**निःशाणा** nih-sána, m. or n. march, procession, Sáh. (Pers. نشان?).

**निःशास्** nih-✓sás (pf. Subj.-śasás), to drive away, expel, RV. i, 80, 1.

**निःशिष्** nih-✓sish; Caus.-śeshayati, -śe-shita &c. See nih-sesa under nih, p. 538, col. 3.

**निःशी** nih-✓śī, only pr. p. Ā.-śayāna, mfn. starting up from sleep, BhP.

**निःशृच्** nih-✓śuc, Intens. Ā.-śosucanta, to shine forth, RV. vii, 1, 4.

**निःशृङ्खणा** nih-śrīnkhāna, n. blowing the nose, Āpast. (cf. śrīnkhānīkā).

**निःश्त्रे** nih-✓śrī, P.-śriṇāti (Impv. -śriṇīhi), to break, crush, AV.

**निःश्वस्** nih-✓śvas, P.-śvasiti (pf. -śaśvāsa), to hiss (said of a serpent), R.; to snort (said of an elephant), ib.; to breathe, exhale, Suṣr., inhale, MārkP.; to sigh, MBh.; Kāv. &c. **श्वासा**, n. breathing out or sighing, W. **श्वासिता**, mfn. breathed or breathing out, sighing; n. expiration, Ragh.; a sigh, Kum.; Vikr. **श्वास्या**, ind. having breathed out or sighed, sighing, R.; Kālid. &c. **श्वासा**, m. (ifc. f. ā) = **श्वासिता**, n., Mn.; MBh. &c. (often v. l. or w. r. ni-śv<sup>o</sup>); -parama, mf(ā)n. quite addicted to sighing, melancholy, Nal.; -śamhitā, f. N. of a code of laws supposed to have been revealed by Rudra-Śiva, Pur.

**निःषिच्** nih-shic (*✓ sic*), P.-shiñcati (Pāṇ. viii, 3, 65, Vārtt. I, Pat.), to pour away, AitBr. **शिक्ता**, mfn. poured away i.e. shaken off, removed (as a sin or crime), Nir. **शेचाना**, n. a contrivance for pouring out; -vat, mfn., ĀpSr.

**निःषिध्** 1. nih-shidh (*✓ 2. sidh*), P.-she-dhati (Pāṇ. viii, 3, 65, Vārtt. I, Pat.), to frighten away, VS. 2. **निःशिध्**, see *puru-n<sup>o</sup>*.

**निःषिध्** 3. nih-shidh, f. (*✓ 1. sidh*) granting, bestowal, gift, oblation, RV. **शिध्वन्**, mi(varī)n. granting, munificent, ib.

**निःषु** nih-shu (*✓ 3. su*), P.-shunoti, Pāṇ. viii, 3, 65, Vārtt. I, Pat.

**निःषु** nih-shū (*✓ 1. sū*), P.-shuvati (Pāṇ. ib.), to drive or frighten away, AV. **शुति**, f., Pāṇ. viii, 3, 88.

**निःष्टन्** nih-shṭan (*✓ stan*; cf. VPrāt. iii, 68, P. ni-shṭanati for nih-shī<sup>o</sup>, p. ni-shṭanat for nih-shī<sup>o</sup>, MBh.; 2. sg. Impv. nih-shṭanīhi, RV. vi, 47, 30), to roar out, thunder, sound, cry.

**निःष्ठा** nih-shṭhā (*✓ sthā*; cf. Pāṇ. viii, 3, 65), P. ni-shṭhati, to grow forth, rise, RV.; bring to an end, finish, make ready, prepare, ChUp.: Caus. ni-shṭhāpayati (for nih-shī<sup>o</sup>), to drive out into (loc.), Kauś.; to prepare, make ready, Kātyār. **निःष्ठिता** (or nih-shī<sup>o</sup>), mfn. grown forth, RV.; finished, accomplished, ready, ŠBr.; MBh. &c.

**निःष्ठिव्** nih-✓shṭhiv, P.-shṭhivati or **व्याति**, to spit, ŠBr.; to draw lines with spittle, Daś.

**निःष्वप्** nih-shvap (*✓ svap*), P.-shvapiti, cf. Pāṇ. viii, 3, 88. **शुप्ता**, mfn., ib.

**निःस्** nih-✓sri, P.-sarati (pr. p. Ā.-sara-māna, MBh.), to go out, come forth, depart, withdraw, Mn.; MBh. &c.: Caus.-śārayati, to cause to go out, turn out, expel (abl. with or without bahis), MBh.; R. &c.; to conclude, finish, BhP. **शरा**, mfn. issuing out; -tva, n. = *pitta-roga*, L. **शराणा**, n. going forth or out, MBh.; Pañc.; issue, egress, gate, L.; means, expedient, remedy to get rid of (comp.), MBh.; departure, death, final beatitude, L.; -vat (nih-sdr<sup>o</sup>), mfn. flowing out, liquid, ŠBr. **शरा**, m. going forth or out, MBh. **शराणा**, n. turning out, expelling, Rājat.; egress or road of egress, L. **शरिता**, mfn. turned out, expelled, dismissed, MBh. &c. **शरु** or **शरुका**, m. **निःस्तृत्** nih-stṛita, mfn. (*✓ stṛi*) crumbled off from (abl.), Grīhyās. (v.l. nih-śrīta).

