**निरभ्यवेक्ष्** *nir-abhy-avēksh* (√iksh), to search through, examine thoroughly, Kāraṇḍ.

**निरम्** *ni-√ram*, Ā. -ramate (aor. 3. pl. -a-ransata), to rest, come to rest, cease, AV.; Caus. -rāmayati (aor. -arīramat), to cause to rest, stop, detain, RV.; (-ramayati) to gladden, give pleasure (by sexual union), BhP. <sup>o</sup>rata, mfn. pleased, satisfied, delighting in, attached or devoted to, quite intent upon, deeply engaged in or occupied with (loc., instr. or comp.), Mn.; Var.; MBh.; Kāv. &c. <sup>o</sup>rati, f. delighting in, attachment to (comp.), Var. I. <sup>o</sup>ra-mana (cf. 2. *nir-am*°, next), n. resting, ceasing, Nir. ii, 7. <sup>o</sup>rāmīn, mfn. waiting, lurking, RV. ii, 23, 16.

**निरय** *nir-aya*, m. (either fr. *nis + √i*= egression, sc. from earthly life, or fr. *nir+aya* 'without happiness') Niraya or Hell (personified as a child of fear and death, BhP.), Mn.; MBh.; Kāv. &c. -pati, m. the king of hell, BhP. **Nirayāvali-sūtra**, n. N. of wk.

*Nir-āyana*, n. (√i) egression, RV.

*Nir-ayin*, m. an inhabitant of hell, BhP.

**निरद्वे** *nir-√ard*, P. -ardati, to stream forth, ŠBr.

**निरवत्त** *nir-āvatta*, <sup>o</sup>tti. See *nir-ava-do*.

**निरवदय्** *nir-ava-√day*, Ā. -dayate, to satisfy any one (acc.) with (acc. or instr.) or with respect to (abl.), TS.; Br.

**निरवदो** *nir-ava-√do*, P. -dāti or -dyati (ind. p. -dāya), to distribute or divide completely, give any one his share, appease or satisfy with (double acc.), TS. <sup>o</sup>āvatta, mfn. distributed, completely divided or allotted; -bali, mfn. whereof oblations have been distributed all round, ŠBr. <sup>o</sup>āvatti, f. (TBr.; Kāth.), <sup>o</sup>avadāna, n. (Jaim.; ĀpSr.) allotment or distribution of shares.

**निरवद्य** *nir-avadya*, -avayava &c. See *nir*, p. 539, col. 3.

**निरवधे** *nir-ava-√dhe*, P. -dhayati, to suck out, ĀpSr.

**निरवयज्** *nir-ava-√yaj*, Ā.-yajate, to satisfy a god (acc.) by means of sacrifice in preference to another god (abl.), Kāth.

**निरवसो** *nir-ava-√so*, Caus. -sāyayati, to establish, settle, furnish with (instr.), TS.; TBr. <sup>o</sup>avasita, mfn. expelled, rejected, Pāṇ. ii, 4, 10.

**निरवह्** *niravaha*, m. (fr. *nis + ava + √han*?) a kind of sword, Gal.

**निरविन्द** *niravinda*, m. (for *nir-arav*?) N. of a mountain, MBh.

**निरवेक्ष्** *nir-avēksh* (√iksh), to observe, perceive. <sup>o</sup>avēkshya, ind. having observed or perceived, Mṛicch. v, 30.

**निरष्ट** *nir-ashṭa* (√aksh), emasculated, deprived of vigour, RV.; ŠBr. (cf. *mahā-n*°).

**निरस्** *nir-√2. as*, P. **निरागम** *nir-āgama*, *nir-āgas*, &c. See p. 540, col. 1.

**निराक्ष** *nir-ā-√caksh*, Ā. -cashṭe, to refute, reject, Sarvad.

**निराचिकीषु** *nir-ā-cikirshu* (Desid. of *1. kri*), desirous of contradicting or refuting, Šāmk.

**निराजन्** *nir-āja*. See under *nir-aj*.

**निराणङ्** *nir-ā-ηaddha*, mfn. (*√nah*), Pāṇ. viii, 4, 2, Kāś.

**निरादिष्ट** *nir-ā-dishṭa*, mfn. (*√dis*) paid off (as a debt), Mn. viii, 162. <sup>o</sup>deṣa, m. complete payment or discharge of a debt, W.

