शीतक m. (-कः) 1. Cold weather or the cold season, winter. 2. A lazy man, one who is dilatory or dull. 3. One devoid of care or anxiety, a happy man. 4. A plant, (*Marsilea dentata*.) 5. A scorpion. E. कन् added to the preceding.

शीतकाल n. (-लः) Cold weather, winter. E. शैत, and काल time.

शीतकालीन mfn. (-नः-ना-न) Produced in winter. E. शैतकाल, and न् aff.

शीतकृष्ण m. (-कृष्णः) A religious penance, drinking cold water three days, cold milk three days, cold Ghee three days, and fasting three. E. शैत cold, and कृष्ण penance.

शीतकूम m. (-कूमः) A flower, (*Nerium odoratum*.) f. (-कूमा) An aquatic plant. E. शैत cold, कुम a water-pot.

शीतचार n. (-चारः) Refined Borax. E. शैत cold, चार nitre. “वैतटज्जये !”

शीतगंध n. (-गंधः) White Sandal. E. शैत cold, and गंध smell.

शीतगृह m. (-गृहः) 1. The moon. 2. Camphor. E. शैत cold, and गृह neut. form of गृह a ray of light, here forming a masc. compound.

शीतचम्पक m. (-कः) 1. A lamp. 2. Pleasing, satisfying. 3. A mirror. E. शैत cold, cool, and चम्पक a flower.

शीतता f. (-ता) Cold, coldness. E. शैत, and ता aff. ; also with ल, शैतलं ।

शीतदीपिति m. (-तिः) The moon.

शीतपत्ताँ f. (-पत्ताँः) A plant, (*Cleome pentaphylla*.) E. शैत cool, पत्ता a leaf.

शीतपञ्चव m. (-ञ्चवः) A plant, (*Ardisea solanacea*.) E. शैत cool, पञ्चव a shoot.

शीतपाकिनी f. (-नी) A medicinal root, commonly Kákoli. E. शैत the cold, (in a cold climate,) पाक ripening, and इन aff.

शीतपाकी f. (-की) 1. A medicinal root, commonly Kákoli. 2. A plant, (*Sida cordifolia*.) E. शैत cold, (in cold weather, &c.) पाक a ripening, छैप् fem. aff.

शीतपुष्प m. (-पुष्पः) The Sirisha tree. n. (-पुष्पः) A fragrant grass, (*Cyperus rotundus*.) E. शैत cold, (in the cold weather, &c.) and पुष्प a flower.

शीतपुष्पक n. (-कः) Storax or Benzoin. E. शैत cold, (in the snowy mountains,) पुष्प a flower, कन् aff.

शीतप्रभ m. (-भः) Camphor. E. शैत cool, and प्रभ shining.

शीतभानु m. (-नुः) The moon. E. शैत cool, भानु the sun. [भीर afraid.

शीतभौम f. (-भः) Arabian jasmine, (*Jasminum zambac*.) E. शैत the cold,

शीतभोजिन् mfn. (-जी-जिनी-जि) Eating cold viands. E. शैत, सूज् to eat, खिनि aff. [of light.

शीतमयूख m. (-खः) 1. The moon. 2. Camphor. E. शैत cool, मयूख a ray

शीतमराचि m. (-चिः) The moon. E. शैत cool, मरैचि a ray. [मूलक a root.

शीतमूलक n. (-कः) The root of the Andropogon muricatum. E. शैत cool,

शीतरस m. (-सः) A lamp. E. शैत cool, and रस agreeable.

शीतलाम् mfn. (-लः-ला-सं) Cold, chilly, frigid. n. (-लः) 1. Green vitriol. 2.

शीतलघण्ठी f. (-घण्ठः) The sixth of the light-half of Ma'gha, when only cold food is eaten. E. शैतल, and घण्ठ sixth.

शीतगिर n. (-नः) 1. A sort of resin, (*Storax benzoin*.) 2. Rock salt. m. (-वः) 1. A kind of fennel, (*Anethum sowa*.) 2. The S'ami-tree, (*Mimosa suma*, Rox.) E. शैत cool, and विव auspicious.

शीतगृक m. (-कः) Barley. E. शैत cold, and गृक an awn or beard.

शीतसह mfn. (-हः-हा-हः) Bearing or enduring cold. m. (-हः) A Pilu, or tree so named, growing in the Hima'laya mountains. E. शैत cold, and सह enduring.

