanglement, multitude, mass, *Mālatīm.*; *Mcar.*; *Kathās.* lxxi; beauty, *Uttarar.*; *Viddh.*; N. of an attendant of *Skanda*, *MBh.* ix, 2541; of a *Gandharva*, *Hariv.* (v. l. *ḍumb°*); cf. *ā-*. - **नामान**, mfn. having a high-sounding name, *Mālatīm.* i, 4.

डम्बुर *ḍambura*, ?, *Hcat.* i, 9, 49.

डम्भ *ḍambh*, cl. 10. *Ā.*, v. l. for *√ḍap*.

डम्भा, m. N. of a man, *Rājat.* viii, 1135; (*ā*), f. N. of a weapon, *Buddh.* L.

डयन *ḍayana*. See *√ḍi*.

डलक *ḍalaka*. See *dall°*.

डलन *ḍalana*, m. = *dall°*.

डल्लक *ḍallaka*, n. a *Dūli* carried on men's shoulders by means of a stick and ropes like the beam and strings of a balance (also *ḍalaka*, W.), *BrahmavP.*; m. N. of a man, *Rājat.* vii, 189 & 198.

डल्लन *ḍallana*, m. N. of a scholiast on *Suśr.*

डवित्थ *ḍavittha*, m. N. of a man (named along with *Dittha*; cf. *dāmbhiṭṭa*), *Pāṇ.* i, 2, 45, *Sch.* (*kapittha*, *Kāś.*); *Bādar.* ii, 4, 20, *Sch.*; *Sāh.* ii, 4; a wooden antelope, L.

डहल *ḍahāla*, in *Prākṛit* for *daśāna*, *Bālar.* iii, 1/2; cf. *ḍah°*.

डहु *ḍahu*, °*hū*, m. *Artocarpus lakuca*, L.

डाक *ḍāka*, m. an imp attending *Kālī*, *Kālac.* v, 38.

डकिनि, f. (of °*ka*, *Pāṇ.* iv, 2, 51, *Pat.*) a female imp attending *Kālī* (feeding on human flesh), *BhP.* x; *BrahmavP.*; *MārKP.*; *Kathās.* (*ḍāginī*, cii, cviii f.); (cf. *ṣāk°*); N. of a locality, *ŚivaP.* i, 38, 18. - **त्वा**, n. the condition of a female imp, *Daś.* xi, 302.

डगिनि, *Prākṛit* form for *ḍākinī* (q. v.), *Kathās.*

डगिनेया, °*yaka*, N. of a gambler, cxxi, 33 ff.

डंकृति *ḍaṅkṛiti*, f. = *ṭaṅkṛita*, *Prab.* iii, 14.

डाङ्गरी *ḍāṅgarī*, f. = *ḍaṅg°*, L.

डाकृति *ḍāt-kṛiti*, f. (= *ḍām-*; *ṭaṅ-kāra*) howling, *Mālatīm.* v, 19.

डाभी *ḍābhī*, N. of a family, *Ratnak.*

डामर *ḍamara*, mfn. 'causing tumult (*ḍam°*)', extraordinary, surprising, *Mālatīm.* (-*ṭva*, n. abstr.); *Gīt.* xii, 23; m. surprise, sight, L.; = *ḍam°*, L.; a lord (probably = baron, knight), *Rājat.*; a N. of 6 *Tantras* (*yoga-*, *śiva-*, *ḍurgā-*, *śārasvata-*, *brahma-*, *gandharva-*); of an attendant of *Śiva*, *BrahmavP.* - **तन्त्रा**, n. N. of a *Tantra*, *Nirṇayas.* ii, 7. - **भैरवा-तन्त्रा**, n. N. of a *Tantra*.

डामरवा, mfn. coming from a drum, *Hastar.*

डाम्भिट्ट *ḍāmbhiṭṭa*, m. N. of a man, man of *Dāmbhiṭṭa*'s kind (? mentioned along with *Dittha*;

cf. *ḍavittha*), *Pāṇ.* v, 1, 119, *Vārtt.* 5, *Pat.* - **त्वा**, n. an act of a man of *Dhāmbhiṭṭa*'s kind, ib.

डाल *ḍāla*, a branch, *Śil.* on *Ācār.* ii.

डालिम *ḍālīma*, m. = *dāḍīma*, L., *Sch.*

डहल *ḍahāla*, m. pl. N. of a people (= *cedi*, L.; sg. their country, L.), *Romakas.*; *Ratnak.*

डहलधिसा, m. a *ḍahāla* prince, *Vcar.* xviii, 95.

डहला, m. pl. (cf. *ḍah°*) = °*hala*, *Vcar.* xviii, 93.

डहुक *ḍāhuka*, m. = *dātyūha*, a gallinule, L.

डिक्करिका *ḍik-karikā*, = *dik-karī*, *Śil.*

डिङ्गर *ḍiṅgara*, m. a servant, L.; a rogue, cheat, L.; = *ḍaṅg°* (q. v.; 'a fat man,' W.), L.

डिडिमाणक *ḍiḍimāṇaka*, m. N. of a bird of the *Pratuda* class, *Suśr.*; (*ḍiḍimāṇava*, *Car.* i, 27.)

डिण्डिक *ḍiṅḍika*, N. of a mouse, *MBh.* v.

डिण्डिभ *ḍiṅḍibha*, m. a water-snake, L.

