

असाद्र mfn. (-द्रः-द्रा-न्द्र) Fine, delicate but with interstices. E. अ priv. and साद्र coarse.

असामयिक mfn. (-कः-की-कं) Unseasonable. E. अ neg. समय time, ठञ् aff.

असामान्य mfn. (-न्वः-न्या-न्व) Peculiar, not common. n. (-न्व) Peculiar or special property. E. अ neg. सामान्य common.

असाम्यतम् ind. Unfitly, improperly, inopportunistly. E. अ priv. and साम्यतम् fitly, &c.

असाम्य n. (-न्व) 1. Difference, dissimilarity. 2. Unsuitableness, (in medicine or diet,) Unwholesomeness. 3. Disagreeableness. E. अ neg. साम्य sameness.

असार mfn. (-रः-रा-रं) 1. Sapless, pithless. 2. Vein, unprofitable. 3. Weak, feeble. n. (-र) The castor oil tree. E. अ priv. and सार juice, sap, &c.

असावधान mfn. (-नः-ना-नं) Careless, inadvertent. E. अ neg. सावधान careful.

असावधानता f. (-ता) Carelessness. E. तल् added to the last, or with ल, असावधानत्.

असाहस n. (-सं) Gentleness, absence of violence. E. अ neg. साहस violence.

असाहसिक mfn. (-कः-की-कं) Gentle, peaceable, not violent. E. अ neg. साहसिक violent.

असाहाय्य n. (-य्य) Want of assistance or co-operation. E. अ neg. साहाय्य alliance, friendship.

असि m. (-सिः) A sword, a scymitar. E. अस to cast, and इन् Una'di aff.

असिक n. (-कं) The part of the face between the under-lip and the chin. E. अस to throw, to shine, &c. and इकन् aff.

असिक्रिका f. (-का) A woman servant : see असिक्री.

असिक्री f. (-क्री) 1. A girl attending upon the inner or women's apartments. 2. A river. E. अ neg. and सित white, because her hair is not whitened by age : क्री is substituted for त्री, and the affix is डीप्.

असिगण्ड m. (-ण्डः) A small pillow.

असित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Black or dark blue. m. (-तः) 1. Black, (the colour.) 2. A name of the planet Saturn. 3. The dark fortnight of a lunar month. f. (-ता) 1. The indigo-plant. E. अ neg. and सित white.

असिताश्वशेखर m. (-रः) A Jaina or Budd'ha saint. E. असित black, अश्व a cloud, and शेखर a crest : cloud-crested.

असिताश्वरुह n. (-रुहं) The blue lotus. E. असित black or dark blue, and अश्वरुह a lotus.

असिताश्विन् m. (-श्विः) A name of VAHNI or fire. E. असित dark, smoky, अश्विन् a ray of light.

असिताश्वमन् n. (-मन्) 1. The lapis lazuli. 2. Any black or dark blue stone. E. असित black, and अश्वमन् a stone.

असितोत्पल n. (-लं) The blue lotus. E. असित and उत्पल lotus.

असितोपल n. (-लं) The lapis lazuli. E. असित blue, उपल stone.

असिदंष्ट्र m. (-ष्ट्रः) A marine monster, the Makara, considered as the emblem of KAMADEVA. E. असि and दंष्ट्र a tooth : sword-toothed.

असिदंष्ट्रक m. (-कः) See the preceding. E. As before, कन् added.

असिदन्त m. (-न्तः) A crocodile : see सकर.

असिधारा f. (-रा) The edge of a sword. E. असि and धारा edge.

असिह mfn. (-हः-हा-हं) 1. Unripe. 2. Imperfect, incomplete. 3. Unaccomplished, uneffected. 4. Unproven. E. अ neg. and सिह perfect.

असिहि f. (-हिः) 1. Failure, imperfect or incomplete accomplishment. 2. (In logic,) Want of proof, conclusion not warranted by the premises. E. अ neg. सिहि completion.

असिधाव m. (-वः) An armourer, a furbisher, a sword or tool cleaner. E. असि and धाव who polishes ; to धाव clean, अच् aff.

असिधावक m. (-कः) See the preceding. E. कन् added to the above.

असिधेनु f. (-नुः) A knife. E. असि and धेनु a bow ; the sword-like bow.

असिधेनुका f. (-का) See the preceding. E. As before.

