

विचतुर mfn. plur. (-राः-राः-राणि) Three or four. E. वि, and चतुर् four, अच् added.

विजातक n. (-कं) Three spices collectively, mace, cardamoms, and cassia leaf. E. वि, and जातक species.

विज्या f. (-ज्या) A radius, a sine of three signs or ninety degrees. E. वि, and ज्या a sine.

विण n. (-ण) Grass, meadow grass. E. See वृण, ऋ being changed to रि ।

विणता f. (-ता) 1. A bow. 2. The state or abstract property of grass. E. विण for वृण grass, and तल् aff.

विणाचिकेत n. (-तं) A portion of the Yajur Veda. m. (-तः) A follower of that branch of the Vedas. It is also sometimes read वृणाचिकेत ।

चित्तच nf. (-च-चै) An assemblage of three carpenters. E. वि three, तच् a carpenter, affix अच् समा० ।

वितथ mfn. (-यः-या-यं) Third. E. वि three, तथ aff.

विदण्ड n. (-ण्ड) 1. Three staves collectively. 2. Triple subjection of words, thoughts, and acts ; the state of a religious ascetic. E. वि three, दण्ड a staff, &c.

विदण्डधारण n. (-णं) Carrying three staves tied together, (as done by some mendicants.) E. विदण्ड, and धारण holding.

विदण्डिन् m. (-ण्डी) 1. A wandering devotee, one who carries three long bamboo staves in his right hand. 2. The religious man who has obtained a command over his words, thoughts, and actions, or mind, body, and speech. E. वि three, and दण्ड a punishment, a staff, &c. इनि aff.

विदला f. (-ला) A creeping plant, (Cissus pedata.) E. वि three, and दल a leaf.

विदश m. (-शः) A god, a deity, an immortal. E. वि the third, and दश state, being, (youth ; ) enjoying perpetual youth, or वि three, and दश state, subject as well as mortals to the three conditions, of birth, being, and destruction.

विदश mfn. (-शः-शा-श) Thirteenth. f. (-शी) The thirteenth day of the fortnight ; also त्रयोदश ।

विदशदीर्घिका f. (-का) The heavenly Ganges. E. विदश a deity, and दीर्घिका a long pool.

विदशन् mfn. plu. (-श) Thirteen. E. वि three, and दशन् ten.

विदशनदी f. (-दी) The heavenly Ganges. E. विदश, and नदी a river.

विदशपति m. (-तिः) INDRA. E. विदश, and पति chief.

विदशवधू f. (-धू) A nymph of INDRA's heaven. E. विदश, and वधू wife.

विदशवनिता f. (-ता) A nymph of INDRA's heaven. E. विदश, and वनिता a wife.

विदशाङ्गुश n. (-शं) The thunderbolt. E. विदश a deity, and अङ्गुश a goad.

विदशाचार्य m. (-र्यः) The preceptor of the gods, VRIHASPATI. E. विदश a deity, and आचार्य a teacher.

विदशायुध n. (-ध) The thunderbolt of INDRA. E. विदश a deity, and आयुध a weapon.

विदशारि m. (-रिः) An Asura or infernal being hostile to the gods, a Titan, a Giant. E. विदश a deity, and अरि a foe.

विदशल्य m. (-यः) 1. Swarga, INDRA's heaven or paradise. 2. The mountain Sumeru. E. विदश a deity, and आलय an abode.

विदशावास m. (-सः) Swarga, the heaven of INDRA. E. विदश a god, and आवास abode.

विदशाहार m. (-रः) Amrita or ambrosia. E. विदश a deity, and आहार food.

विदालिका f. (-का) A plant, commonly Charnaghosa.

विदिन n. (-न) Three days collectively. E. वि, and दिन a day.

विदिनस्युग् m. (-स्युक्) Conjunction or concurrence of three lunations with one solar day. E. विदिन, and स्युग् contact.

विदिव mn. (-वः-वः) 1. Swarga or paradise. 2. Sky, atmosphere, heaven. f. (-वा) The name of a river. E. वि the three, BRAMHA, VISHNU, and SIVA, दिव् to sport, affix क् ; the place where these three gods take divine pleasure.

विदिवेश m. (-शः) A god, a deity. E. विदिव heaven, and ईश master or lord.

विदिवीकस् m. (-काः) A god, a celestial. E. विदिव heaven, and वीकस् asylum.

