सांयुग sāmyuga, mf(i)n. (fr. sam-yuga) relating to battle (with *ku*, f. 'a battle-field'), Śiś.

Sāmyugīna, mfn. relating to war or battle, warlike, martial, Kālid.; m. a hero, great warrior, ib.

Sāmyogika, mfn. = *sāmyogāya prabhavati*, g. *sāmtāpādī*.

Sāmyaugika, mfn. related, being in relation, connected, Nir. i, 2.

सांरक्ष्य sāmrakshya, n. (fr. sam-raksha), g. *purohitāddī*.

सांराविण sāmrāviṇa, n. (fr. sam-rāvin) general acclamation or calling out of a number of people together, a general shout, uproar, Mālatīm.; Naish.

सांवत्सर sāmvatsara, mf(i)n. (fr. sam-vat-sara) yearly, annual, perennial, lasting or occupying a year (with *bhrīti*, f. 'annual wages'), ŚrS.; MBh.; BhP.; m. an astrologer, almanac-maker, MBh.; Kāv. &c.; a lunar month, L.; black rice, L.; (with *dīkṣhita*) N. of an author, Cat.; (i), f. a funeral ceremony performed a year after a person's death, L. — **ratha**, m. the sun, L. — **sūtra**, n. N. of a ch. of Bhaṭṭotpalas Comm. on VarBrS.

Sāmvatsaraka, mfn. yearly, payable in a year (as a debt), Pāṇ. iv, 3, 50; m. an astrologer (in *a-*s°), VarBrS. ii, 12, v. l.

Sāmvatsarika, mfn. yearly, annual, relating to a year, produced in a year &c. (with *bali*, m. 'annual revenue'; with *rīna*, n. 'a debt payable in a year'), AitBr. &c. &c.; relating to an annual sacrifice, Lāty.; m. an astrologer, Pañcat. — **śrāddha**, n. an annual funeral ceremony in honour of deceased ancestors (also N. of wk.), Cat. — **Sāmvatsarikālākōddishtā-śrāddha-prayoga**, m. N. of wk.

Sāmvatsarīya, mfn. = *sāmvatsara* above; (ā), f. (with *śinī*) a partic. personification, IndSt.

सांवरण sāmvvaraṇa, m. (fr. sam-varaṇa) patr. of the Vedic Rishi Manu, RAnukr.

Sāmvvaraṇi, m. id., RV. viii, 51, 3.

सांवर्ग sāmvarga, m. (fr. sam-varga) N. of a Sāman (with *Indrasya*), ĀrshBr.

Sāmvargajita, m. pl. (fr. samvarga-jit) patr. of the Gotamas, Lāty.

सांवर्त sāmvarta, mfn. written or composed by Sam-varتا, Cat.; n. N. of various Sāmans (also with *Indrasya*), ĀrshBr. — **smṛiti**, f. N. of a law-book.

Sāmvartaka, mfn. (fr. sam-vartaka = *sam-varta*) relating to or appearing at the dissolution of the universe (as fire, the sun &c.), R.; BhP.

सांवहित्र sāmvahitṛa, mfn. (fr. sam-vahitṛi = *sam-vodhṛi*), Pāṇ. iv, 3, 120, Vārit. 8, Pat.

सांवादिक sāmvādika, mfn. (fr. sam-vāda) colloquial, controversial, causing discussion, L.; m. a disputant, controversialist, logician, L.

Sāmvādya, n. (fr. sam-vādin), g. *brāhmaṇāddī*.

सांवाशिन sāmvāśina, n. (fr. sam-vāśin) bellowing together (of cows and calves), Kātyār.

सांवासिक sāmvāsika, mfn. = *sam-vāsaya prabhavati*, g. *sāmtāpādī*.

Sāmvāsyaka, n. = *sam-vāsa*, dwelling together, community of abode, MBh.

सांवाहिक sāmvāhika, mf(ā and ī)n. (fr. sam-vāha), g. *kāśy-ādi* and *guḍḍī*.

सांवित्तिक sāmvittika, mfn. (fr. sam-vitti) based on a (mere) feeling or perception, subjective, Kap., Sch.

1. **Sāmvidya**, n. (fr. 1. sam-vid) mutual understanding, agreement, TS.; PañcavBr.

2. **Sāmvidya** 2. sāmvidyā, n. (fr. 2. sam-vid) = (or prob. w.r. for) *sām-vidya*, AV.

Sāmvaidya, n. (cf. 2. sam-vedya) finding each other, meeting, Vait.

