

पौलस्य paulastya, mfn. relating to or descended from Pulasti or Pulastya, R.; m. patr. of Kubera or Rāvaṇa, MBh.; Hariv.; R.; of Vibhishana, L.; (pl.) the brothers of Dur-yodhana, MBh.; (pl.) a race of Rākshasas, L.; the moon, L.; N. of an author; (-smṛiti, f. N. of wk.); w.r. for **paurastyā**, Kathās.; (°stī), f. patr. of Sūrpa-ṇakha (the sister of Rāvaṇa), L.

पौलाक paulāka, mfn. (fr. pūlāka), g. **pālāddi**.

पौलास paulāsa, mfn. (fr. pūlāsa), g. **samkāddi**.

पौलि pauli, n. grain half dressed or scorched or fried with ghee and made into a sort of cake, L.; patr. (also pl.), Samskārak.

पौलिका, f. a kind of cake, L. (v.l. polikā).

पौलिन्य paulinya, mfn. (fr. pulina), g. **samkāddi**.

पौलिश pauliśa, mfn. derived from or composed by Puliśa; -mata, n., -siddhānta, m. N. of astron. wks.

पौलुषि paúlushi, m. (fr. pulusha) patr. of Satya-yajña, ŠBr.

पौलोम pauloma, mfn. relating to or treating of Pulomā (N. of the 4th-12th Adhyāyas of MBh. i; cf. IW. 371, n. 1); relating to Puloman or Pulomā or Pulomi, MBh.; Hariv.; m. N. of a Rishi, Hariv.; (pl.) of a class of demons, KaushUp.; MBh. &c.; (i), f., see next.

Paulomī, f. 'daughter of Puloman,' N. of the wife of Indra, Kāv.; Pur.; of the wife of Bhṛigu (cf. *pulomā*), VāyuP. — **pati**, m. 'lord or husband of Paulomī,' N. of Indra, Bhām. — **vallabha**, m. 'lover of P°,' N. of Indra, Bālar. **Paulomisa**, m. = °mī-pati, L.

पौलक्ष paulkasá, m. (=pulkasa) the son of a Nishāda or of a Śūdra father and of a Kshatriyā mother, VS.; ŠBr. &c.

पौष pausha, mf(i)n. relating to or occurring at the time when the moon is in the asterism Pushya, Ragh.; Var.; m. the month Pausha (December-January, when the full moon is in the asterism Pushya), Gr. SrS.; MBh. &c.; N. of the 3rd year in the 12 years' cycle of Jupiter, VarBrS.; (i), f. the night or day of full moon in the month Pausha, Kauś.; n. a festival or a partic. festival, L.; a fight, combat, L.; N. of sev. Sāmans, Br. — **māhātmya**, n. N. of wk.

Paushya, mfn. relating to the asterism Pushya, MBh.; relating to king Paushya (°shyōpākhyāna, n. N. of MBh. i, 3; cf. IW. 371, n. 1); m. N. of a prince (the son of Pūshan and king of Karavīra-pura), MBh.

पौषध paushadha, m. (cf. poshadha) a fasting day, Kalpas.; HParī. (also -dina, n.)

पौष्कर्णिति paushkajiti, m. patr. (fr. pushkajit?), Samskārak.

पौष्कर paushkara, mf(i)n. relating to or made of or connected with the blue lotus, MBh.; Hariv.; Pur.; (m. with or scil. *prādūr-bhāva*, 'the appearance of Vishnu in the form of a lotus flower,' Hariv.); relating to or derived from Costus Speciosus or C° Arabicus; n. the root (with or sc. *mūla*) or fruit of C° Sp° or Ar°, Suśr.; L.; N. of wk. — **tantra**, n., -samhitā, f. N. of wks.

Paushkaraka, mfn. = *paushkara* (also with *prādūr-bhāva*), Hariv.

Paushkarasādi, m. (fr. *pushkara-sād*) N. of a grammarian, TPrāt.

Paushkariṇī, f. = *pushkariṇī*, a lotus pool, L.

Paushkareyaka, mfn., g. **kattrī-ādi**.

पौष्कल paushkula, m. (fr. pushkala) a species of grain, MārkP.; n. N. of sev. Sāmans, Br.

Paushkalāvata, m. (fr. *pushkalā-vatī*) N. of a physician, Suśr.; mfn. derived from or composed by Paushk°, ib.

Paushkaleyaka, mfn., g. **kattrī-ādi**.

Paushkalya, n. full growth, maturity, complete development, BhP.