विद्वग् mfn. (-द्वक्) Tri-ocular, three-eyed. m. (-द्वक्) A name of SIVA. E. वि three, and द्वग् an eye.

विदोष n. (-षं) Disorder of the three humours of the body, vitiation of the bile, blood, and phlegm. E. वि three, and दोष a fault.

विदोषघ्न mfn. (-घ्नः-घ्नी-घ्न) Correcting the vitiated state of the three humours. E. विदोष, and घ्न what destroys.

विदोषज m. (-जः) Disease, &c. proceeding from disorder of the three humours of the body. E. विदोष, and ज produced.

विधा ind. In three ways. E. वि, and धाच् aff.

विधातु m. (-तुः) A name of GANESA. n. (-त) Three minerals, &c. E. वि three, and धातु mineral, &c. चीन् धर्माधिकामान् दधाति पुण्याति धा-तुन् ।

विधामन् mfn. (-मा-मा-म) Having three residences, &c. m. (-मा) 1. A name of VISHNU. 2. An appellation of SIVA. 3. Agni or fire. 4. Death. E. वि three (worlds,) and धामन् abode.

विनयन mfn. (-नः-नी-नं) Three-eyed, tri-ocular. m. (-नः) A name of SIVA. E. वि three, and नयन an eye ; this deity is represented with a third eye in his forehead ; also similar compounds, as विद्वग्, विनेव, वत्रच्, &c.

विनेव mfn. (-वः-वा-व) Tri-ocular. m. (-वः) SIVA. E. वि, and नेव eye.

विनेवचूडामणि m. (-मिः) The moon. E. विनेव SIVA, चूडा a crest, and मणि a gem ; being worn by that deity as his crest.

विपक्ष n. (-क्षं) A period of six weeks. E. वि, and पक्ष a fortnight.

विषताक m. (-कः) 1. The forehead marked naturally with three horizontal lines. 2. The hand with three fingers erect. E. वि three or three-fold, and पताका a banner, a symbol.

विपत्र mfn. (-त्रः-त्रा-त्र) Three-leaved trefoil. m. (-त्रः) A bell tree, (Ægle marmelos.) E. वि, and पत्र leaf.

विपत्रक m. (-कः) The Kinsuka tree, (Butea frondosa.) E. वि three, and पत्र a leaf ; having three leaves on each stalk.

विपथ n. (-थं) 1. A place where three roads meet. 2. Three ways or paths. E. वि, and पथ a road.

विपथगा f. (-गा) The Ganges. E. विपथ three roads, and गा who goes, flowing through earth, heaven, and hell.

विपद् mfn. (-दः-दा-दी-दं) 1. Three-footed. 2. Having three lines or divisions, (a stanza.) 3. (In Arithmetic,) Trinomial. n. (-दं) 1. A tripod. f. (-दा) A verse of three lines, as the Gayatri. f. (-दी) 1. A creeper, (Cissus pedata.) 2. The girth of an elephant. E. वि three, and पद् a foot.

विपर्ण mfn. (-र्णः-र्णी-र्णे) Three leaved trefoil. f. (-र्णी) Wild cotton. E. वि three, and पर्ण a leaf.

वृषपाद् m. (-पाद्) 1. A name of VISHNU. 2. Fever, (personified.) E. वि three, and पाद् foot or part, three-footed, alluding to VISHNU's three steps which paced the universe ; and the demon of fever is described in the Puranas, with three feet, and three heads, alluding probably to its three stages of cold, hot, and sweating.

विपिव m. (-वः) A long-eared goat. E. वि, and पिव who drinks, touching water with both ears as he laps.

विपिष्ट n. (-षं) 1. Heaven, Swarga or paradise. 2. Sky, æther. E. पिष्ट a world, and वि three, or the third ; also विपिष्ट ।

विपिष्टसद् m. (-सद्) A deity. E. विपिष्ट heaven, and सद् who goes, from सद् with क्प् affix ; also विपिष्टसद् ।

विपुड m. (-डः) 1. Pulse, pease of three kinds. 2. A bank or shore. 3. A kind of vetch, (Cicer arietinum.) 4. A cubit. 5. A plant, (Ruellia longifolia.) f. (-टा-टी) A plant, (Convolvulus turpethum.) f. (-टा) Small cardamoms. 2. Arabian jasmine. 3. A goddess. E. वि three, and पुट skin or coat of a seed, &c.
