पलक्ष *palaksha*, mf(i)n. white, VS. (cf. *balaksha*).

पलङ्क *palañkaṭa*, mfn. shy, timid, L.

पलव *palava*, m., *plava* (\sqrt{plu}), a basket of wicker-work for catching fish, L.; N. of a man, Prav.

पलस *palasa*, w. r. for *panasa*, R.

पलस्तिजमदग्नि *palasti-jamadagnī*, m. pl. the grey-haired Jamadagnis (prob. a branch of this family of Rishis), RV. iii, 53, 16 (Sāy.)

पलाक *palāka*, m. n., Siddh.

पलाण्डु *palāndu*, m. (rarely n.) an onion, Mn.; MBh.; Suśr. &c. (cf. Uṇ. i, 38, Sch.) — **भक्षिता**, m(fā or ī)n, one who has eaten onions, Pāṇ. iv, 1, 53, Sch. — **मांडना**, n. N. of a comedy.

पलाप *palāpa*, m. a halter, L.; an elephant's temples, L.

पलापहा *palāpahā*, w. r. for *malō*.

पलाय *palāy* (fr. *palā* = *parā* and $\sqrt{ay} = i$; cf. Pāṇ. viii, 2, 19, Sch.), Ā. *pālāyate*, TS.; Br.; MBh. &c. (ep. also P.; pf. *palāyām cakre*, Pañc.; aor. *apalāyishṭa*, Bhaṭṭ.; fut. *palāyishyate*, Hit.; $\circ ti$, Satr.; ind. p. *palāyya*, ŚBr. &c.; inf. *palāyitum*, Pañc.); to flee, fly, run away, escape, cease, vanish, TS. &c. &c. — **yaka**, mfn. fleeing, a fugitive, SaddhP. \circ *yana*, n. fleeing, flight, escape, MBh.; Kāv. &c. (-*kriyām* \sqrt{kri} , to take to flight, Pañc.); a saddle, TS., Sch. (cf. *paly-ayana*, *paryāna*); -*parāyāna*, mfn. occupied in flight, fugitive, W.; -*manas*, mfn. thinking of fl°, MW.; -*vishaya*, mfn. having fl° for an object, bent on fl°, ib.

पलायिता, mfn. flown, fled, defeated, TS.; Kathās. &c.; n. gallop, L. (v.l. *pulō*). **Palāyin**, mfn. fleeing, flying, taking to flight, MBh.

(for 1. see under *pala*) a leaf, petal, foliage (ifc. f. ī), ŚBr.; Gr̄ŚrS.; MBh.&c.; the blade of a sharp instrument (cf. *paraśu-pō*); the blossom of the tree *Butea Frondosa*, Pañc.; = *śmaśāna*, L.; = *paribhāshāna*, L.; m. (ifc. f. ī) the tree B° F° (its older name is *parṇa*, q.v.), Br.; MBh. &c.; *Curcuma Zedoaria*, L.; N. of Magadha, L.; (ifc. it denotes beauty, g. *vyāghrāddi*); (ī), f. a species of climbing plant, L.; cochineal, L.; red lac, L.; mfn. green, L. पलिङ्गु *palingu*, m. N. of a man, HirGr.

पलिता *palitā*, mf(ā or *páliknī*, Pāṇ. iv, 1, 39, Vārtt. I. 2, Pat.) n. grey, hoary, old, aged, RV. &c. &c.; = *pālayitri*, Nir. iv, 26; m. N. of a mouse, MBh.; of a prince, Hariv.; VP. (v.l. *pālō*); (*paliknī*), f. a cow for the first time with calf, L.; n. grey hair (also pl.), AV. &c. &c.; a tuft of hair, Daś.; mud, mire, L.; heat, burning, L.; benzoin, L.; pepper, L. [Cf. Gk. *πελτρός*, *πολιός* &c.; Lat. *palleo*, *pallidus*, *pallus*; Lith. *pālvas*; Slav. *plavū*; H. Germ. *falo*, *val*, *fahl*; Angl. Sax. *fealo*; Eng.

पलीश *palīśa*, m. = *palāśa*, Bhpr.

पलेशिनी *palesinī*, prob. w.r. for *palāśinī*, Inscr.

पल्पूलन *pálpūlana*, n. lye, water impregnated with alkaline salt, TS.; AV.; Kauś.

पल्पूलया, Nom. P. \circ *lāyati*, to wash with alkaline water, to tan, TS.; TBr. \circ *lita*, mfn. washed, tanned, ŚrS.; Baudh.

पल्य *palya* &c. See under *pala*.

