*Makara* (I)—a Mt. to the north of Meru.

*Makara* (II)—a sea monster; gift of a golden one in the ceremony of digging tanks, etc.

*Makara* (III)—one of the eight *nidhis* of Kubera.

*Makara* (IV)—the Tamil month, Tai; with Sūrya,<sup>1</sup> in the Capricornus; the sun entering which, Uttarāyaṇa commences.

*Makaras*—the sons born to the daughters of Ṛkṣa.
