

धूमोष्णी f. (-णी) The wife of YAMA. E. धूम smoke, and ऊर्ण wool ; of a smoky hue, and woolly-headed, a Caffree, Prosopine.

धूमोष्णीपति m. (-तिः) YAMA, the ruler of the dead. E. धूमोष्णी as above, and पति husband.

धूम्या f. (-या) A quantity of smoke. E. धूम with य affix, implying aggregation.

धूम्याट m. (-टः) The fork-tailed shrike. E. धूम्या much smoke, and अट who goes. E. धूम्या इव अटति अट् अच् ।

धूम mfn. (-सः-सा-सं) Of a purple or smoky colour. m. (-सः) Purple, the colour ; a compound of red and black. n. (-सः) Sin, vice, wickedness. E. धूम smoke, रा to get, affix क, deriv. irr.

धूमक m. (-कः) A camel. E. धूम smoky, कन् affix ; of a smoky or tawny hue. धूम इव कायति कै-क ।

धूमलीचन m. (-नः) A pigeon. E. धूम dark, लीचन the eye.

धूमरश्च mfn. (-रश्च) Of a purple colour. E. धूम, and रश्च to shine, affix क्तिप्.

धूमवर्ण mfn. (-र्णः-र्णा-र्णं) Of a smoky hue. m. (-र्णः) Incense. f. (-र्णा) Flame, or one of the seven tongues of AGNI or fire. E. धूम smoky or purplish, and वर्ण colour.

धूमालि m. (-लिः) A pearl of a bad colour. E. धूम smoky, अलि an eye.

धूम्राट m. (-टः) The fork-tailed shrike. E. धूम smoky, and अट who goes.

धूमाम m. (-मः) Air, wind. E. धूम smoky, आम who shines.

धूमिका f. (-का) The Sisū tree. E. कन् added to धूम, fem. form.

धूममान mfn. (-नः-ना-नं) Agitated, shaken. E. धू to shake, pass. v. शानच् aff.

धूर (इ.) धूरी r. 4th cl. (धूयते) 1. To kill or hurt. 2. To move or approach. वधि गती च दिवा० आ० सक० सेट् ।

धूर्जटि m. (-टिः) A name of SIVA. E. धूर a burthen, and जटि a collection, from जट् to collect, and इन् affix ; who collects or bears the burthen of the three worlds.

धूर्त mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) 1. Fraudulent, crafty, dishonest, knavish ; &c. 2. Mischievous, injurious. m. (-तः) 1. A gamester. 2. A rogue, a cheat. 3. Thorn apple, (Dhutura.) n. (-तः) 1. Rust or iron filings. 2. Black salt. E. धूर्त् to injure, Una'di affix तन्, deriv. irr. धूर वा क्त ।

धूर्तक m. (-कः) 1. A jackal. 2. A cheat, a rogue, &c. E. धूर्त् crafty, कन् added. धूर्त् इव इवार्थे कन् ।

धूर्तकितव m. (-वः) A gamester. E. धूर्त्, and कितव a knave.

धूर्तकृत् mfn. (-कृत्) Dishonest, a knave, a rogue, a cheat. m. (-तः) Thorn apple : see धूर्त् E धूर्त् mischievous, and कृत् who acts.

धूर्तजन्तु m. (-न्तुः) Man. E. धूर्त् crafty, and जन्तु an animal ; the subtlest of all animals.

धूर्तता f. (-ता) Knavery, roguery, knavishness. E. धूर्त्, and तल् affix ; also with त्व, धूर्तत्.

धूर्तमण्डल m. (-लः) A party of rogues or gamblers. E. धूर्त् a cheat, and मण्डल a circle.

धूर्तमानुषा f. (-षा) A plant ; see राक्षा.

धूर्वर mfn. (-रः-रा-रं) 1. Bearing a load or burthen. 2. Managing affairs. m. (-रः) A beast of burthen. E. धूर a burthen, and धर bearing.

धूर्वह mfn. (-हः-हा-हं) Bearing a load, who or what does so. 2. Managing affairs. E. धूर, and वह what bears.

धूर्वी f. (-वी) The fore part or pole of a carriage. E. धूर्त् to injure, affix- es अच् and डीप् ।

धूलक n. (-कः) Poison.

धूलि mfn. (-लिः-लिः or -ली) 1. Dust. 2. A number. E. धू to agitate, affix लिक् वा डीप् ।

धूलिका f. (-का) Fog or mist. E. धूलि dust, कन् affix of resemblance ; the dust of the atmosphere. धूलिरिव कायति कै-क ।

धूलिकुट्टिम n. (-मः) A mound, a rampart. E. धूलि dust or earth, and कुट्टिम prepared ground.

धूलिकेदार m. (-रः) A mound, a rampart of earth. E. धूलि dust, and केदार a field.

