सहस्र् sahásra, n. (rarely) m. (perhaps fr. 7. *sa + hasra* = Gk. $\chi\lambda\mu\omega$ for $\chi\epsilon\sigma\lambda\omega$; cf. Pers. *hazâr*) a thousand (with the counted object in the same case sg. or pl., e.g. *sahasrena bâhunâ*, 'with a thousand arms', Hariv.; *sahasram bhishajah*, 'a thousand drugs', RV.; or in the gen., e.g. *dv° sahasre su-varnasya*, 'two th° pieces of gold', Râjat.; *catvâri sahasrâni varshânâm*, 'four th° years', Mn.; sometimes in comp., either ibc., e.g. *yuga-sahasram*, 'a th° ages', Mu., or ifc., e.g. *sahasrâśvena*, 'with a th° horses'; *sahasram* may also be used as an ind., e.g. *sahasram rishibhih*, 'with a th° Rishis', RV.; with other numerals it is used thus, *ekâdhikam sahasram* or *eka-sahasram*, 'a th° + one', 1001; *dvy-adhikam* s°, 'a th° + two', 1002; *ekâdasâdhikam* s° or *ekâdaśam* s° or *ekâdaśa-s*°, 'a th° + eleven' or 'a th° having eleven', 1011; *vinâsaty-adhikam* s° or *vinâsam* s°, 'a th° + twenty', 1020; *dve sahasre* or *dvi-sahasram*, 'two th°'; *trîni sahasrâni* or *tri-sahasram*, 'three th°' &c.), RV. &c. &c.; a thousand cows or gifts (= *sahasram gavyam* &c., used to express wealth; *sahasram satâśvam*, 'a th° cows and a hundred horses', Sâṅkhâr.), RV.; VS.; ŠBr.
