गीलास m. (-स:) A mushroom, a kind of fungus spinging from cowdung. गीलिइ m. (-इ:) A plant, commonly Ghantaparuli. गोसन m. (-न:) The sacrifice of a cow, one of the grand sacrifices of the Hindus in former times, and not permitted in the present or Kali yuga age: see गोमेष. E. जी a cow, and सन sacrifice.