धूलिगुच्छक m. (-कः) The red vegetable powder thrown about at the spring festival called the Ho'li. E. धूलि dust, and गुच्छक a nose-gay ; also धूलिगुच्छ m. (-च्छः)

धूलिध्वज m. (-जः) Air or wind. E. धूलि dust, and ध्वज sign or symbol.

धूलिकदम्ब m. (-म्बः) 1. A species of the Kadamba tree, (Nauclea cordi folia.) 2. Tila, a plant. 3. A tree : see वरुण (Tapia cratæva.) E. धूलि dust, and कदम्ब Kadamba, whose pollen perhaps resembles that of the Kadamba, or having a similar quantity of blossoms ; also with कन् added धूलिकदम्बक ; these words are also written with a short इ. as धूलिकदम्बक ।

धूलिपटल m. (-लः) A cloud of dust. E. धूलि, and पटल a heap.

धूय r. 10th cl. (धूयति ते) To make splendid or elegant ; also धूय, and धूस । चुरा० उभ० सक० सेट् ।

धूय r. 10th cl. (धूयति ते) to make splendid or elegant चुरा० उभ० सक० सेट् । also धूय and धूस ।

धूस r. 10th cl. (धूसयति ते) To embellish, to make splendid or elegant.

धूसर mfn. (-रः-री-रं) Grey, of that colour. m. (-रः) 1. Grey, (the colour,) 2. A jack ass. 3. An oilman. 4. A camel. 5. A pigeon. 6. Any thing of a grey tint. f. (-री) A female Kinnara or chorister of heaven. E. धू to agitate (the mind,) सर Unadi aff.

धूसरकदा f. (-दा) A plant commonly Swetara'sna. E. धूसर grey, and कदा a leaf, grey-leaved.

धूलूर m. (-रः) The thorn apple, (Dhutura metel and fastuosa.) E. धूस elegant, and तूर injurious : see धुतुर.

धृ (ङ) धृङ् r. 1st cl. (धरते) To fall. r. 6th cl. (ध्रियते) 1. To continue. to remain. 2. To have or hold, (ञ) धृञ् r. 1st cl. (धरति ते) To have or hold, to keep, to maintain. r. 1st cl. (धरति) To sprinkle. r. 10th cl. (धारयति ते) To hold. With अप or निर् prefixed, To verify, to make sure or certain. स्थितौ अक० धृतौ सक० उभ० भा० अनिट् । तुदा० आ० अनिट् । चुरा० उभ० सक० सेट् ।

धृज r. 1st cl. (धर्जति) also (इ) धृजि r. 1st cl. (धृजति) To go or move. भा० पर० सक० सेट् । इदित् च ।

धृत् mfn. (धृत्) Who has, holds, possesses, &c. E. धृ to have, क्तिप् aff.

धृत mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) 1. Possessed, held, contained. 2. Cherished, supported. 3. Stood, stayed, standing. 4. Alighted, gone down. 5. Placed. 6. Considered, weighed. E. धृ to hold, and क्त aff.

धृतकाक्षुकेषु mfn. (-षुः-ष्-षु) Armed with bow and arrow. E. धृत, काक्षुकेषु a bow, and इष् an arrow.

धृतपट mfn. (-टः-टा-टं) Covered or overspread with a cloth, &c. E. धृत, and पट a cloth.

धृतराष्ट्र m. (-ष्ट्रः) A proper name ; DHRTARA'SHTRA, the father of DU'RYODHANA, and uncle of the Pan'd'u princes. 2. A good king. 3. A Na'ga' or serpent of the lower regions. 4. A kind of bird, perhaps a short of goose: see धातराष्ट्र. f. (-री) A goose, the female bird only. E. धृत possessed, cherished, (by whom,) राष्ट्र a region.

धृतवत् mfn. (-वान्-वती-वत्) 1. Held, was holding, 2. Having taken or conveyed. धृ to hold, क्तवत् aff.

धृतहेति mfn. (-तिः-ति-ति) Armed. E. धृत, and हेति a weapon.

धृतात्मन् mfn. (-त्मा-त्मा-त्म) Firm, steady, calm, collected. E. धृत, and आत्मन् self.

धृताश्वस् mfn. (-श्वाः-श्वाः-श्वाः) Full of water. E. धृत, and अश्वस् water.

धृति m. (-तिः) Sacrifice, offering, religious rite or ceremony. f. (-तिः) 1. Holding, having. 2. Steadiness, firmness. 3. One of the astrological Yogas. see योग. 4. Pleasure. 5. Satisfaction, content. 6. Happiness. 7. A metre ; a stanza of four lines of eighteen syllables each. 8. The thirteenth Ma'trika' E. धृ to have &c. affix क्तिन्.