शीतहर mfn. (-रः-रा-र) Removing cold. E. शैत, and हर what takes.

शीतांशु m. (-शुः) 1. Camphor. 2. The moon. E. शैत cold, अंशु a ray.

शीताङ्गु mfn. (-ङ्गः-ङ्गा-ङ्ग) Benumbed, frozen. E. शैत, आङ्गु perplexed.

शीताद m. (-दः) Scorbutic affection of the gums. E. शैत, अद what eats.

शीताद्वि m. (-द्विः) The snowy mountain. E. शैत cold, अद्वि a mountain.

शीतार्द mfn. (-र्दः-र्दा-र्द) Cold, chilled, shivering, suffering or shrinking from cold. E. शैत cold, and आर्द pained.

शीतालु mfn. (-लुः-लुः-लु) Cold, shivering, shrinking from cold. E. शैत cold, आलु उ aff., here implying aversion or impatience.

शीतामूल m. (-मूलः) The moon-gem, crystal. E. शैत cold, अमूल a stone.

शीतीभाव m. (-वः) 1. Final emancipation. 2. Coolness, composure. 3. Cold, coldness. E. शैत cold, भाव nature, चु उ augment.

शीतीतम n. (-तः) Water. E. शैत cold, उत्तम best.

शीत्य mfn. (-त्यः-त्या-त्य) 1. Ploughed, tilled: more usually सौत्य. 2. To be cooled or chilled. E. शैत cold, or शैता a furrow, यत् aff.

शीत्यार m. (-त्यः) Uttering a sound expressive of pleasurable sensations. E. शैत उtative sound, and कार making : also with कृत made, uttered, शैतकृत n. (-तेः) [Una'di aff. उक् ।

शीघ्र mn. (-घुः-घु) Rum, distilled from molasses. E. शैत to sleep, or rest,

शीघ्रगंध m. (-घः) A plant, (*Mimusops elengi*.) E. शैघ्र Rum, गंध smell.

शीघ्रप m. (-घः-घी) A drinker of spirits, a dram-drinker. E. शैघ्र spirits, and घी to drink, aff. टक् ।

शीन mfn. (-नः-ना-न) Thick, congealed, (as oil or butter.) m. (-नः) 1. A fool, a blockhead. 2. A large snake. E. शै उ to go, aff. क् ।

शीफालिका f. (-का) A flower, (*Nyctanthes tristis*) : see शैफालिका ।

शीभ् (च) शैभ् r. 10th cl. (शैभते) 1. To flatter. 2. To boast. 3. To say.

शीभव m. (-वः) Thin rain.

शीभ m. (-भः) 1. S'IVA. 2. A bull. E. शैभ to praise, यत् aff.

शीयमान mfn. (-नः-ना-न) Going away, dissipating, dispersing, departing. E. शैद to go, शान्त् aff. ; शैय substituted for the radical letters.

शीर m. (-रः) A large snake, (*Boa constrictor*.) 2. A plough. E. शै to sleep, रक् Unádi aff.

शीर्ष mfn. (-र्षः-र्षः-र्ष) 1. Thin, small, slender. 2. Wasted, withered, decayed. E. शै to injure, aff. क्, form irr. [त्, शीर्षत्.

शीर्षता f. (-ता) Emaciation, withering. E. शैर्ष, and तल् aff. ; also with शीर्षनाला f. (-ला) A plant, (*Hemionites cordifolia*.) E. शैर्ष shrivelled or slender, नाल stem.

शीर्षपद m. (-वः) A tree, (*Pterospermum acerifolium*.) E. शैर्ष withered, पद a leaf. [पाद a foot.

शीर्षपाद m. (-वः) An epithet of the planet Saturn. E. शैर्ष shrivelled,

शीर्षपुष्पिका f. (-का) A kind of fennel, (*Anethum sowa*.) E. शैर्ष shrunk, पुष्प a flower, कन् aff., fem. form.

शीर्षद्वन्द्व n. (-न्द्वः) A water-melon. E. शैर्ष slender, and द्वन्द्व foot-stalk.

शीर्षाङ्गि m. (-ङ्गिः) YAMA, judge of the dead. E. शैर्ष shrivelled, अङ्गि a foot : being shrunk up in consequence of a curse of his mother's.
