

पतिला ind. Having fallen or fallen down, having alighted, &c. **पत्** to fall, **क्ता** aff.

पतिप्राणा f. (-या) A faithful wife. **पति**, and **प्राण** life.

पतिवरा f. (-रा) 1. A bride choosing her husband. 2. A pungent seed, (*Nigella Indica*.) **पति** a husband, **व** to choose, **खच्** aff.

पतिवती f. (-वती) A married woman, a wife whose husband is living. **पति** a husband, **सुतृप्** aff. fem. form irr., **वृक्** being inserted.

पतिव्रता f. (-ता) A good and virtuous wife. **पति** a husband, **व्रत** a religious obligation; who never violates her marriage vow.

पतिसेवा f. (-वा) Devotion to a husband. **पति**, and **सेवा** service.

पतीयन्ती f. (-न्ती) A woman wishing or fit for a husband. **पति**, and **यच्** added, aff. **इत्**.

पतिर mfn. (-र-रा-रं) Going, moving, one who goes or moves. **म**. (-रः) 1. A bird 2. An Arhaka, a measure so called. 3. A hole. **पत्** to go, **एरक्** Una'di aff.

पत्तापिन् mfn. (-पी-पिपी-पि) Pedestrian, going on foot. **म**. (-पी) A footman, a foot soldier, &c. **पत्** for **पाद** foot, **क्वच्** to injure, **पिनि** aff. पदादेशः ।

पत्तङ्ग n. (-ङ्ग) Red sanders : see **पत्रङ्ग**, of which it appears to be a local corruption. (**वकम्**) । [तनन् aff.]

पत्तन n. (-नं) 1. A town, a city. 2. A sort of drum. **पत्** to go, **पत्तनवणिज्** m. (-णिज्) A tradesman. **पत्तन** a city, **वणिज्** a trader.

पत्ति m. (-तिः) 1. A foot soldier. 2. A hero. f. (-ति) 1. Going, moving, walking. 2. A company, a platoon, consisting of one chariot, one elephant, three horse, and five foot. **पद्** to go, **नि** Una'di aff. or **तिन्** aff. for the feminine.

पत्तिपङ्क्ति f. (-ङ्क्ति) A line of infantry. **पत्ति**, and **पङ्क्ति** a line.

पत्तिसंहति f. (-तिः) A body of troops. **पत्ति**, and **संहति** assemblage.

पत्तूर m. (-रः) A plant, commonly *Salincha*. **न**. (-रः) Red sanders.

पत्त न. (-त्त) Any vehicle or means of conveyance. **पत्** to go, **इन्** aff. ; also **पत्र**.

पत्नी f. (-नी) A wife. **पति** a husband, **डीप्** aff. and **वृक्** augment.

पत्नीराट m. (-रः) The Harem, the private or women's apartments. **पत्नी** a wife, **राट** who goes, from **रच्**, with **वच्** affix, and **आङ्** prefix.

पत्र (त्र) n. (-त्रं) 1. A leaf. 2. A vehicle in general ; as a car, a horse, a camel, &c. 3. The wing of a bird. 4. The feather of an arrow. 5. The leaf of the *Laurus cassia*. 6. The leaf of a book. 7. Gold leaf, &c. any thin sheet or plate of metal. 8. A letter. 9. The blade of a weapon. 10. Painting the person as a decoration. 11. A knife, a dagger. 12. The leaf of a flower. **न**. (-त्रं-त्री) A letter, any written document or address. **पत्** to go, **इन्** aff. and one **त** rejected ; also sometimes **पत्र** ।

पत्रक n. (-कं) 1. A leaf. 2. The leaf of the *Laurus cassia*. 3. Staining the person with Sandal, &c. by way of decoration. **पत्र** with **कार्य**-क् added.

पत्रकाहला f. (-ला) The noise made either by the flapping of wings, or by the rustling of leaves. **पत्र** a leaf, a wing, &c. and **काहल** noise.

पत्रकच्छ n. (-च्छ) A sort of penance, drinking infusion of any leaves for a given time. **पत्र** a leaf, and **कच्छ** a penance.

पत्रगुप्त m. (-गुप्त) A species of *Euphorbia*, commonly *Teyka'nta* Sij. **पत्र** a leaf, and **गुप्त** hidden.

पत्रङ्ग n. (-ङ्गः) Red sanders, (*Pterocarpus santalinus*.) also **पत्राङ्ग**.

पत्रसंस्कार m. (-रः) The current of a river : other authorities have in place of this word, **पुरसंस्कार**, and **पत्रसंस्कार**, of which the last appears to be most accurate. **रायमटी** इत्ये च ।

पत्रश्या f. (-श्या) 1. Trimming the feathered butt of an arrow. 2. Painting figures on the body as a decoration. **पत्र** the feather of an arrow, **श्या** to get, aff. **ङ**.

पत्रगच्छुला f. (-ला) 1. A woman. 2. A kind of barley.

