

काष्ठनक m. (-कः) Mountain ebony, &c. n. (कं) Yellow orpiment. E. काष्ठन gold, &c. and कन् affix, implying resemblance or identity.

काष्ठनकन्दर m. (-रः) A gold-mine. E. काष्ठन, and कन्दर a cave.

काष्ठनकारिणी f. (-णी) a plant, (*Asparagus racemosus* :) see शतमूली.

काष्ठनगिरि m. (-रिः) Mount Sumeru. E. काष्ठन, and गिरि a mountain ; the golden mountain.

काष्ठनचय m. (-यः) A heap of gold. E. काष्ठन, and चय assemblage.

काष्ठनभू f. (-भूः) 1. Gold-dust. 2. A Golden or yellow soil. E. काष्ठन, and भू soil.

काष्ठनमय mfn. (-यः-यी-यं) Golden. E. काष्ठन, and मयट् aff.

काष्ठनवप्र m. (-प्रः) A hill or mound of gold. E. काष्ठन, and वप्र a mound.

काष्ठनसन्धि f. (-न्धिः) A treaty of friendship between two parties on equal terms. E. काष्ठन, and सन्धि alliance.

काष्ठनाल m. (-लः) Mountain ebony, (*Bauhinia variegata*, &c.) E. काष्ठन gold, and अल् to be able or like ; some copies read काष्ठनार.

काष्ठनीया f. (-या) A yellow pigment, commonly Goroohana. E. काष्ठी to shine, अनौर aff.

काष्ठी f. (-ष्ठीः) See काष्ठी.

काष्ठीक n. (-कं) Sour gruel : see काष्ठीक

काष्ठी f. (-ष्ठी) 1. A woman's zone or girdle. 2. The name of an ancient city situated in the peninsula, and one of the seven sacred cities of the Hindus. 3. A plant, (*Abrus precatorius* :) see गुञ्जा. E. कश्चि to bind or shine, इन् or डीष् affixes ; whence also काष्ठी.

काष्ठीपद n. (-दं) Mons veneris, the public region. E. काष्ठी the zone, and पद place, site.

काष्ठीक nf. (-कः-का) Sour gruel, the water of boiled rice in a state of spontaneous fermentation. E. क water, अञ्च् to go, &c. and affix इक ; also the vowel being lengthened काष्ठीक, or without the final, काष्ठी.

काष्ठ m. (-ठः) A stone, a rock. E. कठ् to be hard, &c. अण् affix ; also with कन् added, काष्ठक.

काष्ठक mfn. (-कः-की-कं) According to the Katha portion of the Vedas. E. कठ, and वृञ् aff.

काष्ठिन m. (-नः) The date fruit. n. (-नं) 1. Hardness. 2. Sternness. E. कठिन, and अण् aff.

काष्ठिन्य n. (-न्यः) 1. Hardness. 2. Difficulty, obscurity. 3. Sternness, severity. E. कठिन hard, and अण् aff.

काष्ठा mfn. (-ष्ठाः-ष्ठा-ष्ठी) One-eyed, monocular. m. (-ष्ठाः) A crow E. कष् to sound, &c. अण् aff.

काष्ठाक m. (-कः) A crow. E. कष् to sound, &c. and ककन् Unadi aff.

काष्ठीय mfn. (-यः-यी-यं) One-eyed. E. काष्ठा, and टक् aff.

काष्ठीर mfn. (-रः-री-रं) One-eyed. E. काष्ठा, and टक् aff.

काष्ठ mn. (-ष्ठः-ष्ठं) 1. A stalk or stem. 2. The part of the trunk of a tree whence the branches proceed. 3. A cluster, a clump. 4. An arrow. 5. Opportunity, season. 6. Water. 7. A kind of reed, (*Saccharum sara*.) 8. A multitude, a heap, a quantity. 9. A horse. 10. A chapter, a section. 11. The part in a sacrifice appropriated to different objects, as the gods or manes. 12. A long bone, a bone of the extremities. 13. Praise, flattery. 14. Private, privacy. 15. Low, vile, bad. 16. Sinful, wicked. E. कन् to shine, &c. उ Unadi affix, and the radical vowel male long.

काष्ठकाष्ठक m. (-कः) A species of grass. E. काष्ठ repeated.

काष्ठहार m. (-रः) The betel-nut, the fruit of the areca.

काष्ठगीचर m. (-रः) An iron-arrow. E. काष्ठ a stem or stalk, and गीचर an object of sense ; it is fired from a stock like the arrow of the cross bow.

काष्ठी f. (-ष्ठी) A plant, commonly Ramaduti : see सूक्ष्मपर्वी.

काष्ठतिक्त m. (-कः) A kind of gentian, (*Gentiana cheryta*, Rox.) E. काष्ठ the stem, and तिक्त sharp, bitter, कन् added to this and similar compounds.

काष्ठनील m. (-लः) A plant with an astringent bark, commonly Lodh. E. काष्ठ, and नील blue.

