Thirdly, Balara'ma, (the elder and half-brother of Krishn'a,) the son of Ba'sudb'va by Ro'hhni, born at the end of the Dwa'para or third age. 2. A name of Varun'a, regent of the waters. 3. A horse. 4. A sort of deer. f. (-#1) 1. A woman, a female, a pleasing or beautiful female. 2. Asafætida. 3. A river. 4. Vermilion. n. (-#7) 1. A potherb, (Chenopodium album.) 2. A sort of Costus, (C. speciosus.) E. TH to sport, aff. HS 1

रामकरी f. (-री) One of the Ra'gi'nis, or female personifications of the musical modes. E. राम delighting, करी who makes; also रामकली। रामकर्षर m. (-र:) A fragrant sort of grass. E. राम pleasant, and कर्ष्र (smelling like,) camphor.

रासलली f. (-ली) A Ra'gi'ni. E. राम pleasant, जला sound or note, कीय aff. रामगिरि m. (-रि:) The name of a mountain, variously applied, but especially assigned to a mountain called Compten or Chitraku't'a in Bundelkhund, and to another near Na'gpore, called now Ra'mter. E. राम the hero Ra'ma, and गिरि a mountain; being one of his halting places in his progress from Oudh to the Peninsula.

रामचन्द्र m. (-न्द्र:) The hero Ramachandra, the son of Dasaratha. E. राम and चन्द्र the moon, the moon-like Rama.

रामजननी m. (-नी) The mother of Balara'ma. E. राम् and जननी mother, hence it is equally applicable to Re'nuka', the mother of Paras'ura'ma, and to Kaus'alya, the mother of Ra'machandra.

रामद्र n. (-ठ') Asafœtida. E. रम् to please, श्रुद्ध Unádi aff., and the radical vowel lengthened. [बुझ aff.

रामणीयक min. (-क:-का-कं) Beautiful, pleasing. E. रमणीय the same, and रामदूत m. (-त:) The monkey Hanuma'na, the friend and messenger of Ram'a. f. (-ति:-ती) A shrub, apparently a variety of basil with small leaves. "नाग्दीना." E. राम Ra'ma, and दूत a messenger.

रामनवसी f. (-सी) The ninth day in the light-half of Chaitra, the anniversary of the birth of Ra'Machandra.

रामपूर्ग m. (-ग:) A small species of the areca or betel-nut tree, (Areca triandra, Rox.) E. रास RA'MA, पूर्ग areca. [auspicious.

रामभद्र m. (-द्र:) The hero Ra'machandra. E. राम the same, and भद्र रामनीया f. (-या) A sort of Vina or lute. E. राम Ra'ma and नीया a lute; it may be also ironically applicable to the horn blown by Bala-Ra'ma, and called still the Ra'masinha'.

रामगर m. (-र:) A variety of the Saccharum Sara, a sort of grass..

पानसञ्च m. (-ख:) The monkey-king Sugriva. E. रान् Ra'ma, and सख friend; Ra'ma having restored him to his throne, whence he had been driven by his elder brother Ba'm.

रामसेतु m. (-तु:) A bridge of sand, now a chain of islands, between the Indian Peninsula and Ceylon, popularly known by "Adam's bridge".

रामायण n. (-णं) 1. The first epic poem of the Hindus, written by the poet Va'lmiki, recording the adventures of Ra'ma, the son of Das'a Ratha, sovereign of Oudh. 2. A name of several poems on the life and adventures of Ra'ma. E. राम the prince, and भवन abode.

रामानुज m. (-ज:) Name of the founder of a Ve'da'ntic sect.

रामिल m. (-ल:) 1. Ka'ma or Cupid. 2. A lover, a husband. E. राम pleasing, agreeable, इलच् aff. [bamboo, aff. अज् । राम m. (-म:) The bamboo staff of a religious student. E. रमा a रायण n. (-ण) 1. Pain. 2. Sounding, crying. E. रे to sound, aff. छ ट । रायभाटी f. (-टी) The current or flow of a river. [v., ज्ञानच् aff. रारखमान mfn. (-न:-ना-नं) Crying aloud and repeatedly. E. रम to cry, reit. राज m. (-ल:) Resin, the resinous and fragrant exudation of the Shorea

robusta. "भुना". E. रा to give or get, aff. श्रलम्; also श्रराख। राव m. (-व:) Sound, noise. E. क् to cry or sound, aff. घत्र।

RA'MACHANDRA. n. (-vi) Noise, tumult. E. & to cry, (in the causal form,) aff. wz; afflicting mankind.

