

शक m. (-शः) 1. A name of S'IVA. 2. A weapon. 3. A cutter, a destroyer.
n. Adv. (-शं) or Ind. (शं or शन्) Happy, happily, auspiciously.
E. शो to sleep or शो to pare, &c., aff. ड ।

शंयु mf. (-युः-यु-यु) Happy, prosperous, fortunate. m. (-युः) A sort of snake. E. शम् happily, and युस् aff.

शंय mf. (-यः-य्या-य्य) Happy, fortunate. f. (-य्या) Knowledge, understanding. E. शम् happily, and यस् aff.

शंय mf. (-यः-य्या-य्य) Fortunate, prosperous. m. (-यः) 1. The thunderbolt of INDRA. 2. The iron head of a pestle. E. श good fortune, and य poss. aff.; also as differently derived, read शम्ब and सम्ब &c.

शंवर n. (-रः) Water. E. शं happily, व to choose or cover, aff. चच् or चरच्; more usually read शम्बर, q. व.

शंसु (उ) शंसु r. 1st cl. (शंसति) 1. To praise. 2. To hurt. 3. To wish. 4. To calumniate. 5. To suggest. 6. To report, to relate, (with a dat. or gen. of the person communicated to.) With चभि prefixed, To accuse wrongfully. With चाड्, 1. To hope. 2. To speak. 3. To wish. With प्र, To praise, to flatter; this root and its derivatives are sometimes read with the palatal sibilant final or शंश्, &c.

शंसन n. (-नः) 1. The act of reciting. 2. Praising.

शंसा f. (-सा) 1. Narrating. 2. Wish, desire. 3. Praise, flattery, eulogium. E. शंसु to praise, &c., affs. चड् and टाप्.

शंसित mf. (-तः-ता-ते) 1. Established, ascertained. 2. Calumniated, falsely accused. 3. Said, declared. 4. Praised, celebrated. 5. Wished, desired. E. शंसु to wish, aff. क्त । [compound.]

शंसिन् f. (-न्ति) 1. Saying, indicating. 2. Praising, (used at the end of a शंसु m. (-न्ति) An encomiast, a panegyrist, a flatterer. E. शंसु to praise, टन् Una'di aff.

शंस्य mf. (-यः-य्या-य्य) Happy, prosperous, well-faring. E. शं happily, य्या to stay or be, aff. क्त ।

शंस्य mf. (-यः-य्या-य्य) 1. Desirable, to be wished. 2. Meritorious, to be praised. E. शंसु to praise, &c., aff. यञ् or क्वप्; also शंस्य ।

शक् r. 4th cl. (शक्वति-ते) (इर लु) इरशक्नु r. 5th cl. (शक्वति) 1. To bear patiently, to endure, to be patient. 2. To be able to effect, to be competent. 3. To be powerful, (generally with an inf.) (इ) शक्ति r. 1st cl. (शक्ते) 1. To think probable, to suspect. 2. To fear, to apprehend. With चाड्, To dread.

शक m. (-कः) 1. A sovereign, and prince who gives his name to an era, especially applied to SA'LIVA'HAN'A. 2. A particular caste, the followers or descendants of S'AKA or SA'LIVA'HAN'A. 3. A country. m. plu. (-काः) 1. The inhabitants, the Saccæ, the Scythians. 2. An era: see शक. E. शक् to be able, aff. चच् ।

शकट mf. Subst. (-टः-टो-टं) A cart. m. (-टः) 1. A Daitya slain by KRISHN'A. 2. A cart-load. 3. A form of military array resembling a wedge. 4. A measure of capacity equal to two thousand Panas. E. शक् to be able, चटन् Una'di aff.

शकटविल m. (-लः) A gallinule.

शकटहन m. (-हन्) KRISHN'A. E. शकट the demon so named, and हन् destroyer; also similar compounds, as शकटारि &c.

शकटाल m. (-लः) The minister of NANDA; also read SAKATA'RA.

शकटाहा f. (-हा) The fourth lunar asterism, called Rohini', the stars of which are represented as a cart. E. शकट a cart, आह्वा appellation.

शकटिका f. (-का) A small cart, a toy-cart. E. कन् added to शकटो ।

शकन् n. (-का) Animal-dung; this word has no forms for the first five cases; according to some this is not a separate word but a substitute for शकत् ।

शकल mn. (-लः-लं) A part, a portion, a piece. n. (-लं) 1. Skin. 2. Bark. 3. A kind of (black) pigment or die. 4. The scales of a fish. E. शक् to be able, कलच् Una'di aff.

शकलित f. (-ता) Reduced to fragments.

शकलिन m. (-ली) A fish. E. शकल skin or scales, and इनि aff.

शकलीकरण n. (-णः) Parting, dividing, cutting or breaking in pieces. E. शकल, करण making, with च्च् aug. [made, च्च् aug.]

