N. of a partic. plant or its root, Car.; (ā), f. Intens. of √1. *lup*) very destructive, destroying, MW.; (prob. corrupted fr. *lolubha*) very desirous or eager or covetous, ardently longing for (loc. or comp.), MBh.; Kāv. &c.; (ā), f. eager desire, appetite, longing for (loc.), MBh.; N. of a *Yoginī*, Hcat. — **त**, f., **-त्वा**, n. eager desire or longing for (comp.), greediness, cupidity, lust, Kāv; Pur.; Suśr.