काष्ठपट m. (-टः) An outer tent, a screen surrounding a tent. E. काष्ठ a stem, &c. and पट a cloth ; also with कन् added काष्ठपटकः.

काष्ठपुष्प n. (-ष्पः) A small fragrant flower, commonly Dona, (*Artemisia*.) E. काष्ठ the stem, and पुष्प flower ; flowering from the stalk.

काष्ठपृष्ठ mfn. (-ष्ठः-ष्ठा-ष्ठं) Of the military profession, a soldier. m. (-ष्ठः) 1. The husband of a Vaisya female. 2. An adopted or any other than the natural son. n. (-ष्ठः) The bow of कामा. E. काष्ठ an arrow, and पृष्ठ the back : see काष्ठस्यट्. [breaking.

काष्ठभ्रम n. (-भ्रः) A fracture of either of the extremities. E. काष्ठ, and भ्रम

काष्ठरुहा f. (-रुहा) A medicinal plant : see कटुकौ. E. काष्ठ the stem of a tree, and रुहा what ascends ; hence it appears to be a creeper.

काष्ठर्षि m. (-र्षिः) Rishi or divine saint of a peculiar class ; Jaimini and others who teach a particular Kanda or section of Vedas. E. काष्ठ a section, and ऋषि a saint.

काष्ठवत् mfn. (-वान्-वती-वत्) Armed with an arrow, an archer. E. काष्ठ an arrow, and मतुप् poss. aff.

काष्ठसन्धि m. (-न्धिः) A knot, a joint in the stem of a tree, &c. E. काष्ठ a stem, and सन्धि union.

काष्ठस्यट् mfn. (-ष्ठः-ष्ठा-ष्ठं) Of the military profession, living by arms, a soldier. E. काष्ठ an arrow, &c. सृष् to touch, and क्त aff.

काष्ठहीन n. (-नं) A fragrant grass, a sort of cyperus : see मद्रसुसक. E. काष्ठ a stem, and हीन deprived.

काष्ठीर mfn. (-रः-रा-रं) Armed with an arrow, an archer. m. (-रः) 1. A creeping plant, commonly Kanda Bel, (*Momordica charantia*.) 2. A plant, (*Achyranthes aspera*.) f. (-रः) Bengal madder, (*Rubia manjit'h* :) see मञ्जिष्ठा. E. काष्ठ an arrow, a stem, &c. and ईरच् aff.

काष्ठेक्षु m. (-क्षुः) 1. A plant, (*Barleria longifolia*.) 2. A kind of reed, (*Saccharum spontaneum* :) see काष्ठा. E. काष्ठ, and इक्षु sugar-cane ; having a similar stem.

कातर mfn. (-रः-रा-रं) 1. Confused, perplexed, disordered. 2. Timid, gentle. m. (-रः) A large kind of fish, commonly Katala (*Cyprinus catla*, HAM.) E. का a little or badly, and तर what crosses.

कातरता f. (-ता) Timidity, agitation. E. तच् added to कातर ; also with ल्, कातरलं.

कातल m. (-लः) The name of a fish, commonly Katala, (*Cyprinus catla*, HAM.) E. See कातर, र changed to ल.

कातीय m. (-यः) 1. A name of KATYAYANA. 2. A pupil of the same. E. कात्यायन with फक् affix and the middle syllable dropped ; also कात्यायनीय. [टकच् aff.

कात्थक mfn. (-कः-का-कं) Produced from any tad triad. E. कत्थ, and कात्थ m. (-थः) The name of a saint ; also कात्यायन. E. कत a proper name, and यच् affix implying descent or lineage.

कात्यायन m. (-नः) 1. The name of a celebrated lawgiver and divine sage. 2. An appellation of VARARUCHI a poet. E. कात्थ, and फक् pleonastic affix. f. (-नी) 1. A name of DURGA. 2. A middle-aged widow. E. डीष् added to कात्यायन ; the daughter of the saint KATYAYANA, (DURGA,) or resembling the wife of a sage in dress and austerity, (the widow.)

कात्यायनीय m. (-यः) A pupil of KATYAYANA. E. कात्यायन, and फक् aff.

काथिक mfn. (-कः-की-कं) Belonging to a story, told in it, &c. m. (-कः) A narrator. E. कथा, and टक् aff.

कादम्ब n. (-म्बः) 1. A tree, (*Nauclea cadamba*.) 2. A drake, or, according to some, a teal. 3. An arrow. f. (-म्बा) A plant, commonly Mundiri : see कदम्बपुष्प. E. अण् added to कादम्ब.

कादम्बक m. (-कः) An arrow. E. कन् added to the preceding.

कादम्बर n. (-रं) The surface or skim of coagulated milk. m. (-रः) A spirituous liquor distilled from the flowers of the Kadamba. f. (-री) 1. Wine, spirituous liquor in general. 2. A name of SARAS-