**निःस्पृ** nih-✓spri, P.-sprinoti (2. du. aor. -spartam, RV. vii, 71, 5), to rescue from (abl.)

**निःस्फुर्** nih-✓sphur, P.-sphuráti, to jerk or hurl away, RV.

**निःस्यन्द्** nih-syand or -shyand (*✓ syand*; Pāṇ. viii, 3, 72). **श्यांदा**, v.l. or w.r. for ni-sy<sup>o</sup>.

**निःस्रू** nih-✓sru, P.-srávati, to flow out or off, ŠBr.; rise from (abl.), Cat.; to disappear or be lost to or from (abl.), Āpast.: Caus.-srávayati, to cause to flow out (as a pond), MBh.; to cause to disappear from or be lost to or from (abl.), Āpast. **श्रावा**, m. remainder, surplus, overplus (with abl.), Yajñ. ii, 251. **श्रावा**, m. the causing to flow out, expending, expense, Kām.; the moisture or water of boiled rice, L. (cf. ni-srāva). **श्रुता**, mfn. flowed out or off, Suṣr.; passed away (time), L.

**निःस्वृ** nih-✓svri, P.-sváratí, to sing or chant away i.e. expel by singing or chanting, Kāth.

**निक** nika, n. (with prajā-pateḥ) N. of a Sāman, ĀrshBr.

**निकाक्षा** ni-kakshā, m. the arm-pit, ŠBr. &c.

**निकट** ni-kaṭa, mf(ā)n. being at the side, near; m. or n. nearness, proximity (*ṭam*, ind. near to, towards, with gen. or comp.); *ṭe*, id., near, at hand; *ṭāt*, away from, R.; Pañc.; Kathās. &c. -ga, mfn. near, at hand, Var. -vartin (Pañc.) and -stha (Daś.), mfn. id.

**निकाति**, in comp. for ni-kaṭa. -bhūya, ind. p. having become near; -bhūta, mfn. become near, approached, Kathās.

**निकथितिन्** nikathitin, mfn. (fr. ni-kathita, ✓kath), g. ishīddi.

**निकम्** ni-✓kam (Pot. -kāmayet, BhP.; p. Ā.-kāmāyamāna, TS.; pf. cakame, ŠBr.; inf. -kamam, Kāth.), to long or wish for, lust after (acc.) **कामा**, m. desire, wish, pleasure, RV.; VS.; AV.; ibc. = (am), ind. according to wish or desire, to one's heart's content, abundantly, excessively, Var.; Mricch. &c. (cf. yadā-nikāmam); (ni-śv<sup>o</sup>), mfn. desirous, covetous, greedy, RV.; m. N. of an Agni, SāṅkhGr.; -kāma, mfn. covetous, BhP.; -jala, mfn. (a river) yielding abundant water, Śak. vi, 16; -tapta, mfn. excessively burnt, Kum.; -dhārana, mfn. bearing according to wish, TBr.; -nirākuṣa, mfn. freely ruling over (gen.), Git. vii, 40; -bhāma-bhāshya, n. **निकर** ni-kara, m. (*✓ kri*) a heap, pile, a flock or multitude, a bundle, mass, collection (mfn. ifc. f. ā), MBh.; Kāv. &c.; (L.) pith, sap, essence; suitable gift, a honorarium; a treasure, the best of anything, a treasure belonging to Kubera. 1. **निकारा**, m. (L.) piling up or winnowing corn; tossing or lifting up.

**निकत्तेच्** ni-kartavya, ni-kartana, ni-karsha &c. See ni-kri, ni-krit, ni-krish &c.

**निकष्** ni-✓kash, -kashati, **ोते**, to scratch, rub, Car. **काशा**, m. rubbing in, smearing, Mālav. ii, f.; a roller or harrow, Āpast.; the touchstone, MBh.; Kāv. &c.; N. of wk.; (ā), f. N. of the mother of Rāvaṇa, (R.) or of all the Rākshasas (*śāṭmaja*, m. a Rakshas, L.); n. the streak of gold or test made on the touchstone, MBh. xii, 7471 (Nilak.); *sha-grāvan* (Hit.), *sha-pāshāṇa* (ib.), *śhāṭman* (BhP.), *shōpala* (Hariv.), m. the touchstone. **काशाना**, n. rubbing off, ĀpSr., Sch.; m. or n. the touchstone, BhP. **काशा**, ind. (g. svar-ādi) near to (with acc.), proximate, Hariv. 16038; Śiś.

