

शिखादृक् m. (-क्ष) The stand of a lamp. E. शिखा a flame, and दृक् a tree.
शिखावृति f. (-विः) Usurious interest payable daily. E. शिखा a tuft of hair, and वृति interest ; growing constantly.

शिखिकरुद n. (-रुदः) Blue vitriol.

शिखिग्रीष n. (-ं) Blue vitriol. E. शिखि for शिखिन् a peacock, ग्रीष the neck, अं �added ; being of the same colour.

शिखिभज m. (-जः) 1. Smoke. 2. The deity KA'RTIKE'YA. E. शिखि a peacock or fire, and भज an emblem.

शिखिन् mfn. (-खी-खिनी-खि) 1. Crested. 2. Having a lock of hair on the top of the head. 3. Proud. m. (-खी) 1. Fire. 2. A peacock. 3. A bull. 4. An arrow. 5. A tree. 6. A cock. 7. KETU, the personified descending node. 8. A horse. 9. A mountain. 10. A Brahmaṇ. 11. A lamp. 12. A religious mendicant. E. शिखा a crest, &c., दूनि aff.

शिखिपृच्छ n. (-क्ष) A peacock's tail. E. शिखि a peacock, and पृच्छ a tail.

शिखिमधुल m. (-लः) A tree, (Tapia cratæva.) E. शिखि a peacock, and मधुल district.

शिखियुप m. (-पः) An antelope. [increasing.]

शिखिवर्द्धक m. (-कः) A pumpkin-gourd. E. शिखि a peacock, and वर्द्धक a crest, &c.

शिखिशिखा f. (-खा) 1. Flame. 2. A peacock's crest. E. शिखिन्, and शिखा।

शिखिशेखर n. (-र) A peacock's crest. E. शिखिन्, and शेखर a crest.

शिघ्र m. (-यः) 1. A tree, (Morunga guilandina and hyperanthera.) 2.

A pot-herb in general. E. शि to sharpen, रक् aff., and गुक् augment.

शिघ्रुज n. (-जः) The seed of the Morunga. E. शिघ्रु, ज produced.

शिघ्रमूल n. (-लः) The pungent root of the Morunga. E. शिघ्रु, मूल the root.

शिघ्रवौज n. (-जः) The seed of the Morunga. E. शिघ्रु, and वौज seed.

शिघ्र् (इ) शिखि r. 1st cl. (शिङ्गति) To smell.

शिङ्गाण n. (-णः) 1. Any glass-vessel. 2. The mucus of the nose. 3. Rust

of iron. m. (-णः) 1. Phlegm. 2. Froth, foam. E. शिखि to smell, आण्ड Unádi aff., and the final optionally rejected ; also शिङ्गाणक

and सिङ्गाणक ! [to smell, aff. आण्ड ।]

शिङ्गाणक m. (-कः) Phlegm. mn. (-कः-कः) The mucus of the nose. E. शिखि

शिङ्गित mfn. (-तः-ता-तः) Smelled. E. शिखि to smell, aff. क्ति।

शिर्ष f. (-श्रिक्) The string of a pole for carrying burdens. E. श्रस् to fall,

deriv. irr.: see शिर्ष !

शिर्जन् (इ) शिर्जन् r. 2nd cl. (शिर्जन्ते) r. 10th cl. (शिर्जयति ते) 1. To make an inarticulate sound. 2. To tinkle, to jingle.

शिर्जन् mf. (-ज्ञः-ज्ञा) The tinkling sound of silver and other metallic ornaments worn round the waist, arm, or ankle, &c. f. (-ज्ञा) 1. A bow-

string. 2. Jingle of ornaments. E. शिर्जन् to make an inarticulate sound, affs. अङ्ग् and टाप् : also शिर्जनी, &c.

शिर्जन्जिका f. (-का) A chain worn round the loins.

शिर्जित n. (-तः) The tinkling of metallic ornaments worn as rings, chains, &c. E. शिर्जन् inarticulate sound, इत्तच् aff.

शिर्जन्न mfn. (-ज्ञौ-ज्ञिनी-ज्ञि) Tinkling, making a tinkling. f. (-ज्ञिनी) 1. A bow-string. 2. Metallic rings worn round the toes, an ornament of the feet. E. शिर्जन् a tinkling, and इनि aff.

शिर्ट r 1st cl. (शेटति) To disregard, to treat with disrespect.

शिर्त mfn. (-तः-ता-तः) 1. Thin, emaciated, wasted, declined. 2. Weak, feeble. 3. Sharpened, whetted. E. शि to sharpen, or शो to pare or whet, aff. क्ति !

शिरता f. (-ता) Sharpness. E. तल् added to the last ; also with ल, शिरत्ल' !

शिरद्रु f. (-द्रुः) The S'atadru or the river Sutlej. E. शिरत weakened, द्रु to flow, aff. क्ति : see शतद्रु !

शिरधार mfn. (-रः-रा-रं) Sharp-edged. E. शिरत, and धारा an edge.

शिरशक m. (-कः) 1. Barley. 2. Wheat. E. शिरत sharpened, शूक् the beard.

शिराय mfn. (-यः-या-य') Sharp-pointed. m. (-यः) A thorn. E. शिरत, अय point.