पौष्कि paushki, m. patron. (Kāś., v.l. in g. *taulvaly-ādi*).

पौष्टिक paushṭika, mf(i)n. (fr. pushṭi) re-

lating to growth or welfare, nourishing, invigorating, furthering, promoting (with gen.), Grīhyās.; Mn.; MBh. &c.; n. a cloth worn during the ceremony of tonsure, L.

Paushṭī, f. (fr. *pushṭa*?) N. of the wife of Pūru, MBh.

पौष्टिमेर paushṭhimera, m. patron., Samskārak.

पौष्टिष्ठा paushṭha, mf(i)n. (fr. *pūshan*) belonging or relating or sacred to Pūshan, VS.; TS.; Br.; SrS.; relating to the sun, Jyot.; n. the Nakshatra Revati, Var. (w.r. °nya).

Paushṭāvata, m. pl. patron, Samskārak. (prob. w.r. for *paushṭāvata* fr. *pushṭā-vat*).

पौष्टिष्ठा paushṭha, mf(i)n. (fr. *pushṭa*) relating to or coming from or made of flowers, flowery, floral, Kāv.; Pur. (often w.r. for *paushya*, MBh.); (i), f. N. of the city of Pāṭali-putra (= *pushṭapuri*), L.

Paushṭpaka, mfn. = *paushṭha*, Hcat.; n. oxide of brass considered as a collyrium, green vitriol, L.

Paushṭpaketava, mfn. (fr. *pushṭa-ketu*) relating to the god of love, Bālar.

Paushṭpāyana, m. patr. fr. *paushṭpi*, g. *taulvaly-ādi*.

Paushṭpi, m. patr. fr. *pushṭha*, ib.

Paushṭpiya, mfn., fr. *paushṭpi*, Pān. iv, 2, 113, Sch.

पौष्टिज्ञ paushṭpāñji or °piñji, m. patr. of a teacher, VāyuP.; °piñjin, m. pl. his disciples, ib.

पौष्टिगिरि paushṭpiñdi or °piñdyā or °pidya(?), m. N. of an ancient teacher, Cat.

पौष्टिष्ठा paushya. See under *pausha*.

पौष्टिज्ञ paushṭpāñji, °yiñji, v.l. or w.r. for *paushṭpāñji*, °piñji.

पौष्कर pauskara, w.r. for *paushkara*.

प्रा pnā, f. the braided hair of Śiva, L.

प्लाट pyāt, ind. a particle used in calling, ho! hallo! L. (cf. g. cādi).

प्लाय pyāy. See *pyai* below.

प्लुक्षण pyukshṇa, m. or n. a covering for a bow (made of sinews or of the skin of a serpent; only -veshtitam dhanuh), ŠBr.; Kātyā.

प्लुष pyush, cl. 4. 10. P. *pyushyati*, *pyoshyati*, v.l. for *vyush*, Dhātup. xxvi, 7.

प्लुस pyus, cl. 4. P. *pyusyati*, v.l. for *vyush*, Dhātup. xxvi, 106.

प्ल pyai or pyāy, cl. 1. Ā. (Dhātup. xxii, 68; xiv, 17) *pyāyate* (pf. *pyāye*, Gr.; aor. apyāyi, ib.; apyāsam, AitĀr.; Prec. *pyāyishīmahi* or *pyāsishīmahi*, AV.; VS.; Br.; fut. *pyāsyate* or *pyāishyate*, Gr.; *pyātā*, *pyāyitā*, ib.), to swell, be exuberant, overflow: Caus. *pyāyāyati*, °te, AV. &c.; (Pass. *pyāyyāte*, Br.) to make overflow, fill up (mostly in comp. with ā, see ā-pyai; cf. √pi, pi).

प्लाता (TS.) or **प्लाना** (Gr.), mfn. fat, swollen (= pīna).

प्लायाना, mfn. causing to thrive, promoting growth or increase, invigorating, Nir.; n. growth, increase, Vop.

प्लायिता, mfn. fat; grown fat; increased; strengthened, refreshed (= pīna), MW.