सांवृत्ति sāmvṛitti, °ttika, w.r. for *sam-vṛitti* and *sāmvittika*.

सांवेशनिक sāmvesanika, mfn. = *sam-veśa-nāya prabhavati*, g. *sāmtāpādī*.

Sāmvesya, n. (fr. sam-veśin), g. *brāhmaṇāddī*.

सांवेशिक sāmveshika, mfn. = *sam-veshāya prabhavati*, g. *sāmtāpādī*.

सांच्यवहारिक sāmvyavahārika, mf(i)n. (fr. sam-vyavahāra) current in every-day life, generally intelligible, Lāty., Sch.

सांश sānṣa, mfn. having or consisting of parts or shares, Sāmkhyapr.

सांशंसिक sāṁśansika, mfn. (fr. sam-śaṇsā) that which is recited together, GopBr.

सांशयिक sāṁśayika, mf(i)n. (fr. sam-śaya) doubtful, dubious, Nir.; Āpast.; MārkP.; hazardous, Kām. (v.l.); in doubt, uncertain, irresolute, sceptical, L. — **tva**, n. doubtfulness, uncertainty, Bādar.

सांशित्य sāṁśitya, m. patr. fr. sam-śitu (see *sam-* √*śo*), g. *gargādī*.

सांसर्गविद्य sāṁsargavidya, mfn. = *sam-sarga-vidyām adhīte veda vā*, Kāś. on Pāṇ. iv, 2, 60.

Sāṁsargika, mf(i)n. produced by or resulting from contact (*sāṁsarga*) or intercourse, Kām.; BhP.

सांसारिक sāṁsārika, mfn. (fr. sam-sāra) connected with or dependent on mundane existence, worldly, Kāv.; Śaṅk.; BhP.; being still subject to mundane existence, Kāraṇḍ.

सांसिद्धिक sāṁsiddhika, mf(i)n. (fr. sam-siddhi) effected naturally, belonging to nature, natural, native, innate, MBh.; Kāv. &c.; self-existent, existing by its own nature or essence, existing absolutely, absolute, Śaṅk.; effected by supernatural means (as spells &c.), MW. — **drava**, m. natural (as opp. to 'generated') fluidity (e.g. that of water), ib.

Sāṁsiddhya, n. the state of having attained the highest object, perfection, BhP.

सांसृष्टिक sāṁsṛiṣṭika, mfn. (fr. sam-sṛiṣṭi) directly or immediately connected, direct, L.

सांस्कारिक sāṁskārika, mfn. (fr. sam-skāra) belonging to or requisite for a funeral ceremony or other rite &c., R.

सांस्थानिक sāṁsthānika, mfn. (fr. sam-sthāna) relating or belonging to a common place of abode, a fellow-countryman (or countrywoman), Pāṇ. iv, 4, 72.

सांस्पर्शक sāṁsparśaka, n. (fr. sam-sparṣa) touch, contact, MānGṛ.

सांस्फीयक sāṁsfīyaka, mfn. (fr. sam-sphīya), g. *dhūmāddī*.

सांस्रविण sāṁsravīṇa, n. (fr. sam-srava) a general stream (of water &c., = *vrikshasya vriksham vyāpya samyak-srāvah*), L.

सांहत्य sāṁhatya, n. (fr. sam-hata; see sam-√han) connection, union, Kap.

Sāṁhananika, mfn. (fr. sam-hanana) relating to the body, bodily, corporeal, MW.

Sāṁhātika, n. (for sam-hāta) N. of the sixteenth Nakshatra after that in which the moon was situated at a child's birth, L.

सांहार sāṁhāra, w.r. for *sam-hāra*.

सांहित sāṁhīta, mf(i)n. relating to the Saṁhitā, found in the S° text or based upon it &c., Prāt.; Pāṇ., Sch. — **Sāṁhitopanishad-bhāshya**, n. N. of wk.

Sāṁhitika, mfn. = *sāṁhīta*, g. *ukthāddī*; m. the author of an astrological Saṁhitā, Gaṇit.

साक sāka, n. = 2. *sāka*, a vegetable, herb, culinary herb, Uṇ. iii, 43, Sch.

साकच् sākac (in gram.), having the Taddhita affix akac (cf. Pāṇ. v, 3, 71 &c.)

