विचतुर mfn. plur. (-रा:-राचि) Three or four. E. वि, and चतुर् four, अच added.

विजातक n. (-कं) Three spices collectively, mace, cardamoms, and cassia leaf. E. ति, and जातक species.

विज्या f. (-ज्या) A radius, a sine of three signs or ninety degrees. E. fa, and ज्या a sine.

विष n. (-स') Grass, meadow grass. E. See हस, ऋ heing changed to रि। विषता f. (-ता) l. A bow. 2. The state or abstract property of grass.

E. विष for हस grass, and तस aff

विणाचिकेत n. (-तं) A portion of the Yajur Veda. m. (-त:) A follower of that branch of the Vedas. It is also sometimes read ट्रणाचिकेत।

বিবল nf. (-ল্-লী) An assemblage of three carpenters. E. वि three, तच a carpenter, affix অভ্ৰম্মত।

वितय mfn. (-य:-या-यं) Third. E. वि three, तयप aff.

বিবয় n. (-ছে') 1. Three staves collectively. 2. Triple subjection of words, thoughts, and acts; the state of a religious ascetic. E. বি three, বয়ৰ a staff, &c.

विद्राहणारण n. (-णं) Carrying three staves tied together, (as done by some mendicants.) E. विद्राह, and धारण holding.

নিবজিল্ m. (-জ্জী) 1. A wandering devotee, one who carries three long bamboo staves in his right hand. 2. The religious man who has obtained a command over his words, thoughts, and actions, or mind, body, and speech. E. নি three, and ব্জ a punishment, a staff, &c. হনি aff.

विदला f. (ला) A creeping plant, (Cissus pedata.) E ति three, and दल a leaf.

निदम m. (-ज:) A god, a deity, an immortal, E. नि the third, and दशा state, being, (youth;) enjoying perpetual youth, or नि three, and दश state, subject as well as mortals to the three conditions, of birth, being, and destruction.

विदय mfn. (-ग्र:-ग्रा-ग्र') Thirteenth. f. (-ग्री) The thirteenth day of the fortnight; also विशेदग्र।

विद्रम्दीर्घिका f. (-का) The heavenly Ganges. E. विद्रम् a deity, and दीर्घिका a long pool.

विदश्न mfn. plu. (-श्र) Thirteen. E. वि three, and दश्न ten.

विद्यानदी f. (-दी) The heavenly Ganges. E. विद्या, and नदी a river.

विदश्पित m. (-ति:) INDRA. E. विदश, and पति chief.

विद्मवधु f. (-धू:) A nymph of Indra's heaven. E. विम्रद, and बधु wife.

विदयनिता f. (-ता) A nymph of Indra's heaven. E. विदय, and निता a wife.

विद्गाङ्ग n. (-ग्रं) The thunderbolt. E. विद्गा a deity, and श्रङ्ग a goad. विद्गाचार्य m. (-थ्रं:) The preceptor of the gods, VRIHASPATI. E. विद्गा a deity, and श्राचार्य a teacher.

विदशायुष n. (-ध') The thunderbolt of INDRA, E. विदश् a deity, and बायुष a weapon.

विद्यारि m. (-रि:) An Asura or infernal being hostile to the gods, a Titan, a Giant. E. विद्या a deity, and परि a foe.

तिदशास्त्र m. (-य:) 1. Swarga, Indra's heaven or paradise. 2. The mountain Sumeru. E. तिदश a deity, and शास्त्र an abode.

विद्यावास m. (-स:) Swarga, the heaven of INDRA. E. विदय a god, and आवास abode.

विद्याहार m. (-र:) Amrita or ambrosia. E. विद्य a deity, and पाहार food. विदालिका f (-का) A plant, commonly Charmaghasa.

विदिन n. (-नं) Three days collectively. E. वि, and दिन a day.

विदिनस्ग्र् m. (-सृक्) Conjunction or concurrence of three lunations with one solar day. E. विदिन, and सृश् contact.

निदिव mn. (-व:-वं) 1. Swarga or paradise. 2. Sky, atmosphere, heaven. f. (-वा) The name of a river. E. fa the three, Bramha, Vishnu, and Siva, दिव् to sport, affix क ; the place where these three gods take divine pleasure.

निदिवेश m. (-श:) A god, a deity. E. निदिव heaven, and ईश master or lord.

