भूतक्रान्ति f. (-न्ति) Possession by evil spirits. E. भूत a goblin, क्रान्ति going.

भूतगण m. (-णः) A class of spirits or goblins. E. भूत and गण a troop.

भूतगन्धा f. (-न्धा) Mura, a sort of perfume. E. भूत a goblin, and गन्ध a perfume; used perhaps in the ceremonies with which those beings are worshipped.

भूतग्राम m. (-ग्रामः) Any aggregate of elementary matter, the body, the world. E. भूत and ग्राम a heap.

भूतघ्न m. (-घ्नः) 1. A camel. 2. Garlic. f. (-घ्नी) 1. A plant, commonly Mundi'ri'. 2. Holy basil. E. भूत a spirit, and घ्न what destroys or removes.

भूतचतुर्दशी f. (-श्री) The fourteenth day of the second half of Kártic.

भूतजटा f. (-टा) Indian spikenard, (Valeriana jatámánsi.) E. भूत a goblin, and जटा clustered locks. [दया clemency.]

भूतदया f. (-या) Compassion or tenderness to all creatures. E. भूत and दया.

भूतधात्री f. (-त्री) The earth. E. भूत a living being, and धात्री a nurse.

भूतनाथ m. (-थः) S'IVA. E. भूत a spirit of element, and नाथ lord.

भूतनायिका f. (-का) DURGA'. E. भूत a spirit, and नायिका leader.

भूतनाशन m. (-शनः) 1. Marking-nut plant, (Semicarpus anacardium.) 2. mustard. n. (-न) The Elecarpus seed. E. भूत a goblin, and नाशन dispelling.

भूतपुष्प m. (-पुष्पः) A plant, (Bignonia Indica.) E. भूत a spirit, पुष्प a flower.

भूतपूर्णिमा f. (-मा) Day of full-moon in A'shwin. E. भूत a spirit, and पूर्णिमा full moon; the Bhu'tas being worshipped in this day.

भूतपूर्वम् Ind. Formerly.

भूतबलि f. (-बलिः) Throwing the remnants of an offering on the ground for animals and outcaste, &c. E. भूत and बलि an offering.

भूतभक्तृ mfn. (-र्ता-नी-र्तृ) Supporting the elements, living beings. E. भूत and भक्तृ who cherishes.

भूतभाव mfn. (-वः-वा-वं) Elementary. E. भूत and भाव a nature.

भूतधत् mfn. (-धत्) Supporting the elements, living beings. E. भूत and धत् sustaining. [ment.]

भूतमाक nf. (-क-चा) The rudiment of an element. E. भूत and माक ele-

भूतयज्ञ m. (-ज्ञः) 1. Offering viands, &c. to all created beings. 2. Worshipping evil spirits. E. भूत and यज्ञ sacrifice.

भूतल n. (-लः) The earth, the surface of the earth. E. भू and ल below.

भूतवत् mfn. (-वान्-वती-वत्) Being, been. E. भू to be, वत् aff.

भूतवास m. (-वासः) Beleric myrobalan, (Terminalia belerica.) E. भूत a goblin, and वास abode. [change.]

भूतविक्रिया f. (-या) Epilepsy, possession by evil spirits. E. भूत and विक्रिया

भूतविद्या n. (-द्या) Demonology.

भूतवृक्ष m. (-वृक्षः) 1. A tree, (Trophis aspera.) 2. A species of Bignonia, (B. Indica.) E. भूत a goblin and वृक्ष a tree.

भूतवेशी f. (-श्री) A species of the Niba'ri (Nyctanthes tristis,) with

भूतसञ्चार m. (-रः) Possession by evil spirits. f. (-रो) Fire in a forest. E. (-रिणी) 1

भूत a goblin, सम् with, चर् to go, aff. चञ्; also भूतसचारिन् f. white flowers. E. भूत a goblin, विष् to pervade, चण् and ङोप् affs.

भूतखन् m. (-खान्) 1. The body. 2. BRAHMA'. 3. A name of S'iva. 4. War, conflict. 5. The elementary or vital principle, or the proximate cause of life and action. E. भूत an element, खान् self or soul.