असिपत्र m. (-त्रः) 1. The sugar-cane. 2. A hell paved with swords. n. (-त्र) 1. A sheathe, a scabbard. 2. The blade of a sword. E. असि and पत्र a leaf ; sharp as a sword, or enclosing it.

असिपत्रक m. (-कः) The sugar-cane. E. As the preceding.

असिपत्रवन n. (-नः) A hell where the trees have leaves as sharp as swords. E. असि and पत्र a leaf, वन a wood.

असिपुच्छक m. (-कः) The gangetic porpoise, (Delphinus gangeticus, Rox.) E. असि, पुच्छ a tail, and कन् affix ; sword-tailed.

असिपुत्रिका f. (-का) A knife. E. असि and पुत्रिका a daughter, an infant sword ; from its smallness.

असिपुत्री f. (-त्री) A knife. E. See the preceding.

असिनेद m. (-दः) A fetid Mimosa : see विटखदिर. E. असि and नेद marrow, essence ; the plant being described with many thorns, and a decoction of it being emulcent.

असिहेति m. (-तिः) A swordsman or soldier armed with a sword. E. असि and हेति a weapon.

असु m. pl. always, (असवः) The five vital breaths or airs of the body. n. (-सु) 1. Reflexion, thought, or the heart as the seat of it. 2. Affliction. E. असु to be, &c. and उ Una'di aff.

असुकर mfn. (-रः-रा-रं) Difficult, arduous. E. अ neg. सुकर easy.

असुक्षण n. (-णं) See असूक्षण.

असुख n. (-खं) Sorrow, pain, affliction, &c. E. अ neg. and सुख pleasure.

असुखावह mfn. (-हः-हा-हं) Producing unhappiness. E. असुख and आवह what bears.

असुखिन् mfn. (-खी-खिनी-खि) Unhappy, sorrowful, afflicted. E. असुख and इनि aff.

असुखोदय mfn. (-यः-या-यं) Causing or ending in unhappiness. E. असुख and उदय rising.

असुखोदकं mfn. (-कं-का-कं) Productive of or ending in unhappiness. E. असुख and उदकं subsequent.

असुगम mfn. (-मः-मा-मं) 1. Difficult of attainment or accomplishment, hard, unattainable. 2. Difficult to be understood. E. अ neg. सु easily, गम going.

असुत mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Childless. E. अ neg. सुत a son, &c.

असुधारण n. (-णं) Life, existence. E. असु vital air, and धारण possession.

असुनिरस mfn. (-सः-सा-सं) Disagreeable, unpleasant, offensive. E. अ neg. सुनिरस agreeable.

असुन्दर mfn. (-रः-रा-रौ-रं) 1. Plain, ugly. 2. Improper, unbecoming. E. अ neg. सुन्दर handsome.

असुधत् mfn. (-धत्) Living, alive. E. असु and धत् possessing.

असुमत् mfn. (-मान्-मती-मत्) Living, breathing. m. (-मान्) Life, the principle of vitality, the portion of spirit connected with the attributes of existence. E. असु vital air, मत्प् poss. aff.

असुर mf. (-रः-रा) An Asura or demon : the Asuras are children of DIRI by KASYAPA ; they are demons of the first order, and in perpetual hostility with the gods. m. (-रः) The sun. f. (-रा) 1. Night. 2. A zodiacal sign. 3. A prostitute. f. (-री) 1. Black mustard, (Sinapis ramosa.) 2. The wife of an Asura. E. अ neg. and सुर a deity ; or असु to send, to cast, &c. and उरन् Una'di affix, टाप् and डीप् for the fem. or अ neg. and सुरा spirituous liquor, personified as a damsel produced at the churning of the ocean, who was rejected by the demons and received by the gods.

असुरच mfn. (-चः-चा-चं) Perishable, volatile, transitory. E. अ neg. सु easy रचा preservation.

असुररक्ष्य mfn. (-क्ष्यः-क्ष्या-क्ष्यं) Difficult of retention or preservation. E. अ neg. सु easily, रक्ष्य to be kept.

असुररिपु m. (-पुः) A name of VISHNU. E. असुर and रिपु an enemy, the foe of the Asuras.

असुरसा f. (-सा) A sort of basil, (Ocymun pilosum.)

असुराह n. (-हः) Bell metal. E. असुर and आह a name ; named after an Asura ; struck at seasons of worship, and deterring his approach.

असुर्चण n. (-णं) See असूर्चण.

असुलभ mfn. (-भः-भा-भं) Difficult of attainment. E. अ neg. सुलभ easily got.