पत्रतक m. (-कः) The foetid *Mimosa*. दुष्खद्विरे ।

पत्रदारक m. (-कः) A saw. **पत्र** a leaf, &c. and **दृ** to tear, **खुल्** aff. (करात) ।

पत्रनाडिका f. (-का) The fibre or vein of a leaf. **पत्र** a leaf, **नाडी** a vessel, aff. **कन्**.

पत्रपरशु m. (-शुः) A small file used by silversmiths, &c. **पत्र** a sheet of metal, **परशु** an axe ; also with **पशु** the same, **पत्रपशु** m. (-शुः) (हिनी) ।

पत्रपाल m. (-ज) A large knife. f. (-जो) A pair of shears or scissors. **पत्र** a leaf, **पाल्** to nourish, aff. **वच्** (कांचि) ।

पत्रपाश्या f. (-श्या) An ornament of the forehead, a piece of goldleaf situated on the forehead, or a painted mark upon it. **पत्र** a leaf, **पशु** to bind, aff. **खत्**. (टीका) ।

पत्रपिशाचिका f. (-का) A sort of cap or cover for the head, made of leaves. **पत्र** a leaf, **पिशाचिका** an imp. (टीका) ।

पत्रपुष्प m. (-पुः) A plant, a red sort of Tulasi or Basil, (*Ocimum pilosum*.) f. (-या) Holy basil, (*Ocimum sanctum*.) **पत्र** a leaf, and **पुष्प** a flower.

पत्रपुष्पक m. (-कः) A kind of birch, from the bark of which Hukka snakes, &c. are made : see **भूर्जपत्र** **पत्र** a leaf, and **पुष्प** a flower, **कन्** added.

पत्रपुग m. (-गः) A shower of arrows. **पत्र**, and **पुग** a heap.

पत्रवन्ध m. (-न्धः) Adorning with leaves, flowers, &c. decorating with nosegays or garlands. **पत्र** a leaf, and **वन्ध** a binding.

पत्रबाल m. (-लः) An oar, especially a large one used as a rudder. **पत्र** a leaf, **बल्** to be strong, aff. **वच्**.

पत्रभङ्ग mf. (-ङ्गः-ङ्गी) Decorating the person by staining it with fragrant pigments of sandal, musk, &c. **पत्र** a leaf, **भङ्ग** to break, aff. **वच्**.

पत्रयौवन n. (-नं) A new leaf, a sprout. **पत्र** a leaf, **यौवन** youth.

पत्ररथ m. (-थः) A bird. **पत्र** a wing, and **रथ** a vehicle.

पत्ररञ्जन n. (-नं) Embellishing a page, illuminating, gilding, &c. **पत्र**, and **रञ्जन** colouring.

पत्रल n. (-लं) Thin or skim milk. **पत्र** to go, **रल्** aff. (पात्वा दृष्ट) ।

पत्रलेखिका f. (-का) Decoration of the face or person, by means of fragrant pigments, consisting of Sandal, saffron, musk, &c. **पत्र** a leaf, and **लेखा** a line.

पत्रवल्ली f. (-वल्ली) Staining the person with Sandal, &c. by way of ornament. **पत्र** a leaf, and **वल्ली** a creeper ; also **पत्रावल्ली**, **पत्रलेखा**, &c.

पत्रवाह m. (-हः) 1. An arrow. 2. A bird. 3. A postman, a letter carrier. **पत्र** a feather or a letter, and **वाह** bearing.

पत्रशि(सि)रा f. (-रा) The vein or fibre of a leaf. **पत्र** a leaf, and **शि(सि)रा** a tubular vessel.

पत्रशेख m. (-हः) The Bel tree.

पत्रसंस्कार m. (-रः) The current of a river. **पत्र** a leaf, **संस्कार** making perfect ; see **पत्रभङ्गार**.

पत्रसूचि m. (-चिः) A thorn. **पत्र** a leaf, and **सूचि** a needle.

पत्रहिम n. (-नं) Cold, wintry weather. **पत्र** here said to mean falling, **हिम** frost or snow.

पत्राख्या m. (-ख्याः) The pungent leaf of the *Laurus cassia*. **पत्र** a leaf, and **आख्या** a name ; the leaf, by way of distinction.

पत्राङ्ग n. (-ङ्गः) 1. Red sanders, (*Pterocarpus santalinus*) 2. Red or sappan wood, (*Casalpinia sappan*.) 3. *Bhurjapatra*, a tree so called, a kind of Birch. 4. Another plant : see **पत्रक**. **पत्र** a leaf, **आङ्ग** body or substance.

पत्राङ्गुलि f. (-लिः) Painting the forehead, throat, neck, &c. with coloured Sandal, saffron, or any other fragrant substance. **पत्र** a leaf and **आङ्गुलि** a finger, being applied with the finger.

पत्राङ्गन n. (-नं) Ink or blacking. **पत्र** a leaf, (of a book,) and **वच्** to tint, **करणे**-खुट् aff.

पत्राङ्ग n. (-ङ्गः) 1. The root of a long pepper. 2. A kind of grass.

पत्राली f. (-ली) Coloured or ornamental marks on the face or person. **पत्र**, and **आलि** a row.