रावणारि m. (-रि:) The hero Ra'ma. E. रावण, ऋरि the foe. [mic aff. रावणि m. (-णि:) The eldest son of Ra'van'a. E. रावण, इझ patrony-राष्ट्र (न्ह्र) राष्ट्र r. 1st and 4th cl. (राष्ट्रते राष्ट्रते) To sound.

राश्चि m. (-शि:) 1. A heap, a quantity. 2. A sign of the zodiac. 3. Arithmetical or algebraic quantity. 4. A part and its divisor or numerator and denominator. 5. A congeries of number or quantity. E. अम् to pervade, इस् Una'di aff., and इट् initial augment; or रम् to sound, with the same aff.

राशिभोग m. (-ग:) Passage of a planet through a sign of the zodiac. E. राशि, भीग enjoyment. [augment.

राशीनस्य n. (-यं) Heaping, piling, gathering. E. राशि, नर्य making, च् राशीनत mfn. (-त:-ता-तं) Heaped, piled, &c. E. राशि, नत made, च् aug. राशीभूत mfn. (-त:-ता-तं) Heaped, piled. E. राशि, and भूत become, च् aug.

বাহু mn. (-ছু:-ছু') 1. An inhabited country or realm, a region. 2. Any public calamity, as plague, famine, &c. ছ. বাল্ to shine or govern, aff. হুন্।

राष्ट्रनिवासिन् m. (-सी) An inhabitant of any civilized country. E. राष्ट्र a district, निवासिन् a dweller.

राष्ट्रिक mfn. (-क:-की-क) Bolonging to or inhabiting a country. f. (-का) A prickly sort of night-shade, (Solanum jacquini.) "करकारी". E. राष्ट्र a country, and उन् aff.

राष्ट्रिय mfn. (-य:-या-यं) Of or belonging to a kingdom, produced or born in it, &c. E. राष्ट्र a region, च aff.

राष्ट्रीय mfn. (-य:-या-यं) Belonging or relating to a region or realm. m. (-य:) A king's brother-in-law, (in theatrical language.) E. राष्ट्र a region, क् aff.

रास_(ऋ) रास्ट r. 1st cl. (रासते) To sound, to cry.

रास m. (-स:) 1. Confused noise, uproar, hubbub. 2. Sound in general. 3. Speech, discourse. 4. A chain. 5. A festival amongst the cowherds, including songs and dances, especially the circular dance as performed by Krishn'a and the Go'pis or cowherdesses. 6. A game played by children. E. रास् to sound, यञ्ज aff.

रासन n. (-नं) A kind of minor drama in one act. [Una'di aff. रासभ m. (-नं:) An ass. f. (-भी) The she-ass. E. रास् to sound, अभन् रासभपूसर mfn. (-र:-रा-रं) Grey or light-brown, ass-grey. E. रासभ, भूसर grey. [aff. चिनि ।

रासभवन्दिनी f. (-नी) Arabian jasmine. E. रासभ an ass, वृद् to praise, रासयावा f. (-ना) A festival held in honour of Krishn'a on the full-moon of Ka'rtika. E. रास, and याता festival.

रासेरस m. (-स:) 1. An assembly, a company, a party. 2. A game or festival peculiar to the cowherds : see रास. 3. Love, desire, the passion or sentiment. 4. Alchemy : see रसिंदि. 5. The sixth night after delivery, on which the family and friends sit up all night.
6. Sport, mirth, pastime. 7. Any festival or holiday. E. रास noise, &c., and रस flavour, taste.

रासा f. (-सा) 1. A plant, (Mimosa octandra.) 2. Another plant, (the serpent ophioxylon.) 3. A sort of perfume. E. रस् to sound, नज् Unadi aff., and the vowel made long.

राहित n. (त्वं) The being without anything, distitution.

No. (-ज:) The ascending node; in mythology, the son of VIPRACHITTI by SINHIKA', a Daitya, with the tail of a dragon, whose head was severed from his body by VISHA'U, on the information of the sun and the moon who caught him in the act of drinking Amrita which was being served to gods, but being immortal by tasting it, his head and tail retained their separate existence, and being transferred