साकम् sākām, ind. (prob. fr. 7. sa + 2. añc; cf. *sāci*) together, jointly, at the same time, simultaneously, RV. &c. &c.; along with, together with, with (with instr.), ib. — **aśva**, m. N. of a man, ĀrshBr.; n. N. of a Sāman (-tva, n.), ib. — **úksh**, mfn. sprinkling together, RV. — **edhā**, m. pl. N. of the third Parvan of the Cāturmāsyas, TS.; ŚBr.; ŚrS.; a partic. Soma sacrifice lasting three days, ŚāṅkhSr. — **prasthāyīya** (TS.) or **prasthāyya** (ŚrS.), m. a partic. ceremony (also °yya-yajña, Vait.)

साक्षात् sākshāt.

sākam, in comp. for sākam. — **yúj**, mfn. joined together, RV. — **vr̄it**, mfn. rolling t° (said of wheels), PañcavBr. — **vṛidh**, mfn. growing t°, RV. — **garbha**, mfn. pregnant t°, Kauś. — **jā**, mfn. being born together or at the same time, RV.; ŚBr.

साकरुण sākuruṇḍa, w.r. for *sākuruṇḍa*.

साकर्णकायन sākarṇakāyana, mfn. (fr. *sākarnaka*), g. *pakshādi*.

Sākarṇakya, mfn. (fr. id.), g. *sāmkāśādi*.

साकल sākala, n. N. of a town in Madras (also written *sākala*), MW.

साकलायन sākalāyana, mfn. (fr. *sa-kala*), g. *pakshādi*.

Sākalya, n. totality, completeness, entireness (ena, ind. 'entirely', 'completely'), the whole, Mn.; MBh. &c. — **vacana**, n. complete perusal, L.

साकलि sākali and °likā, f. N. of a woman, Divyāv.

साकल्यक sākalyaka, mfn. sick, unwell (w.r. *sākalpaka*), Kathās.

साकाङ्क्ष sākāṅksha, mfn. having a wish or desire, wishing, desirous, longing (am, ind. 'longingly'), Kāv.; Hit.; requiring a complement, correlative, Pāṇ.; Sāh.; having significance, MW. — **ta**, f. (Sāh.), -tva, n. (Kātyār.) correlation.

साकाम्प्राज्ञायन sākāmp्रātāyana (?), m. (only pl.) a patr., Samśkārak.

साकार sākāra, mf(ā)n. having form, having any shape or definite figure, Kathās.; Sarvad.; having a fair form, beautiful (am, ind.), Hariv.; Pañcat.; MārkP. — **jñāna-vāda**, m. the doctrine (held by the Yogācāras) that ideas consist of forms or images which exist independently of the external world, Sarvad. — **siddhi**, f. N. of wk., ib.

साकाश sākāśa, mfn. with or having the light shining towards (an object), ĀśvGr.

साकुरुण sākuruṇḍa, m. a kind of plant (cf. *sa-kō*), L.

साकुल sākula, mfn. perplexed, bewildered, Kathās.

साकूत sākūta, mf(ā)n. having significance, significant, having meaning, intentional, Kāv.; Kathās.; (am), ind. intentionally, emphatically, Kathās.; accurately, attentively, ib.; n. (prob.) a desired object, Prasannar. — **smita**, n. a significant or meaning smile, wanton glance, W. — **hasita**, n. id., Git.

साकेत sāketa, n. N. of the city Ayodhyā or Oude (prob. also of other cities), Pat.; Kāv.; VarBrS. &c.; m. pl. the inhabitants of Sāketa, Cat. — **purāna** or **-māhātmya**, n. N. of a wk. (also called *Ayodhyā-māhātmya*).

Sāketaka, mfn. (fr. prec.), g. *dhūmāddī*.

Sāketana, n. the city of Sāketa, Buddh.

Sāketu, m. or f. (?), id., VP.

साकोक sākoka, m. N. of a poet, Cat.

साकोटक sākotaka, w.r. for *sākhotaka*.

साक्तव sāktava (fr. *saktu*), a beverage prepared from barley, L.

Sāktuka, mfn. = *saktuni sādhuh*, g. *guḍḍī*; = *saktave prabhavati*, g. *sāmtāpādī*; m. barley, W.; = *saktuka*, a partic. vegetable poison, L.; n. a quantity of fried barley or barley-meal, ib.

Sāktusaindhava, mfn. = *saktu-sindhusu bhavah*, Pāṇ. vii, 3, 19, Sch.

साक्ष 1. sāksh, cl. I. P. sākshati = āpnoti (used in explaining *pra-sākshate* fr. *pra-√sah*), Nir. xi, 21.

2. sāksh, mfn. (fr. 7. sa + 1. aksha) furnished with a