शकलीकृत mn. (-तः-ता-त) Parted, cut in pieces, wounded. E. शकल, कृत

शकव m. (-वः) A goose.

शकशकायत् mn. (-यन्-यन्-यत्) Rustling, making a noise, (as the leaves of a tree in the wind.) E. शकत् imitative sound, nominal v., शट् aff.

शकान्तक m. (-कः) 1. The prince VIKRAMA'DITYA. 2. The name of SA'LIVA'HAN'A. E. शक an era or a Scythian, अन्तक destroyer.

शकाब्द n. (-ब्दः) 1. A year of the Saka era, or era of SA'LIVA'HAN'A. E. शक, अब्द a year. [a king's concubine.]

शकार m. (-रः) 1. A silly brother-in-law of a Rájá. 2. The brother of शकारि m. (-रिः) VIKRAMA'DITYA, the celebrated sovereign of Oujein. E. शक a Saca or Scythian, अरि the foe.

शकुन m. (-नः) 1. A bird in general. 2. A kind of bird, either the Indian vulture or the common kite, (Falco cheela;) it is also applied to the pondicherry eagle, (Falco ponticeriana.) 3. A sort of hymn or song, sung at festivals to solicit or secure lucky events. n. (-नः) Any lucky or inauspicious object or omen. E. शक् to be able, उनन् Una'di aff.

शकुनज्ञा f. (-ज्ञा) A small house-lizard. E. शकुन a bird, and ज्ञा who knows.

शकुनज्ञान n. (-नः) Knowledge of omens.

शकुनि m. (-निः) 1. A bird. 2. The maternal uncle of the Kaurava princes, and counsellor or DURYODHAN'A. 3. One of the astronomical periods called Karan'as. 4. The Indian kite or eagle, (Falco cheela.) f. (-नी) A hen-sparrow. E. शक् to be able, उनि Una'di aff.

शकुनिप्रपा f. (-पा) A trough or little well for watering birds. E. शकुनि a bird, प्र before पा to drink, affs. चड् and टाप् ।

शकुनिवाद m. (-दः) 1. The sound of a bird. 2. The crowing of a cock.

शकुनिवर m. (-रः) A name of GARUDA. E. शकुनि a bird, and इवर chief.

शकुन्त m. (-न्तः) 1. A bird. 2. A kind of bird, the Indian vulture. 3. Another sort of bird, described as of aquatic habits, perhaps a kind of maritime or fishing-falcon. 4. A sort of insect. 5. The blue-jay. E. शक् to be able, उन्त Una'di aff.; also शकुन्त, &c.

शकुन्तक m. (-कः) A bird. f. (-न्तिका) 1. A kind of bird. 2. A locust. E. कन् added to the last.

शकुन्तला f. (-ला) The daughter of ME'NAKA', the courtesan of Swarga, by the sage VISHWA MIRA, brought up by KANWA the hermit, and afterwards married to DUSHYANTA, by whom she became the mother of BHARATA, the sovereign of all India. E. शकुन्त a bird, ला to get, affs. क and टाप्, being born in a solitary forest, and protected by the birds till found by KANWA. [above, चासज् the son.]

शकुन्तलाज m. (-जः) BHARATA, the sovereign of India. E. शकुन्तला as शकुन्ति m. (-न्ति) 1. A bird in general. 2. A kind of bird; see शकुन्त, &c. E. शक् to be able, Una'di aff. उन्ति । [rison.]

शकुन्तिका f. (-का) A locust, a cricket. E. शकुन्त a bird, कन् aff. of compa-

शकुल mf. (-लः-लो) A kind of fish. "शाल". E. शक् to be able, aff. उलच् ।

शकुलगण्ड m. (-ण्डः) A kind of fish. "शालमाह ।"

शकुलाचक m. (-कः) Bent grass, (Panicum dactylon,) with white blossoms. E. शकुल a kind of fish, अक्षि the eye, अच् substituted for the final vowel; the blossoms being compared to the eye of a fish.

शकुलादनी f. (-नी) 1. A medicinal plant, commonly Kat'uki, (Wrightea antidysenterica) 2. A creeping plant, (Jussieua repens.) 3. A drug, commonly Ka'yap'hal. 4. An earth-worm. E. शकुल a fish, अद् to eat, aff. छुट् ।

शकुलार्धक m. (-कः) A sort of fish. "गडुर माह ।" E. शकुल a fish, अर्धक a young one. [aff. चटन् ।

शकुत् n. (-कत्) Faeces, excrement. E. शक् to be able, (to expel,) Una'di

शकुत्कारि mf. (-रिः-री) A calf. E. शकुत् ordure, क्त to make, इन् aff.

शकुत्कार mf. (-रः-री-र) Making ordure or faeces. E. शकुत् ordure, and कार who or what makes.
