

उग्रन् mfn. (-ग्रन्-ग्रती-ग्रत्) Inauspicious, (as discourse.) E. उष् to burn, गृह part. affix ; also उवत्.

उग्रनस् m. (-नाः) A name of SUKRA, regent of the planet Venus. E. वस् to wish, कनसि Una'di aff.

उग्रिन् m. (-ग्रिक्) 1. Fire. 2. Ghee or boiled butter. E. वस् to wish, Una'di affix इज्, and व changed to उ.

उशी f. (-शी) Wish, desire. E. वस् to wish, ई Una'di aff.

उशीर m. (-रः) 1. The name of a country, (Candahar.) 2. A king, the father of Sivi. E. उशी desire, नर a man.

उशीर mn. (-रः-र) The root of a fragrant grass, (Androgon muricatum.) f. (-री) A sort of grass, a small sort of Saccharum. E. वस् to desire, ईरन् Una'di affix ; also with कन् added उशीरक.

उष r. 1st cl. (ओषति) To burn. (उ,) उषु (ओषति) To kill or injure : with प्र prefixed, this root makes प्रोषति, &c.

उष m. (-षः) 1. Early morning, dawn, day-break. 2. A libidinous man. 3. Bdellium. 4. Saline earth. f. (-षा) 1. A cow. 2. Burning, scorching. 3. A proper name, the wife of ANIRUDD'HA. 4. Night. 5. A pot ; also उषा. ind. The end of night or day-break. E. उष् to burn, क affix and fem. do टाप् ; the affix of the particle is का.

उषण n. (-णं) Black pepper. f. (-णा) 1. Long pepper. 2. Chai, (Piper chavya.) 3. Dried ginger. E. उष् to burn, कनच् aff.

उषत् mfn. (-षन्-षती-षत्) Inauspicious, (as discourse :) see उग्रत्.

उषप m. (-पः) 1. The sun. 2. Fire. E. उष् to burn, पच् aff.

उषुषु म. (-षः) Fire. E. उषस् dawn, वृष् to know, क aff.

उषस् n. (-षः) 1. The dawn, morning. f. (-शी) The end of the day, twilight. E. उष् to burn, षसि Una'di aff.

उषस्य mfn. (-स्यः-स्य-स्य) Belonging to the dawn. E. उषस् and य aff.

उषाकल m. (-कः) A cock. E. उषा dawn, कल् to sound, कच् aff.

उषापति m. (-पतिः) A name of ANIRUDD'HA, the son of KAMADEVA. E. उषा and पति a lord, a master ; the husband of USHA.

उषारमण m. (-णः) ANIRUDD'HA : see the preceding. E. उषा and रमण a husband, &c.

उषित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) 1. Stale. 2. Burnt. 3. Quick, expeditious. 4. Fixed, remaining in or on. 5. Inhabited, dwelt. E. उष् to burn, or वस् to abide, affix क्त.

उषितङ्गवीन mfn. (-नः-ना-नं) Formerly inhabited by cattle. E. उषित inhabited, गवीन appertaining to cattle, from गी with खश् affix : see अषितङ्गवीन.

उषित्वा ind. Having resided in. E. वस् to abide, क्वा aff.

उषीर mn. (-रः-र) The root of the Andropogon muricatum. E. वस् to desire, ईरन् affix, श् becomes षः see उशीर. [उषापति.

उषेश m. (-शः) A name ANIRUDD'HA. E. उषा and ईश lord, husband : see उष्य.

उष्य mfn. (-ष्यः-ष्या-ष्यं) Fit to be dressed in a pot, or boiled, (meat, &c.) E. उषा a pot, यत् affix ; also उष्य.

उष्ट्र m. (-ष्ट्रः) 1. A camel. 2. A cart, a vehicle of burthen. f. (-ष्ट्री or -ष्ट्रीका) An earthen vessel. 2. A she camel. E. उष् to burn, and ष्ट्रन् Una'di affix, fem. affix ङीष् or टाप् with इक् inserted.

उष्ट्रकाण्ठी f. (-ण्ठी) A flower of a red colour.

उष्ट्रकीर्णिन् mfn. (-कीर्ण-कीर्ण-कि) Making a noise like a camel. E. उष्ट्र and कृष् to cry, णिनि aff.

उष्ट्रनीयुग n. (-युगं) A pair of camel. E. उष्ट्र and नीयुग a couple.

उष्ट्रशीव m. (-शः) Hemorrhoids. E. उष्ट्र and शीवा the neck.

उष्ट्रधूसरपुष्पिका f. (-का) A tree.

उष्ट्रपादिका f. (-का) Arabian jasmin. E. उष्ट्र and पाद a foot : from the shape of its flowers.

उष्ट्रयान n. (-यानं) A camel litter, a vehicle drawn or borne by camels. E. उष्ट्र and यान a carriage.

उष्ट्रशिरः m. (-रः) Piles, hemorrhoids, bleeding piles. E. उष्ट्र a camel, शिरस् head, and शर what has.

