

पृथक्करय n. (-च) Separating, distinguishing, analysing. E. पृथक्, and करय making. [कृत made.]
 पृथक्कृत mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Separated, sundered, made distinct. E. पृथक्, and पृथक्केच m. plu. (-नाः) Children of one father by wives of different classes. E. पृथक् separately, and केच a wife.
 पृथक्कल n. (-लं) Individuality, separateness, severalty. E. ल added to पृथक्; also with कल, पृथक्कल।
 पृथक्कलिका f. (-का) A plant, commonly Mu'rva', (Sansevieria zeylanica.) E. पृथक् separately, लक् skin; having a fibrous bark from which bows-strings are made.
 पृथक्कपर्णी f. (-णी) A plant, (Hemionites cordifolia Rox.) E. पृथक् separate, पर्ण a leaf, aff. डीप्।
 पृथक्कपिण्ड m. (-ण्डः) A relation connected by ablation of water only. E. पृथक्, and पिण्ड obsequial cake.
 पृथक्कामता f. (-ता) Discrimination, judgment. E. पृथक् severally, कामन् real nature, तक् aff.; distinguishing the different nature of different things.
 पृथक्कामन् mfn. (-का-का-क) Several, separate, individual. m. (-का) Individualised spirit, or that of an individual, as detached from universal spirit, or the soul of all. E. पृथक्, and कामन् self or soul.
 पृथक्कामिका f. (-का) Individuality, separate or individual state of being. E. पृथक् separately, कामन् self, ठक् aff. [quality.]
 पृथक्गुण mfn. (-णः-णी-णं) Having distinct properties. E. पृथक्, and गुण पृथक्जन m. (-नः) 1. An ignorant man, a fool. 2. A man of a low cast. 3. A sinner, a wicked or vicious man. m. plu. (-नाः) Children of one father by different mothers. E. पृथक् separate, away from, (virtue &c.) and जन a man. [विध sort:]
 पृथक्विध mfn. (-धः-धा-धं) Various, diversified, multiform. E. पृथक् several, पृथ्वी f. (-वी) The earth: see पृथिवी।
 पृथा f. (-था) KUN'TI, the wife of PA'N'D'U. E. प्रथ to be famous, affs. थक् and टाप, the semi-vowel changed.
 पृथाज m. (-जः) 1. The son of KUN'TI, "ARJUNA," &c. 2. Name of a tree. E. पृथा, and ज born.
 पृथापति m. (-तिः) PA'N'D'U, the nominal father of the Pa'n'dava princes. E. पृथा KUNTI, and पति husband.
 पृथिका f. (-का) A centipede. E. पृथ् to throw, aff. कृन्, fem. form.
 पृथिवि f. (-विः) The earth: see the next.
 पृथिवी f. (-वी) The earth. E. प्रथ् to be famous, Una'di aff. [विन्, fem. aff. डीप्, and the vowel substituted for the semi-vowel; also with the anti-penultimate vowel changed to थ, पृथवी; or dropped altogether, पृथ्वी; or without the fem. aff. पृथिवि।
 पृथिवीचित् m. (-चित्) A king. E. पृथिवी, and चित् who rules.
 पृथिवीतल n. (-लं) The surface of the ground. E. पृथिवी, and तल surface.
 पृथिवीपति m. (-तिः) 1. A king, a sovereign. 2. A drug, commonly Rishabha. 3. YAMA, regent of the dead. E. पृथिवी the earth, and पति master.
 पृथिवीपाल m. (-लः) A king, a sovereign, a ruler. E. पृथिवी the earth, and पाल who nourishes.
 पृथिवीशक्र m. (-क्रः) A king. E. पृथिवी the earth, and शक्र INDRA.
 पृथु mfn. (-थुः-थुः-थुः-थुः) 1. Large, great. 2. Smart, clever. m. (-थुः) 1. The fifth monarch of the solar dynasty in the second age. 2. A name of Agni or fire. f. (-थुः) 1. A pungent seed, (Nigella Indica.) 2. A medicinal substance, commonly Hingupatri. 3. Opium. E. प्रथ् to be famous, aff. कृ, and र changed to थ।
 पृथुक mfn. (-कः-का-कं) The young of any animal. mn. (-कः-कं) Rice or grain flattened. f. (-का) Hingupatri: see पृथु. E. प्रथ् to be famous, aff. कृकन् or पृथु as above, and कन् added.
 पृथुरोमन् m. (-मन्) A fish in general. E. पृथु large, and रोमन् hair of the human body, to which the scales of the fish may be considered analogous.

पृथुल mfn. (-लः-ला-लं) Great, large. f. (-ला) A medicinal substance, "Hingupatri." E. पृथु, and लक् aff.