शिरास्मृत m. (-मृत) Armed with sharp weapons. E. शिरत, अस्त्र a weapon,

[मृत] शिति infn. (-ति:-ती-ति) 1. Black. 2. White. m. (-ति:) The Bhurja-patra or birch tree. E. शि to sharpen, क्ति् or क्तिच् aff. ; or भृत् to go, Unádi aff. इन्, and इ substituted for the radical vowel.

शितिकरुद m. (-रुदः) 1. S'IVA. 2. A gallinule. 3. A peacock. E. शिति black, and करुद the throat.

शितिचार m. (-रः) A potherb, (apparently Marsilea dentata, Rox.)

शितिच्छद m. (-दः) A goose. E. शिति white, क्षद a feather ; also सितच्छद ।

शितिपत्र m. (-पत्रः) A goose. E. शिति white, पत्र a wing ; also सितपत्र ।

शितिरब n. (-बः) A sapphire. E. शिति, and रब a gem.

शितिसारक m. (-कः) A sort of ebony, (Diospyros glutinosa.) E. शिति black, and सार essence, resin, क्तप् added ; yielding a strong black resin that is used for calking boats, &c.

शितेषु m. (-षुः) A sharp arrow. E. शिति, and षुष् an arrow.

शिथिल mfn. (-लः-ला-लं) 1. Loose, lax, flaccid, flabby. 2. Languid, inert, feeble. 3. Ineffective, unenergetic. 4. Relaxed, slackened. 5. Not rigidly observed. 6. Loosely retained or possessed. 7. Abandoned, got rid of, shaken off. E. स्थृ to be lax or loose, Una'di aff. क्तिलच्; the form irr.

शिथिलता f. (-ता) Relaxation, looseness, being unfastened, &c. E. शिथिल, and तल् aff.; also with ल, शिथिलत्ल' !

शिथिलबल mfn. (-लः-ला-लं) Weakened, relaxed. E. शिथिल, बल strength.

शिथिलवसु mfn. (-सुः-सुः-सु) 1. Reduced in wealth. 2. Shining with diminished rays. E. शिथिल, and वसु wealth, &c. [शक्ति power.

शिथिलशक्ति mfn. (-क्ति:-क्ति:-क्ति) Impaired in strength or power. E. शिथिल, शिथिलता mfn. (-तः-ता-तः) 1. Let go, loosened, released. 2. Relaxed, loosened. E. शिथिल, and इत्तच् aff.

शिथिलीकरण n. (-णः) 1. Loosening, unfastening. 2. Impairing, weakening, reducing. E. शिथिल, and करण doing, चुि augment.

शिथिलीकृत mfn. (-तः-ता-तः) 1. Unbound, unfastened, slackened. 2. Reduced, impaired, weakened. 3. Let loose. E. शिथिल, कृत made, चुि aug.

शिनि m. (-निः) A proper name, a chief of the Kshetriya tribe. E. शि to make thin or small, Unádi aff. निक्।

शिनैर्नम् m. (-मा) A name of SATYAKI, one of the chiefs of the Pán'-dus. E. शिनि a proper name, and नम् grandson.

शिपविष m. (-षः) Bald, &c. : see शिपविष !

शिपि m. (-पिः) A ray of light. f. (-पिः) Skin, leather. n. (पिपि) Water.

शिपविष m. (-षः) 1. A bald man. 2. A man naturally void of prepuce. 3. S'IVA. 4. VISHNU. 5. A leper. E. शिपि a ray of light, and विष entered ; also शिपविष and शिपविष !

शिप्र m. (-प्रः) Name of a lake on the Himalaya. f. (-प्रि) Name of a river which flows by Ujjayini. E. शि-रक् पुक् च।

शिफा f. (-फा) 1. A fibrous root. 2. Spikenard, (Valeriana jatamansi.) 3. A river. 4. A mother. 5. Turmeric. 6. The root of a water-lily.

7. A lash with a whip. E. शो to sleep, फक् aff., and the form irr.

शिफाकन्द mn. (-न्दः-न्दः) The root of a water-lily. E. शिफा a fibrous root, कन्द a root ; also शिफाक !

शिफाधर m. (-रः) A branch. E. शिफा a fibrous root, धर what has. [grows.

शिफारुह m. (-रुहः) The Indian-fig tree. E. शिफा a fibrous root, रुह what

शिफ्ल m. (-फः) A sort of large shrub, (Cassia alata.) f. (-फा) A legume, a pod ; E. शम् बा० उम्बच् : also सिफ्ल and शिफ्ल !

शिफ्लि f. (-फः-स्त्री) 1. A legume, a pod. 2. A kind of grass. E. शम्-वि-नि० वा० डीप् ; also शिफ्ला, and सिफ्ला !

शिफ्लिक m. (-कः) A sort of kidney-bean, (Phaseolus max.) f. (-का) 1. A legume, a pod. 2. A kind of kidney-bean. E. कन् added to the last ; also शिफ्ला, &c.

शिफ्लिपर्णी f. (-पर्णी) A sort of bean, (Phaseolus trilobus.) E. शिफ्ल a pod, and पर्ण leaf, aff. डीप् ; also with कन् added, fem. form शिफ्लिपर्णिका !

शिफ्र n. (-रः) 1. The head. 2. The root of the pepper plant. f. (-रा) Any vessel of the body, really or supposed to be, of a tubular form, as