उष्ण mfn. (-ष्णः-ष्णा-ष्णं) 1. Hot, warm. 2. Pungent, acrid. 3. Sharp, active.

4. Impetuous, warm, passionate. m. (-ष्णः) 1. The hot season, (June and July.) 2. Heat, warmth. 3. Sunshine. 4. An onion. 5. A sigh. f. (-ष्णा) 1. Consumption. 2. Bile. E. उष् to burn, षक् aff.

उष्णक mfn. (-कः-का-कं) 1. Sharp, smart, active. 2. Suffering pain. 2. Bent, inclining, stooping. 4. Warming, heating. m. (-कः) 1. The hot season, two months about June and July. 2. Revolving, turning round. E. वृन् added to the preceding.

उष्णता f. (-ता) Heat, warmth. E. तल् added to उष्ण ; also with लं, उष्णत्, उष्णदी f. (-दी) The river of hell. E. उष्ण hot, नदी a river.

उष्णरश्मि m. (-रश्मिः) The sun. E. उष्ण and रश्मि a ray.

उष्णवारण mn. (-णः-णं) An umbrella or parasol, a Ch'hattah. E. उष्ण heat, and ष to screen, affix लुट्.

उष्णवायु m. (-वायुः) 1. Hot vapour, steam. 2. Tears. E. उष्ण and वायु vapour.

उष्णवीर्य m. (-वीर्यः) 1. The gangetic porpoise. 2. Any hot or pungent substance. E. उष्ण heat, वीर्य power, strength.

उष्णायु m. (-युः) The sun. E. उष्ण and अयु a ray.

उष्णगम m. (-गमः) The hot season, consisting of two months, about June and July. E. उष्ण heat, and गमन arrival.

उष्णभिगम m. (-भिगमः) The hot season, as above. E. उष्ण and भिगम approach.

उष्णालु mfn. (-लुः-लुः-लु) Suffering from heat. E. उष्ण and आलु aff.

उष्णसह m. (-हः) The cold season. E. उष्ण warmth, असह intolerant.

उष्णिका f. (-का) Rice gruel. E. उष्ण warm (rice,) वृन् aff.

उष्णिह् f. (-ष्णिक्) A verse of four lines, each line being of seven syllables : it is used chiefly in the Vedas. E. उष् prefixed to णिह् to be unctuous or bland, क्तिन् aff.

उष्णीष mn. (-षः-षं) 1. A turban. 2. A diadem. 3. A distinguishing cognate mark. 4. The curly hair with which a Budd'ha is born, and which indicates his future sanctity. E. उष्ण heat, ईष् to oppose or injure, क aff.

उष्णीषधारिन् mfn. (-री-रिषी-रि) Turbaned. E. उष्णीष and धारिन् who wears.

उष्णोदक n. (-कं) Warm or hot water. E. उष्ण and उदक water.

उष्णोपगम m. (-गमः) The hot season, summer. E. उष्ण, उपगम arrival.

उष्ण m. (-ष्णः) 1. The hot season, (June and July.) 2. Spring, (April and May.) 3. Heat. 4. Anger, warmth of temper. 5. Ardor, eagerness. E. उष् to burn, षक् affix ; also with कन् affix उष्क, also उष्ण and उष्णक.

उष्णन् m. (-ष्णः) 1. The hot season. 2. Heat. E. उष् to burn, and षनिन् aff.

उष्णपा m. (-पाः) A heavenly spirit of an inferior order.

उष्णभास् m. (-भाः) The sun. E. उष्ण and भास् what shines.

उष्णस्वेद m. (-दः) A vapour bath. E. उष्ण and स्वेद sweat.

उष्णगम m. (-गमः) The hot season : see उष्णगम.

उष्म m. (-ष्मः) 1. A bull. 2. A ray of light. f. (-ष्मा) 1. A cow. 2. A plant, (Anthericum tuberosum, Rox.) E. वस् to dwell, रक् Una'di aff.

उष्मधन्वन् m. (-न्वः) INDRA.

उष्ट्र r. 1st cl. (उष्ट्रि) उष्ट्रि (ओषति) or (उष्ट्रि) उष्ट्रि (उष्ट्रति) 1. To hurt or give pain. 2. To kill, to destroy. With वि and षप् pre. to destroy, to remove.

उष्ट्रान m. (-नः) The name of a country.

ज The sixth vowel of the Sanskrit alphabet, corresponding to U long, and having the sound of that letter in the word rule.

ज ind. 1. An incipient particle. 2. An interjection of compassion. 3. Of regard. m. (जः) The moon. E. ज् to go, क्तिप् affix, व becomes ज.

जड mfn. (-दः-दा-दं) 1. Married. 2. Carried as load or burthen. f. (-दा) A bride, a wife espoused according to the ritual. E. वद् to bear, क्त aff.

जडकवट mfn. (-टः-टा-ट) Armed, mailed. E. जड borne, कवट armour.