विदिवीकस् m. (-का:) A god, a celestial. E. विदिव heaven, and श्रीकस् asylum.

बिह्म् mfn. (-हक्) Tri-ocular, three-eyed. m. (-हक्) A name of Siva. E. बि three, and हम् an eye.

विदोष n. (-एं) Disorder of the three humours of the body, vitiation of the bile, blood, and phlegm. E. वि three, and दीष a fault.

बिदीषम min. (-म:-मी-म') Correcting the vitiated state of the three humours. E. बिदीष, and म what destroys.

विदोषज m. (-ज:) Disease, &c. proceeding from disorder of the three humours of the body. E. विदोष, and ज produced.

विधा ind, In three ways. E. fa, and धाच aff.

विधात m. (-तु:) A name of Ganesa, n. (-त) Three minerals, &c. E. वि three, and धात mineral, &c. चीन धर्मार्थकामान् दधाति पुणाति धा-तुन्।

विधासन् mfn. (-सा-सा-स) Having three residences, &c. m. (-सा) 1. A name of Vishnu. 2. An appellation of Siva. 3. Agni or fire. 4. Death. E. fa three (worlds,) and धासन् abode.

विनयन mfn. (-न:-नी-नं) Three-eyed, tri-ocular. m. (-न:) A name of SIVA.

B. वि three, and नयन an eye; this deity is represented with a third eye in his forehead; also similar compounds, as विहम, विनेव, वाज, &c.

विनेव min. (-व:-वा-व') Tri-ocular. m. (-व:) SIVA. E. वि, and नेव eye.

तिनेतचूडामिक m. (-क्रि:) The moon. E. तिनेत SIVA, चूडा a crest, and मिक a gem; being worn by that deity as his crest.

विषच n. (-चं) A period of six weeks. E. वि, and पच a fortnight.

विषताक m. (-क:) 1. The forehead marked naturally with three horizontal lines. 2. The hand with three fingers erect. E. वि three or three-fold, and पताका a banner, a symbol.

त्रिपत mfn. (-त:-ता-त') Three-leaved trefoil. m. (-त:) A bell tree, (Ægle marmelos.) E ति, and पत्र leaf.

नियम m. (-क:) The Kinsuka tree, (Butea frondosa) E. नि three, and पन a leaf; having three leaves on each stalk.

निषय n. (-य) 1. A place where three roads meet. 2. Three ways or paths. E त्र, and पय a road.

विषयगा f. (-गा) The Ganges. E. विषय three roads, and गा who goes, flowing through earth, heaven, and hell.

निपद mfn. (-द:-दा-दी-दं) 1. Three-footed. 2. Having three lines or divisions, (a stanza.) 3. (In Arithmetic,) Trinomial. n. (-दं) 1. A tripod. f. (-दा) A verse of three lines, as the Gayatri. f. (-दी) 1. A creeper, (Cissus pedata.) 2. The girth of an elephant. E. नि three, and पद a foot.

निपर्ण mfn. (-र्ण:-र्णी-र्ण) Three leaved trefoil. f. (-र्णी) Wild cotton. E. नि three, and पर्ण a leaf.

बिपाइ m. (-पाइ) 1. A name of VISHNU. 2. Fever, (personified.) E. वि three, and पाइ foot or part, three-footed, alluding to VISHNU'S three steps which paced the universe; and the demon of fever is described in the Puranas, with three feet, and three heads, alluding probably to its three stages of cold, hot, and sweating.

निपिन m. (-व:) A long-eared goat. E. नि, and पिन who drinks, touching water with both ears as he laps.

विषिष्टप n. (-पं) 1. Heaven, Swarga or paradise. 2. Skv, æther. E. पिष्टप a world, and वि three, or the third; also विविष्टप।

विपिष्टपसद m. (-सद) A deity. E. विपिष्टप heaven, and सद who goes, from सद with क्षिप affix; also विविष्टपसद।

fayz m. (-z:) 1. Pulse, pease of three kinds. 2. A bank or shore. 3. A kind of vetch, (Cicer arietinum.) 4. A cubit. 5. A plant, (Ruellia longifolia) f. (-zī-zī) A plant, (Convolvulus turpethum.) f. (-zī) Small cardamoms. 2. Arabian jasmine. 3. A goddess. E. fā three, and yz skin or coat of a seed, &c.