**निराधा** *nir-ā-√dhā*, -dadhati, to take out of, take away, AV.; Br.

**निरामालु** *nirāmālu*, m. (*nis + āma + ālu*?) Feronia Elephantum, L.

**निरामित्र** *nir-āmitra*, w. r. for *nir-am*° (see *nir*, p. 540, col. 2).

**निरामिन्** *ni-rāmīn*. See under *nir-ram*.

**निरायम्** *nir-ā-√yam*, P. -yacchatī (ind. p. -yatya), to bring or get out, AV.; ŠBr. 2. <sup>o</sup>yata (for I. see p. 540, col. 2), mfn. stretched out, extended; -pūrva-kāya, mfn. having the fore-part of the body stretched out, Šak. i, 8.

**निरालक** *nirālaka*, m. a species of fish, L.

**निरावह्** *nir-ā-√vah*, P. -vahati, to carry off, TāndBr.; to fetch, bring, AV.

**निराविश्** *nir-ā-√viś*, P. -viśati, to retire, keep away from (abl.), MBh.

**निरास** I. 2. *nir-āsa*. See under *nir* and *nir-as*.

**निराह** *nir-āha*, m. (prob. fr. next) call, exclamation, TāndBr.

**Nir-āhava**, m. (*√hve*) id.; -vat, mfn. accompanied by an exclamation, ib. (v. l. <sup>o</sup>hā-vat).

**निरि** *nir-√i*, P. -eti (1. sg. Subj. -ayā, RV.; dat. inf. -ētave, ib.; Ā. *nir-ayate* or *nil-ayate*, Siddh. on P. viii, 2, 19), to go out, come forth, go off, depart (said of persons and things), RV.; MBh. &c.

**निरिङ्गिनी** *nirīnginī*, f. a veil, L. (cf. *nī-raṅgi*).

**निरी** *ni-√rī*, P. Ā. -riṇāti, <sup>o</sup>ṇīte, to dissolve, scatter, tear, rend, destroy, RV.; AV.; to unveil, discover (Ā.), RV. i, 124, 7; v, 80, 6; to rush forth, escape (Ā.), ix, 14, 4.

**निरीष्** *nir-√īksh*, Ā. -ikshate (<sup>o</sup>ti), to look at or towards, behold, regard, observe (also the stars), perceive, Var.; MBh.; Kāv. &c. <sup>o</sup>ikshaka, mfn. looking at, seeing, viewing, BhP.; seeing = visiting (*a-n*°), Rājat. <sup>o</sup>ikshāna, mfn. looking at, regarding (ifc.), BhP.; n. look, looking at, observing; sight, view (ifc. f. ā; cf. *dur-n*°); the aspect of the planets, Var.; R.; Suśr. &c. <sup>o</sup>ikshā, f. looking at, regarding; (*ayā*), ind. with regard to (comp.), R.; hope, expectation, W. <sup>o</sup>ikshītavya, mfn. to be looked at, Kāraṇḍ. <sup>o</sup>ikshīn, mfn. looking, seeing (see *nātidūra-n*°). **निरुच्छन्** *nir-uñchana*, n. (*√uñch*) = *nī-rājana*, Kum. xiii, 18 (v. l. *nir-māñchana*).

**निरुत** *nir-uta*, mfn. (*√ve*), Pāṇ. vi, 3, 2, Sch.

**निरुद्ध** *nir-√rudh*, P. Ā. -ruṇaddhi, -rundh, to hold back, stop, hinder, shut up, confine, restrain, check, suppress, destroy, RV. &c. &c.;