**निकाय** ni-kāyā (*✓ 1. ci*) a heap, an assemblage, a group, class, association (esp. of persons who perform the same duties), Mn.; MBh. &c.; congregation, school, Buddh.; collection (of Buddh. Sūtras, there are 5, MWB. 62, 63); habitation, dwelling, hiding-place, R. (cf. Pāṇ. iii, 3, 41); the body, ŚvetUp.; the air, wind, VS. xv, 5 (Mahidh.); aim, mark, L.; the Supreme Being, L. **कायान्तरिया**, mfn. belonging to another school, Buddh. **कायिन**, m. N. of a partic. sacrifice, L. **काया**, m. or n. a dwelling-house, L.

**निकार** 1. and 2. **ni-kāra**, **रापा**, &c. See under ni-kara and ni-kri.

**निकावस्तगा** nikāvalgā, f. N. of a woman (or of two women, Nikā & V<sup>o</sup>?), Rājat. vii, 482.

**निकाश** ni-kāśa, m. (*✓ kāś*) horizon, range of sight, proximity (*śam me*, before my eyes, to me), BhP.; ifc. having the appearance of, similar, like, MBh. &c. (cf. ni-śv<sup>o</sup>, pra-k<sup>o</sup> &c.)

**निकाष** ni-kāsha. See ni-kash.

**निकास** ni-kāśa, w.r. for **काशा**.

**निकिल्बध्** ni-kilbishā, n. freeing from sin, deliverance from evil, RV.

**निकुञ्च्** ni-✓kuñc, Caus.-kuñcayati, to draw in, contract (opp. to 'stretch out'), Car. **कुचिति**, f. contraction (?), Pāṇ. vii, 2, 9, Vārtt. I, Pat. **कुच्याकर्णि**, ind. with the ears hanging down, ib. v, 4, 128, Sch. **कुञ्चा**, m. a key, Gal. **कुञ्चाका**, m. Calamus Rotang, Bhpr.; a measure of capacity equal to  $\frac{1}{2}$  of a Kudava, L. **कुञ्जाना**, n. shrinking together, contraction, Car. **कुञ्चिता**, mfn. contracted, W.

**निकुञ्जा** ni-kuñja, m. (n., L.) an arbour, a bower, thicket, MBh.; Kāv. &c. **जिक्मला**, f. a species of plant (= kuñjikā), L.

**निकुञ्जन** ni-kuñjana, n. (*✓ kuñṭi*) pounding, crushing down, Var.

**निकुञ्जा** ni-kubja, mfn. curved, bent, Lalit. **कुञ्जना**, n. upsetting (a vessel), L.

**निकुम्भम्** ni-kumbha, m. Croton Polyandrum (also ī, f., L.); N. of a Dānava (son of Prahlāda and brother of Kumbha, father of Sunda and Upasunda), MBh.; of a Rākshasa, R.; of a son of Kumbha-karna, L.; of an attendant of either Śiva (Hariv.) or Skanda (MBh.); of one of the Viśve Devās, Hariv. (viskumbhu C.); of a hero on the side of the Kurus, MBh.; of a king of A-yodhyā (son of Hary-āśva and father of Samhatāśva or Varhanāśva), Hariv.; Pur.; **भद्रक्षया-बीजा**, n. Croton Jamalgota, L. **कुम्भिता**, n. a kind of time in music. **कुम्भिला**, m. or (ā), f. (fr. kumbha?), a place where oblations are offered, (esp.) a grove at the western gate of Lānkā for the performance of sacrificial rites; (according to others) an image of Bhadra-kālī on the west side of Lānkā, R.

**निकुरम्बा** nikuramba (Mālatīm.), **रुम्बा** (Viddh.), **बाका** (Kāśikh.), m. or n. a flock, mass, multitude.

**निकुलीनका** ni-kulinakā, f. a partic. mode of flying, MBh. viii, 1902, Nilak. (v.l. **निका**).

**निकृञ्ज** ni-✓kūj, P.Ā.-kūjati, **ोते**, to warble, moan, groan, R.; BhP. **कृजिता**, mfn. warbled, sung, BhP. (*tam hānsaih*). **कृजितव्या**, n. moaning, groaning, Jātakam.

**निकूड** ni-✓kūd, P.-kūdayati (ind. p. -kūdyā), to burn, set on fire, ĀpSr.

**निकूण्** ni-✓kūn, P.-kūnati, Caus. **नायति**, to close, contract. **कूनिता**, mfn. closed, shut (esp. an eye), Desin.