डिण्डिम *ḍiṅḍīma*, m. a kind of drum, vii, ix; *Hariv.* (once °*mā*, f., 14836); *R.* v; *Kathās.* (once n., xci, 23) &c. (ifc. f. *ā*, *Amar.*); great noise, murmuring, clamour, loud assertion, *Kād.*; *Bālar.*; *Vcar.* (-*ṭva*, n. abstr.) &c.; *Carissa Carandas*, L.; mfn. humming, *Kād.* ii, 154. **डिण्डिमेश्वर-तिरथा**, n. N. of a Tirtha, *RevāKh.* cccxi.

डिण्डिमाणव *ḍiṅḍimāṇava*. See *ḍiḍimāṇaka*.

डिण्डिर *ḍiṅḍira*, m. = *hiṅḍ°*, os sepia, L.

- **मोदका**, n. garlic, L.

डिण्डिरा, (m., L.) = °*ḍira*, *Vcar.*; (ifc. f. *ā*) *Kathās.*

डिण्डिश *ḍiṅḍīśa*, = *ṭiṅḍ°* = *tindiśa*, *Bhpr.*

डिण्डिर *ḍiṅḍira*. See °*ḍira*.

डित्थ *ḍittha*, m. N. of a man, man of *Dittha*'s kind (?; 'a handsome dark-complexioned man conversant with every branch of learning,' L.; cf. *ḍavittha* & *dāmbhiṭṭa*), *Pāṇ.* v, 1, 119, *Vārtt.* 5, *Pat.* (also *-tā*, f., *-ṭva*, n. 'an act of a man of *Dittha*'s kind'); i, 2, 45, *Kāś.*; *Bādar.* ii, 4, 20, *Sch.*; *Kpr.*; *Sāh.* ii, 4; *Tarkas.* 59; a wooden elephant, L.

डिप *ḍip*, *ḍimp*, *ḍimbh*, cl. 10. *Ā.* *ḍepayate*, *ḍimp°*, *ḍimbh°*, to heap together, *Dhātup.* xxxiii, 4; cl. 4. 6. 10. P. *ḍīpyati*, *ḍīpati*, *ḍepayati* (v. l. *ṭep°*, *Vop.*), *Ā.* *ḍimbayate*, to throw, *Dhātup.*

डिम् *ḍim* (a *Sautra* rt.), to injure.

डिम *ḍīma*, m. a dramatic exhibition of a siege (as of *Tripura-dāha*, q. v.), *Daśar.*; *Pratāpar.*; *Sāh.*; a kind of mixed caste, *BrahmavP.* i, 10, 105.

डिम्प *ḍimp*, *ḍimb*. See *√ḍip*.

डिम्ब *ḍimba*, (m. n., L.) 'affray, riot,' see °*bāhava*; m. an egg, *Mālatīm.*; *Pañcar.*; a chrysalis, W.; the recently-formed embryo, L.; (for °*m̄bha*) a new-born child, a child, L.; a young animal, W.; an idiot, *Rājat.* vii, 1074; viii, 1707; a ball, W.; a humming top, *Naish.* xxii, 53; the body, *Śiś.* xviii, 77; the lungs, L.; the spleen, L.; the uterus, W.; *Ricinus communis*, L.; cf. *ujjūta-jala-*. - **युद्धा**, n. affray, riot, W. **डिम्बहवा**, m. id., *Mn.* v, 95; *MBh.* i, 1219. **डिम्बिका**, f. a lustful woman, L.; a bubble, L.; = *monaka* or *ṣoṅ°* (*Bignonia indica*), L.

डिम्भ *ḍimbh*. See *√ḍip*.

डिम्भ *ḍimbha*, m. (cf. °*m̄ba*) a new-born child, child, boy, young animal, *Śak.*; *Hāl.*; *Naish.*; *Bālar.*; *Pañcar.*; *SāñkhGr.*, *Sch.*; an idiot, *Mālatīm.*; *Sāh.*; a young shoot, *Naish.* viii, 2; an egg, *Pañcar.*; N. of a *Dānava*, *Hariv.* ii, 102, 10; (*ā*), f. an infant, L.; cf. *toya-*. - **कक्रा**, n. N. of a mystical diagram.

डिम्भहदिम्भ, = *ḍimbḍhava* (?), *Hcat.* i, 6.

डिम्भका, m. *ikā*, f. a new-born child, young animal, *Śak.* (in *Prākṛit*, v. l.); m. N. of a general of *Jarā-saṃdha*, *MBh.* ii, 576 & 601 ff.; *Hariv.*

डिल्लि *ḍilli*, °*llī*, the town *Delhi*.

डी *ḍī*, cl. 1. 4. *Ā.* *ḍayate*, *ḍiyate* (*Naigh.* ii, 14; *Pāṇ.* vii, 2, 10, *Vārtt.* 7, *Pat.*; pf. *ḍīḍye*, viii, 4, 54, *Kāś.*; pr. p. *ḍāyamāna*, 59, *Kāś.*; aor. *aḍayishṭa*, *Vop.*) to fly, *Dhātup.*; cf. *ud-*, *prōd-*.

डयाना, n. a bird's flight, L.; a palanquin, L.

डीना, mfn. (cf. *Pāṇ.* vii, 2, 14; viii, 2, 45, *Kāś.*) flown, flying, W.; n. a bird's flight, *MBh.* viii, 1899 f.; cf. *ati-*, *abhi-*, *ava-*, *ni-*, *nir-*, *parā-*, *pari-*, *punar-*, &c. - **डीनाका**, n. flying reiteratedly, ib.