 पृथुशेखर m. (-रः) A mountain. E. पृथु large, and शेखर a crest.
 पृथुस्तम्ब m. (-म्बः) A boar. E. पृथु large, स्तम्ब shoulder.
 पृथुदर mfn. (-रः-रा-रं) Large-bellied, stout, corpulent. m. (-रः) A ram. E. पृथु, and दर the belly.
 पृथ्वी f. (-वी) 1. The earth. 2. A pungent seed. (Nigella Indica.) 3. A medical substance and condiment, perhaps the leaf of the asafoetida plant, "Hingupatri." 4. The mother of the seventh Jina, or Jaina deified teacher, SUPA'RSWA. 5. Cardamoms. 6. Name of a metre. E. The feminine form of पृथु, or पृथु the king so named, and डीप् aff.; the domain of king PRIT'HU.
 पृथ्वीका f. (-का) 1. Large cardamoms. 2. Small cardamoms. 3. A small pungent seed, (Nigella Indica.) E. पृथ्वी as above. कन् aff.
 पृथ्वीभर m. (-रः) A species of the Atyasti metre.
 पृथाकृ m. (-कृः) 1. A snake. 2. A scorpion. 3. A tiger. 4. A leopard or the small hunting leopard. 5. An elephant. 6. A tree. E. पृदं ते fart, Una'di aff. काकृ; the vowel substituted for the semi-vowel.
 पृथ्वि mfn. (-थ्विः-थ्विः-थ्विः) 1. Small, short, thin. 2. Delicate, feeble. f. (-थ्विः) 1. A ray of light. 2. A queen, the wife of SUTAPA', who being regenerated after death, became DEVAKI' the mother of KRISHN'A. 3. The earth. E. सृथ् to touch, नि Una'di aff., and the initial rejected; also पृथ्वि।
 पृथ्वि(वि)का f. (-का) An aquatic plant, (Pistia stratiotes.)
 पृथ्विगर्भ m. (-र्भः) A name of KRISHN'A. E. पृथ्वि the wife of a saint incarnate in DEVAKI', and गर्भ the embryo.
 पृथ्विधर m. (-रः) KRISHN'A.
 पृथ्विपर्णी f. (-णी) A plant, (Hemionites cordifolia,) according to some of its synonymes, but in ROXBURGH'S Catalogue, Hedysarum lagopodioides.) E. पृथ्वि small, पर्ण a leaf.
 पृथ्विभद्र m. (-द्रः) A name of KRISHN'A. E. पृथ्वि DEVAKI' and भद्र auspicious.
 पृथ्विशक्र m. (-क्रः) 1. A name of KRISHN'A or VISHN'U, in that incarnation. 2. A name of GANES'A. E. पृथ्वि small, and शक्र a crest.
 पृथ्वी f. (-वी) An aquatic plant, (Pistia stratiotes.) E. पृथ् to sprinkle, नि, aff. and डीप् added.
 पृथ् (थ) पृथु r. 1st. cl. (पथति) 1. To sprinkle. 2. To weary. 3. To hurt, to injure. 4. To Give. भा० चा० सक० सेट्।
 पृथत् mfn. (-थत्-थती-थत्) Sprinkling. n. sing. (-थत्) du. (-थती) plu. (-थन्ति) A drop of water or any liquid. mf. (-थन्-थती) The porcine deer. E. पृथ् to sprinkle, Una'di aff. थति, or participial aff. थट्; also पृथन् and पृथन्ति।
 पृथत् m. (-तः) 1. A drop of water. 2. The porcine deer. E. पृथ् to sprinkle, Una'di aff. थत्; see the last.
 पृथत्तापति m. (-तिः) Air, wind, or its deified personification. E. पृथत् a deer, in the second case plural, and पति master.
 पृथत्ताम m. (-मः) Air, wind. E. पृथत् the porcine deer, and थत् a horse: see पृथत्थ। [deer.]
 पृथत्क m. (-कः) An arrow E. पृथत् a deer, and कन् added; swift as a पृथत्थ m. (-थः) The god of air, or wind divinely personified. E. पृथत् the porcine deer, or a drop of rain, and थत् a horse; whose steeds are like deer, or may be considered as the drops of rain, accompanying a gale.
 पृथदाज्य n. (-ज्यः) Ghee mixed with curds, forming an oblation. E. पृथत् sprinkling, and ज्य Ghee.
 पृथद्वल m. (-लः) A horse of the wind. E. पृथत् a deer, वलक् aff.
 पृथन्ति n. (-न्ति) A drop of water. E. पृथ् to sprinkle, aff. कृक्; according to the best authorities, however, this word is the plural inflection of पृथत्।
 पृथभाषा f. (-षा) See पृथभाषा।
 पृथाकरा f. (-रा) A small stone used as a weight.
