

शङ्खनीय mfn. (-यः-या-यं) Doubtful, questionable, to be doubted or apprehended. E. शङ्खि to fear or doubt, अनीयर् aff.; also शङ्खित्य, and शङ्खा।

शङ्कर mfn. (-रः-रा-रं) Auspicious, propitious, conferring happiness or good fortune. m. (-रः) 1. S'IVA. 2. The name of a celebrated teacher of the Vēda'nta philosophy. f. (-री) 1. PA'RVATI, the wife of S'IVA. 2. The S'amī-tree. 3. Bengal madder. E. शं good fortune, कर making. [beloved.]

शङ्करप्रिय m. (-यः) The francoline partridge. E. शङ्कर S'IVA, प्रिय dear, शङ्करावास m. (-सः) 1. KAILA'SA, the abode of S'IVA. 2. A kind of camphor.

शङ्खान्वित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) Apprehensive, doubtful, afraid. E. शङ्खा, अन्वित possessed of. [charge.]

शङ्खान्निवाग m. (-गः) Accusation or charge on suspicion. E. शङ्खा, अन्वियोग

शङ्खानय mfn. (-यः-यो-य) Fearful, afraid. E. शङ्खा and नयट् aff.

शङ्खान्मद n. (-दं) Cause or matter of doubt or apprehension. E. शङ्खा and आन्मद site. [and हीन free from.]

शङ्खहीन mfn. (-नः-ना-नं) Free from doubt or apprehension. E. शङ्खा,

शङ्खित mfn. (-तः-ता-तं) 1. Alarmed, frightened. 2. Weak, unsteady. 3. Doubtful, uncertain. E. शङ्खा fear, इतच् aff.

शङ्खितवयश्च m. (-कः) A thief. E. शङ्खित frightened, वयं a caste, कन् aff.

शङ्खु n. (-ङ्कुः) 1. The trunk of a lopped tree. 2. A javelin, a spear. 3. A pin, a stake, a pale. 4. The gnomon of a dial, usually twelve fingers long. 5. A long thin column in front of a pagoda. 6. शङ्खर mfn. (-रः-रा-रं) Formidable, fearful, frightful. E. शङ्खु fear, रा to give or cause, aff. ड । [pieces.]

शङ्खला f. (-ला) A pair of nippers, used to cut the betel-nut into small

शङ्खवृक्ष m. (-वृक्षः) The S'al tree. E. शङ्खु a pin or stake, and वृक्ष a tree.

शङ्खोच m. (-चः) A scate fish. E. शङ्खि-उच्; also शङ्खु, शङ्खुचि and शङ्खोचि ।

शङ्ख्य mfn. (-ङ्ख्यः-ङ्ख्या-ङ्ख्यं) To be feared or doubted. E. शङ्खि to fear, यत् aff.

शङ्ख्य mn. (-ङ्ख्यः-ङ्ख्यः) The conch-shell used by the Hindus, in two ways especially; offering libations with it, or when perforated at one end blowing it as a horn at sacrifices; frequent mention of it occurs in the battle pieces of the poets, each hero being provided with a conch as his horn. m. (-ङ्ख्यः) 1. One of KURVA's treasures. 2. The temple or temporal bone, sometimes comprising the frontal bone also. 3. A perfume, commonly Nak'hi, apparently a dried shell-fish. 4. A military drum. 5. One of the eight chiefs of the Na'gas or serpents of Pāta'la described as of a yellow colour. 6. An elephant's cheek. 7. A large number, "a hundred billions." 8. शङ्खचर्चौ f. (-चौ) Sandal marks made across the forehead. E. शङ्ख the forehead, चर्च् to anoint, affs. चच् and डीष् ।

शङ्खज m. (-जः) A large pearl, of the shape of a pigeon's egg. E. शङ्ख a shell, and ज born.

शङ्खस्र m. (-स्रः) A shell-blower. E. शङ्ख a conch, and स्र who blows.

शङ्खनख m. (-खः) 1. A small shell. 2. A perfume, commonly नखो. E. शङ्ख a conch, नख the nail. [conch, &c., पाल who nourishes.]

शङ्खपाल m. (-लः) 1. The sun. 2. A Nāga or serpent of Pāta'la. E. शङ्ख a

शङ्खपुष्पी f. (-ष्पी) A sort of grass, (Andropogon aciculatum.) E. शङ्ख conch, पुष्प a flower, डीष् aff., implying resemblance.

शङ्खप्रस्य m. (-स्यः) Spots in the moon. E. शङ्ख a shell, and प्रस्य pre-eminent.

शङ्खभृत् mfn. (-भृत्) Having a conch or shell. m. (-भृत्) VISHN'U. E. शङ्ख a conch, and भृन् who possesses.

शङ्खमुख m. (-खः) An alligator. E. शङ्ख a conch, and मुख face.

शङ्खिका f. (-का) A kind of grass, (Andropogon aciculatum.) E. शङ्ख a shell, कन् or उन् implying resemblance, fem. form. "चीरकाचका ।"

शङ्खिन् mfn. (-ङ्खि-ङ्खिनी-ङ्खि) Possessing or having a conch or shell, &c. m. (-ङ्खो) 1. VISHN'U. 2. The ocean. 3. A shell-blower. 4. A worker in shells. f. (-ङ्खी) 1. A sort of grass, (Andropogon aciculatum.) 2. A plant, (Cissampelos hexandra.) 3. A description of woman, one of the four classes into which females are divided in erotic writings; the S'ank'hini' is described as tall, with long hair, neither stout nor thin, of irascible disposition and strong passions. 4. शङ्खोपति m. (-पतिः) INDRA. E. शङ्खो the wife of the deity, पति husband.