प्रा I. prā, ind. before; forward, in front, on, forth (mostly in connection with a verb, esp. with a verb of motion which is often to be supplied; sometimes repeated before the verb, cf. Pān. viii, 1, 6; rarely as a separate word, e.g. AitBr. ii, 40); as a prefix to subst. = forth, away, cf. *pra-vṛitti*, *pra-sthāna*; as pref. to adj. = excessively, very, much, cf. *pra-cāṇḍa*, *pra-matta*; in nouns of relationship = great-, cf. *pra-pitāmaha*, *pra-pautra*; (according to native lexicographers it may be used in the senses of *gati*, ā-rambha, ut-karsha, sarvato-bhāva, prāthamya, khyāti, ut-patti, vyavahāra), RV. &c. &c. [Cf. *puras*, *purā*, *pūrva*; Zd. *fra*; Gk. πρό; Lat. *pro*; Slav. *pra*, *pro*; Lith. *pra*; Goth. *faúr*, *faúra*; Germ. *vor*; Eng. *fore*.]

प्रा 2. pra, mfn. (√pri or prā) filling, fulfilling; (n. fulfilment, ifc.; cf. ākūti-, *kakshya*, *kāma*); like, resembling (ifc.; cf. *ikshu*-, *kshura*-).

प्राइष्टिक paushṭika, mf(i)n. (fr. pushṭi) re-

प्रातःग prā-üga, n. (prob. fr. *pra-yuga*) the forepart of the shafts of a chariot, RV. (cf. *hiranya-p*); TS.; ŠBr.; Kātyā; a triangle, MānGr.; Šulbas.; m.n. = *sastra*, RV.; VS.; Br.; SrS. — *cīt*, mfn. piled up or arranged in the form of a triangle, ŠBr. — *cīti*, f. arrangement in the f° of a tr°, MaitrS. — *sastra*, n. N. of the second Sastra or hymn at the morning libation, Vait.; N. of wk. — *stotra*, n. N. of a partic. Stotra, ib. **Praūgādhyāya**, m. N. of wk.

Pra-ügya, mfn. being at or on the forepart of the shafts of a chariot, ŠBr.

प्रकङ्कत pra-kankatā, m. a partic. venomous worm or reptile, RV.

प्रकच pra-kaca, mfn. (prob.) having the hair erect, L. (cf. *ut-k*, *vi-k*).

प्रकट I. **प्रकाता**, mf(ā)n. (according to Pān. v, 2, 29 fr. *pra* + affix *kaṭa*; but prob. Prākr. = *pra-krīta*, cf. *ava-k*, *ut-k*, *ni-k*, *vi-k*, *sam-k*), evident, clear, manifest, open, plain, public, Sūryas.; Kāv.; Kathās. (prākātaḥ so 'stu, 'let him show himself'); Pur. &c.; m. N. of a Śaiva philosopher, Cat.; ibc. and (am), ind. evidently, visibly, openly, in public, Var.; Kathās.; Pañc.; -*prīti-vardhana*, m. 'evidently increaser of joy,' N. of Śiva, Śivag.; -*raktāntayana*, mfn. having the eye-corners visibly red, Pañc.; -*vaikrita*, mf(ā)n. openly inimical, Rājat.; -*sīrsha*, mfn. bearing the head uplifted, Mārcch.; -*ṭāprakāta*, mf(ā)n. open and not open, L.

प्रकरण pra-kanva, m. 'freed from evil' (?), N. of a place, Pān. vi, 1, 153, Kāt.

प्रकथ pra-√kath, P. -*kathayati* (ind. p. *kathayya*, Pān. vi, 4, 56, Sch.), to announce, proclaim, R. °*kathana*, n. announcing, proclaiming, Pān. i, 3, 32 (am), ind. enclit. after a finite word, g. *gotrāddi*.

प्रकरण pra-kamana, n. (√2. kam), Pān. viii, 4, 34, Sch. °*kamaniya*, mfn. ib.

प्रकम्प pra-√kamp, Ā. -*kampate*, to tremble, shake, quiver, MBh.; R.; to become lax, be loosened, Suśr.; to vibrate (said of sound), RPrāt.: Caus. -*kampayati*, to cause to tremble, R.; BhP.; to swing, wave, brandish, shake, Br.; Kātyā. **काम्पा**, mfn. trembling, R.; m. (ifc. f. ā) trembling or violent motion, quaking, staggering &c., MBh.; Kāv. &c. **काम्पना**, mf(ā) or ī)n. trembling violently, W.; m. wind, air, Śiś.; N. of a hell, L.; of an Asura, Kathās.; n. great trembling, violent or excessive motion, MBh.; Hariv. (cf. Pān. viii, 4, 32, Sch.) **काम्पान्या**, mfn. to be made to tremble, Vop. **काम्पिता**(!), mfn. trembling, quaking, Suparn.; R.; (fr.