भूतादि m. (-दिः) God, the originator beings. E. भूत and आदि first.

भूतारि m. (-रिः) Asafœtida. E. भूत and अरि a foe. [सार्त्त' pained.]

भूतार्त्त mfn. (-र्त्तः-त्ता-र्त्त) Possessed by an evil spirit. E. भूत a spirit, अर्त्त what pains.

भूतवास m. (-वासः) The body. E. भूत and वास abode.

भूताविष्ट mfn. (-ष्टः-टा-ष्ट) Occupied or possessed by a devil. E. भूत a spirit, आविष्ट entered. [and आवेश entrance.]

भूतावेश m. (-शः) Possession by a devil or evil spirit. E. भूत a goblin, आवेश entered.

भूति f. (-तिः) 1. Power, dignity. 2. Superhuman power, as attributable to S'IVA especially, and attainable by the practice of austere and magical rites. 3. Prosperity, success. 4. Production, birth. 5. Ashes. 6. Fried meat. 7. The rut of elephants. 8. State of being, &c. 9. Wealth, riches, fortune. 10. Welfare. 11. Decoration of elephant, with coloured stripes. E. भू to be, aff. क्तिन् ।

भूतिक n. (-कः) 1. A sort of gentian, (G. Cherayta.) 2. A fragrant grass, (Andropogon schœnanthus.) 3. Another kind of grass. 4. A medicinal plant, commonly Katt'phal. 5. Ligusticum ajwaen. 6. Camphor. 7. Sandal-wood. E. भूत being or spirit, &c. aff. ठक्; also भूतीक ।

भूतिकाल m. (-कालः) A happy hour.

भूतिकौल m. (-कौलः) 1. A moat, a ditch. 2. A celler, a place under ground for concealing wealth, &c.

भूतिकृत्य n. (-कृत्यः) Any ceremony of a festive character, as a marriage, &c. E. भूति and कृत्य rite; also भूतिकर्त्त, &c.

भूतिगर्भ m. (-र्भः) BHAVABHU'TI, the dramatic poet. E. भूति superhuman power, and गर्भ embryo, being resuscitated by his contemporary, and rival KA'LIDA'SA, after having lost his life in an intrigue.

भूतिज्य mfn. (-ज्यः-ज्या-ज्य) A worshipper of spirits. E. भूत, ज्या worship.

भूतिनिधान n. (-निधानः) The twenty-fourth lunar mansion, D'hanisht'há. E. भूति prosperity, and निधान receptacle.

भूतीक n. (-कः) 1. A sort of gentian. 2. A kind of lovage, (Ligusticum ajwaen.) 3. A fragrant grass, (Andropogon schœnanthus.) 4. Another sort of grass. 5. Sandal wood. 6. Camphor. E. भूत being, aff. ईकक्. otherwise भूतिक ।

भूदण m. (-णः) A kind of fragrant grass, called "चिप्पगड्डि" by the Tailangeese.

भूदेश m. (-शः) S'IVA. E. भूत an imp, ईश lord. [affected.]

भूतोपहत mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Possessed by an evil spirit. E. भूत and उपहत

भूतम n. (-मः) Gold. E. भू earth, लक्ष्म best.

भूवा Ind. Having been or become. E. भू to be, वा aff.

भूदार m. (-रः) A hog. E. भू earth, हृ to tear, aff. चण् ।

भूदेव m. (-वः) A Bráhma E. भू the earth, and देव a divinity.

भूधन m. (-नः) A king. E. भू the earth, and धन wealth.

भूचर m. (-रः) 1. A mountain. 2. A kind of chemical or medicinal apparatus; a sand bath in which a covered crucible is placed, and the fire is lighted above as well as below it. 3. The number "seven." E. भू earth, चृ to support, aff. चण् ।

भूध्र m. (-ध्रः) A mountain. E. भू the earth, धृ to hold, aff. चण्, and the vowel changed to its analogous semi-vowel.