पल्यङ्क *paly-āṅka*, m. = *pary-āṅka* (Pāṇ. viii, 2, 22) a bed, couch, bedstead, Sīnhās.; Pañcad.; a cloth wound round the loins while sitting on the heels and hams, L.; so sitting, squatting (cf. *pary-āṅka*), L.

पल्यङ्ग *paly-āṅg* (pali = *pari* and $\sqrt{āṅg}$), Ā. *paly-āṅgayate* (ind. p. -*āṅgya*), to cause to go round, stir round, ŚBr.: Pass. -*āṅgyate*, to turn round, revolve, ib.

पल्यय *paly-√ay* (paly = *pari* and $\sqrt{ay} = i$), Ā. *paly-ayate*, ŚBr. (cf. Pāṇ. viii, 2, 19).

Paly-ayana, n. a saddle (= *paryāṇa*), L.; a rein, bridle, Vcar.

पल्याण *palyāṇa*, n. a saddle, L. (also \circ *na*, Gal.) \circ *naya*, Nom. \circ *yati*, to saddle, Bhojacar.

पल्युल *palyula* or \circ *yūla*, Nom. P. \circ *layati*, v.l. for *palpūla*, Dhātup. xxxv, 29.

पल्ल *pall*, cl. I. *pallati*, to go, move, Dhātup. xv, 34, Vop. (invented after \sqrt{pal} , prob. to explain the following words).

(cf. below); strength, L. (= *bala*; v.l. = *vana*, a wood); red lac (*alakta*), L.; a bracelet, L.; sexual love, L.; unsteadiness, L.; m. a partic. position of the hands in dancing, Cat.; a libertine, catamite, L.; a species of fish, L.; pl. N. of a people, MBh.; Pur. (v.l. for *pahlava*); of a race of princes, Inscr. — **grāhin**, mfn. putting forth young shoots, sprouting in all directions, diffusive, superficial (as knowledge), Hit.; (with *dosha*), m. the fault of prolixity or diffusiveness, Git., Sch.; \circ *hi-tā*, f. superficial knowledge, sciolism, MW. — **dru**, m. the Aśoka tree, L. — **dhārin**, mfn. bearing blossoms (as a flower), Ragh. — **pūra**, m. Pallavana, n. prolixity, useless speech, Naish.

Pallavaya, Nom. P. \circ *yati* = 2. **pallava**, Kāv.; to spread, divulge (as news), Vcar.; to make diffuse or prolix (= *vi-stāraya*), Git., Sch.

Pallavika, m. = (or v. l. for) *pallavaka*, m., L.

Pallavita, mfn. sprouted, having young shoots (\circ *taṁ vṛikshaiḥ*, 'young shoots have been put forth by the trees'), Kāv.; spread, extended, Inscr. (*alam* \circ *tēna*, 'enough of further amplification,' A.); (ifc.) filled, full of, Kād.; dyed red with lac, L.; m. the red dye of the lac insect, W.

Pallavin, mfn. sprouting, having young shoots, Kum.; m. a tree, L.

Pallavi-√kṛi (ind. p. -*kritya*), to make or change into a very young shoot, Kāvyanād.

पल्लि *palli*, *pallī*. See under \sqrt{pall} .

पल्लल *palvala*, n. (m., Siddh.) a pool, small tank, pond. [Cf. Gk. *πηλός*; Lat. *pālus*; Lith. *pūrvas*?] **karshaka**, mfn. ploughing a pool, Hariv. — **tīra**, n. the bank or margin of a p°, Pañc. — **pañka**, m. the mud of a p°, Kālid.

Palvalāvāsa, m. 'p°-dweller,' a tortoise, L.

Palvalī-√bhū, to become a pool, Jātakam.

Palvalyā, m(fā)n. marshy, boggy, TS.

पव *pav*, cl. I. **Ā. pavate**, to go, Dhātup. xiv, 40 (v.l. for *plav*).

पव *pava*, m. ($\sqrt{pū}$) purification, winnowing corn, Pāṇ. iii, 3, 28, Sch.; air, wind, L.; a marsh, L.; N. of a son of Nahusha, VP.; (ā), f. purification, RV.; n. cow-dung, L. — **nāla**, (prob.) w.r. for *yava-nāla*.

Pāvana, m. 'purifier,' wind or the god of wind, breeze, air (ifc. f. ī), MBh.; Kāv. &c.; vital air, breath, Suśr.; Sarvad.; the regent of the Nakshatra Svāti and the north-west region, Var.; N. of the number 5 (from the 5 vital airs), ib.; a householder's sacred fire, Hār.; a species of grass, L.; N. of a son of Manu Uttama, BhP.; of a mountain, ib.;
